10th house - Medium Coeli (MC)

Medium Coeli (MC) - Symbolises social status, career, reputation, honours, fame, success, authoritative personality, father.

10th house in Cancer (Cancer ruler is Moon)

People with Cancer on the tenth house cusp are characterised by deep emotions about their career and social status. Interpretations

- **Planets** describe a certain process of what is happening - eg. Mars fights, Saturn limits, Jupiter expands..
- **Sign** in which the planet is located determines how the planet is manifesting itself, for example Mars may manifest itself in a way Aries would behave (vigorously and irritably) or in the manner of Taurus (more slowly, gradually and consistently)
- **Houses** show special areas of everyday life, in which all this takes place. Location in a house shows whether, for example Mars manifests in relationships (7th house), employment (6th house), family (4th house) or elsewhere.

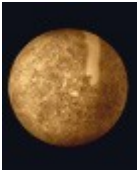
Moon in the 12th House

Mercury - Thinking, communication, intellect, learning

Mercury is the planet that brings us interest in intellectual things, about teaching and learning. It also indicates into what depth we want to study things. It gives us natural intelligence and the ability to analyse and reproduce.

Mercury in Aquarius

Venus symbolises attractiveness. Sign in which Venus is tells us what we are attracted to and this enables us to give or receive love and affection, beauty and happiness, values and principles. The negative side is that it represents weakness and shallowness.

Venus in ♄ Capricorn

Mars in ♒ Aquarius

Pluto - Transformation, regeneration, power

Pluto is the planet of death and rebirth. It is the end of all things, it is the Judgment Day. It can give rise to obsessions or convictions. On the dark end of its spectrum it can manifest as "succumbing to the urge," or it can create an individual who has the ability to get to the core of things, destroy negative things and bring on healing and transformation.

Pluto in ♎ Libra

(Note: Pluto is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Pluto in Libra is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Pluto in the 1st house.)

People with Pluto in the Libra have a good sense of balance, but because Pluto is falling in this sign, it can also bring about sudden and profound changes in their family or unexpected changes in relationships etc. In general, this position brings fears and uncertainties to relationships. These people are adaptable and responsible in their relationships, but they are also unstable. Personal transformation can be accomplished by developing the ability to relate to other people.

Pluto in the 1st House

Lunar Nodes - North Node and South Node

The Lunar Nodes aren't planets, but rather astrology mathematical points, that are directly opposite each other in the chart. It is said, that your life purpose is encoded between them - in the line between North Node and South Node. The South Node indicates your comfort zone, your habitual place, while your North Node shows life lessons and what you're striving for in this lifetime. Both Lunar Nodes are almost always retrograde.

North Node (Mean) in ♋ Cancer - South Node in Capricorn

North Node in Cancer brings the conflict between family and profession, home and public, proximity and distance, inner experience and external obligations.

These people need to find happiness in their family and in their spiritual life. They need to be interested in their family, roots, nation and homeland. They also need to turn to their own feelings and emotional needs, to their inner world and mental images.

Watch out for exaggerated ambition and external recognition instead of developing inner peace.

North Node (Mean) in the 9th House - South Node in the 3rd House

North Node in the ninth house brings the conflict between noble thoughts and simple trivial pearls of wisdom, between worldly

knowledge and sacred values, between intellectual doubts and religious beliefs. These people need to get a real education and find real meaning of various ideas. They need to attain personal spiritual image of the world through long journeys, studying and spiritual pilgrimages. ♁ Lilith - Black Moon - Fascination and Denial

Lilith is a fictional point - the second empty focal point of elliptical orbit of the Moon around the Earth.

In mythology, Lilith refused to submit to Adam, rebelled against the connection between Adam and Eve, decided to escape from the world of people and made a connection with Satan.

In astrology, Lilith symbolises either fascination or refusal of topics with which she is connected with. Both, the fascination or the rejection of the given topics, can eventually engulf the person and take him "away" from the human world.

Lilith (Mean) in ♑ Capricorn

Absolute loneliness; doubts about knowledge

These people are afraid of failure and they are very responsible. When they start doing something, they want to finish it at all cost. They feel that in order to manage everything they do they have to put their feelings aside. They often seem cold and reserved. They have a problem with the authorities; they are afraid of them or they reject them. However, in reality they are very vulnerable and emotional. The way out is through the opposite sign, the sign of Cancer - they have to be open to their feelings and experiences.

Beware of injuries to knees, joints and spine.

♁ Chiron - Wounded Healer, inner teacher

Chiron is an asteroid between Saturn and Uranus. Its orbit is very unusual and represents a bridge between material and spiritual worlds.

According to mythology, Chiron was a great healer, wise teacher and one of the immortal Centaurs. Unfortunately, he was "deadly" injured by a poisonous arrow by Heracles, his favourite disciple. He was suffering in great pain but he could not die. Finally, he gave up his immortality for the benefit of Prometheus who was also suffering, and Chiron was sent to the underworld. In the underworld Zeus had mercy for him and he raised him to the heaven.

In astrology, Chiron symbolises our unhealable injuries and incurable trauma. However, if a person, instead of drowning in his own trauma, is able to accept the trauma and help others who are also suffering, and accept that suffering is part of life, then Chiron may be the key to wisdom, or even to some sort of "Initiation Gate".

Chiron in ♉ Taurus

Unhealable wound of these people may be the result of the fact that other people, their parents, teachers, colleagues, superiors etc. have been constantly belittling them, although they have had no reason to do so. It is as if they have always been lacking something and therefore cannot be regarded as

full-fledged. Revolutionary social events could deprive them of property that has been in the family for generations. These people cannot seem to manage to create their own privacy. It's as if something prevents them from enjoying the little that they have. Even the accumulation of property and various rewards and prizes can not heal this injury.

Chiron in the 8th House

These people repeatedly get into situations where someone is manipulating them and trying to impose their ideas on how they should live and what they should do, or they try to rape them in one way or another (psychologically or even physically). They respond by violence or by having suicidal thoughts. They keep getting into serious, often even life-threatening situations. In marriage, they are unable to create a truly intimate relationship based on mutual trust and sharing.

This harmonious aspect give people good memory, poetic soul and the ability to understand others. It helps people to become good teachers, journalists and psychologists. These people are interested in their origin and roots and in environmental problems. They are often very intelligent.

△ - [Moon Trine Venus](#) (3°57', Separating)

This harmonious aspect gives people balanced temperament, charming manners and usually also good looks. Social success is almost guaranteed. These people have creative abilities and they need to create a pleasant home environment.

♁ - [Moon Tri-Octile Mars](#) (1°59', Separating)

These people often suffer from emotional tension and they are ruthless and indecisive. They love conflicts at home and they know how to win them. They are bossy, they lead adventurous life and find it hard to conform and settle down.

✳ - [Moon Sextile Jupiter](#) (1°22', Separating)

These people are extremely open, optimistic and generous. Thanks to these characteristics they are often successful and they radiate them on to others. They are idealists and they love to have a pleasant home. They are excellent students and they are successful in winning legal disputes.

This harmonious aspect brings people the need for considerable emotional independence and freedom in the family environment. These people often lead unconventional life and they do not like to yield to

the will of others. They feel separated from society (complex of separation). They often experience stormy emotions and mood swings.

☐ - [Moon Square Neptune](#) (5°58', Separating)

This aspect influences people in a similar way conjunction does but not as strongly. This aspect gives people the need to search for something transcendental, and this is often the reason why these people tend to be religious or join various esoteric movements. These people tend to be a bit confused, chaotic and have unrealistic desires. This aspect gives them the ability to perceive deep mental processes and difficulties of human psyche. It's a great aspect for psychologists, but sometimes these people may experience difficulties coping with the depths of human psyche.

☑ - [Mercury Conjunction Venus](#) (2°51', Applying)

This conjunction gives people good manners and mental balance. They can express themselves well and they are convincing. Their views are also well-balanced. Their thinking is often so rational that they are not able to express their feelings too openly.

* - [Mercury Sextile Jupiter](#) (0°15', Separating)

This harmonious aspect brings optimism, kindness and openness. These people are often great philosophers. However, they like to satisfy their mental interests even if they do not have the money for it. They like to travel and they do not stay long in one place.

This aspect gives people serious, conservative and practical mental processes. However, these people also have the ability to calculate clearly and calmly, and this ability is often responsible for their success.

This aspect affects thinking in such a way that these people are overly dominated by their opinions and instincts. This results in biased thinking. These people study sporadically, but when they do, they put all their energy into it and consequently they become very exhausted. When they search for truth they are convinced of their opinions and they do not consider practical aspects much. They often use all the information and intelligence they have into manipulating others. However, they are often unaware of it.

People with this harmonious aspect are kind and cordial. They easily adapt to new social trends and demands, and they like fashion. This aspect brings hospitality and generosity. It is also useful in case of legal disputes.

☐ - [Venus Square Saturn](#) (3°46', Applying)

People with this aspect are responsible, reserved and hesitant. They also have restraints that are often the result of poor parenting or fear of other authorities. This also causes fear of loss - they are afraid to lose both their property and their loved ones. These people often submit their feelings to practicality (typical manifestation of this is getting married for security). They subconsciously fear unemployment and poverty.

☐ - [Venus Square Pluto](#) (0°06', Separating)

This aspect manifests itself in a very typical way - these people can both love and hate with all their heart, deeply and intensely. They hide their true passion and usually they have a great fantasy. They want to feel that they are better than others and this desire manifests by starting a business or by trying

to accumulate material wealth. This aspect activates sexuality and sex appeal. It creates similar radiance as harmonious aspect but it also adds strong jealousy; these people can even become paranoid.

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people vigour and determination that help them achieve their goals. They can fight with passion for what is important to them.

The negative side of this aspect is that it can cause great inner tension and frustration, because the fighting spirit and the desire to conquer can distract these people from the focal point of their life instead of pulling them towards it. There is a danger that they will create artificial image of their enemy as a result of suppressed aggression. The behaviour of these people is often inappropriate and their responses may be exaggerated.

△ - [Node Trine Saturn](#) (0°26', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are focused on overcoming challenges in their life. Declination aspects

Parallels and Contra-Parallels are aspects, which refer to degrees of declination above or below the celestial equator.

- Parallel is similar to a conjunction, but usually provides benefits.
- Contra-Parallel is said to be similar to the opposition, but weaker.

Note: The following parallel and contra-parallel interpretations are the same as the interpretations used for the conjunction and opposition.

|| - [Sun Parallel Venus](#) (1°03')

There can only be conjunction between the Sun and Venus. This aspect highlights feminine characteristics of both sexes. It also supports artistic and creative inclinations. These people are often optimistic and they enjoy the company of other people. They have a good taste for fashionable clothes.

|| - [Sun Parallel Neptune](#) (0°27')

This conjunction brings intuition, fantasy, empathy and self-sacrifice. These people are not very practical. They sometimes tend to lead an ascetic life. They have great imagination, intuition, spirituality and a sense of harmony. However, all their activities lack order and structure (these people are just "floating" through the structure of life). These people sort of "translate" the big truths to others.

|| - [Moon Parallel Pluto](#) (1°03')

This aspect causes unnecessary stubbornness in conflicts with loved ones. These people do not like making compromises and they are difficult to get along with. They hide their true feelings and then they have emotional outbursts. They often decide to make radical changes, even in matters of important and personal nature.

- This conjunction in the horoscope of a woman almost always creates a pathological connection between mother and daughter. It brings coercive relationship between mother and daughter, in which the mother subconsciously does not want to let the daughter become independent.

- This conjunction in the horoscope of a man manifests itself differently; the mother also does not let her son out of her influence and the son become subconsciously dependent on his mother.

In both cases, this person needs strong pressure in order to be able to perceive at all.

|| - [Mercury Parallel Jupiter](#) (0°05')

This conjunction gives people considerable interest in the realm of thought and the desire for learning and knowledge. These people are often travellers, theologians and philosophers. They love freedom of expression and they frequently have reservations about the education system.

|| - [Venus Parallel Uranus](#) (0°12')

This conjunction causes considerable emotional independence, which often becomes a priority need. These people do not like commitments and they often hide their true feelings. If they feel that their independence is threatened, they become cold and distant. They often leave a relationship without an evident cause. They need a feeling of freedom in any relationship. If they feel free they can be faithful and pleasant. They are creative and interested in technologies. They are also artistic and they like modern art.

|| - [Venus Parallel Neptune](#) (0°36')

This conjunction increases sensitivity, a sense of romance and the ability to idealise a partner. These characteristics can be responsible for disappointments and mistakes. Their fantasies are closer to them than reality. However, if they are in a good relationship, they are faithful and devoted. They love fashion, art and photography. Transcendent, mysticism and magic sexually arouse women with this aspect. This aspect in men tells us about characteristics of his inner woman-anima and thus it also tells us about the personality of women that will be interested in him. For artists, this aspect brings inspiration, creativity, imagination, and a very good taste.

|| - [Uranus Parallel Neptune](#) (0°48')

This conjunction is responsible for urge for changes. These people tend to change their lives and to interfere with political affairs that they are never satisfied with. If they are publicly engaged, then their reformist efforts have some chances to be successful, otherwise they live in discontent with the circumstances all their life. This conjunction gives people immense originality, intense creative abilities and innovative inspirations.

This aspect can indicate difficulties acknowledging own values.

‡ - [MC Contra-Parallel Venus](#) (0°28')

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are popular at work. The negative side of this aspect is that they tend to be jealous and dissatisfied in their work environment.

‡ - [MC Contra-Parallel Uranus](#) (0°40')

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people skilful and original behaviour that helps them achieve their goals. The negative side of this aspect is that it may cause bouts of rebellion that can be responsible for changes in their social status.

♃ - [MC Contra-Parallel Neptune](#) (0°07')

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people intuition that helps them find their life path. The negative side of this aspect is that these people may lose their life direction because they are not clearly aware of their real abilities.

♃ - [Node Contra-Parallel Sun](#) (0°43')

Frequent conflicts and tension among the demands of the Sun and the tasks of the lunar node that are waiting to be realised. For this reason the life path of these people is not clear. They are indecisive, chaotic and they have restraints.

♃ - [Node Contra-Parallel Neptune](#) (1°11')

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are sure of their decisions and this helps them overcome life challenges. Pure spirituality becomes the focus of their life.

The negative side of this aspect is that these people only have vague ideas about their focus and meaning of life or their sense for life direction is poor. They easily withdraw their focus from what is important, they are not persistent, or all their goals fall apart.
