

## **API: Doomguard interview**

Okay, so here we are on Aryan practical idealism and Doomguard is the guest for today, so thanks for taking time out of your schedule and dropping by. I'm sure you have a lot of interesting things to offer. So what is it exactly that you want to discuss first and initially? You were saying something about government bullshit and the illegitimacy of current political figures and bureaucracies.

Oh, yeah, that. Well, it's a pleasure. Thanks for having me on, by the way.

And I guess the reason why I put that on the list is because I, for some reason, imagined that you were coming on my show, which I guess. And so I was going to have you introduce yourself because you're a little bit of a mercurial figure yourself, right? And I watched a video one of my friends sent me because I asked him, oh, who's Loki Hallgard? Because I had heard of your show, Aryan Practical Idealism, didn't know much about you. But I watched an interview that you had with Community TV there in that town in Canada.

Oh, yeah. What is it? Yeah. Edison Hat, Alberta.

It's basically about two and three quarter hours away from Calgary, which is a major city in Alberta, sort of near the border of Montana. A major city in Alberta. I didn't think there was such a thing.

Well, Calgary, I guess for Canada, that would be a major city. I think Calgary is maybe a couple million people. So that's a fairly large city.

Oh, no shit. All right. I guess I was wrong.

Well, I was just teasing you a little bit. But from what I'd heard, Alberta is just like really, really rural and really cold. I don't know if that's the case.

But as you were talking to that kid from the Community TV program, I was just thinking, gee, this reminds me of when this communist dude called Caleb was chatting with, well, under the guise of having a conversation. He was lambasting cultured thug as a violent, murderous fascist. And CT is just trying to make the conversation about ideas.

But this guy just keeps going on and on. Why is fascism so violent? That's what I want to know, CT. Why is it especially fascism that is violent? So it was a real fucking pain to listen to, obviously.

But it kind of reminded me of that kid. And I thought, is that kid a little bit Jewish? Like, this is funny. He keeps asking you, well, but what if I see a hot girl who's black? What if I just want to have sex with black girls? How can you want to preserve your race that's been here? How can you want to preserve the race that has achieved all of these things

and has this long history and has created this art? How could you think about achieving that when you see some African girl with a hot ass? And I just thought, I imagine myself sitting there in that chair where you were sitting, and I just was going to turn and look at him with berserker eyes and say, is your argument that we should exercise no control over our urges then? Because I like the direction you're going with this, kid.

Anyway, yeah, that was a pretty funny little interview. It set another kind of example when he was saying, well, what would you do in the event that you know you only have 24 hours to live? I would eat lots of food and stuff like that. More hedonism, you know, more lewish thonic behavior.

Yeah. Chthonic. Yeah.

Chthonic. Exactly. Right.

Well, that kid, I must have missed the part where he asked that, but I recall him saying, well, why are you in such good shape? You have giant legs. It looks like you could walk up a mountain for hours and hours. It's like, is it so important to you to be in shape? I was mentally facepalming.

I'm like, I don't know, so that you can not have fucking diabetes and a heart attack before you're 40. Well, what the fuck is the matter with it? I don't know if this is reflective of general attitudes in Canada. Maybe it's the same here in America, actually.

I have noticed that I basically stand out in most places that I go to because I'm not fat. Yeah, I think in America, there's more of an emphasis on obesity as an accepted phenomenon. Canada, people are a little bit in better shape overall, but I think that's more just a Jewish mentality there.

Either he was trying to imply some denigration about me on the one hand or on the other hand, he was just trying to put forth his actual genuine sentiments of not being able to comprehend a desire to be strong and healthy, because the Jews are predisposed to diabetes for the most part. I think they even call it the Jewish disease, actually. I've heard that.

Who calls it that? Not too sure. Somebody getting sued by the... You mean somebody who's in a lawsuit called it that once? Probably. That's what happens when you don't circulate your blood and when the blood sugar it attacks your nerve tissues, too.

You can get nerve damage and stuff like that. Sounds like a pretty Jewish disease, yeah. I don't know how Jews can get a disease, though, when Jews are a disease, so I just don't understand.

I don't know. It's like somebody tried telling me once, I was like, what the fuck is with these kikes in ISKCON, which is a Hindu movement started by this Prabhupada figure

from the... Akhanda Dasa talks about that. Yeah, exactly.

I was saying, what's with all these Jews and Hinduism, and what's with all these Jews and Buddhism? And somebody tried explaining it to me once, and he's like, well, you see, the Jews have a lot of bad karma, so that's why they're interested in this stuff. And I was like, no, stop right there. The Jews don't have bad karma.

They are bad karma. What was it? They're Maya personified. Yeah.

Every country has the Jews it deserves, right? Yeah, I recall that. He said Jews can only survive in the swamps of our sins. Yeah, I resonated with that a little bit, you know, despite the fact that I'm a heathen.

Yeah, minus the Christian component there. Right. That's definitely a problem.

Well, the Christians say the swamps of our sins, whereas the heathens say the swamps of your degeneracy. So yeah, that's a little bit of a... Quite a lot of difference. They're just looking to expiate their sins and to flee the earth or fly away.

But we're looking to, you know, occupy and conquer. It's quite a distinctive thing there. And I guess we transcend in imminence, whereas they just seek to, you know, make a cowardly flight from reality, as Klassen called it.

They're not looking to give battle. They just want to turn the other cheek and judge the not. So much easier that way.

You're speaking of Ben Klassen, the author of Nature's Eternal Religion? Yeah. Is that what I'm thinking? Yep. Okay.

Excellent. Gee, it seems like we're on the same page in a lot of ways. This is interesting.

Yeah, I rarely talk to people like this. Well, in any case, I was just watching a video before we started this call of Trump talking about his vaccine that he's trying to get done by October. Is that the death vaccine that he's looking to inject in people's bodies? Yeah, I mean, sorry.

Yeah, I mean, I figured he would wait until after his constituents voted for him and then give them the Illuminati Jew world order vaccine. I figured he would at least wait until after the election, but apparently not. So yeah, I don't really know.

It's kind of weird with him. He talks about, oh, we have these alternate treatments and these alternate methods, but we're going to come up with the vaccine anyways. And you can tell just by his attitude and the way he talks, he doesn't really believe in the coronavirus.

He doesn't really take it that seriously. He literally said, downplay it, don't present it as a

serious problem. Like he's in hot water right now because he apparently literally said that to some guy called Bob Woodward.

So it's a little bit funny. And I just don't really know what to think about it, because I recall seeing him on TV telling someone we're going to use the military to make sure everybody gets their vaccine. I'm like, what the fuck is going on here, man? I guess his Trump tards are cheering away.

Yay for the military. They're going to drag us out in the streets and vaccinate us. Yeah.

You're going to get vaccinated one way or another. You're going to get a needle vaccine, or you're going to get a nine millimeter vaccine. I'm guessing that's how it's going to go.

But basically, yeah, it's like he even, you're right, he frames it this way so that his fucking retard followers will just never be able to refuse it. He's like, oh, only Democrats don't want the vaccine because they don't want my presidency to be successful because I'm a Republican. He was saying this to Judge Jeanine lady.

He's like, oh, the Democrats don't want the vaccine because they don't like me. And I'm just thinking, this is an interesting role reversal. Typically, it's the Republicans that are the anti-vaxxers and vaccine conspiracists, whereas it's the Democrats that are like, everybody has to be vaccinated.

Give those 13 year old girls Gardasil. We don't care if it makes them infertile or kills them. Everybody's getting these fucking vaccines.

So it's like, this is an interesting, Trump's like a spatula. He just flips everything. Now the Republicans are screaming about critical race theory and how it has to be eliminated from the government and how we have to stop all this racism.

We have to get the racism that has no place in America. This is all about libertarianism, liberal idealism, and just wrapped up in an American flag as opposed to a hammer and sickle flag. It's kind of like an interesting role reversal.

The Republicans now are like, we're the ones that are here to fight the racists and the Democrats are the real racists. So yeah, Trump's basically like the spatula candidate. So that's essentially what I meant by talking about the fucking political bullshit that these fucking Shylocks are up to.

That's all it is. It's just a contrived theater basically to divide and conquer. Just amazing that people would actually look upon it as having any substance because it's pretty transparently obvious that there's really no substance to it at all in terms of being a reality.

Yeah. It reminds me of what Adolf Hitler said about the parliament in Austria back in his

day when he went to Vienna. And he just said, I couldn't believe my eyes.

I couldn't believe my ears. I couldn't believe how low the discourse was. He basically said that, I'm paraphrasing.

He said, I couldn't believe how low the intellectual level of everything in the parliament was. Well, it's a symptom of decay basically that it's in a late stage, whatever you want to call that. But it's probably orchestrated as well to be in that stage because you can see how they've worked the dialectic back and forth.

Every term of office, four to eight years, they've got Bush, then they've got Obongo, and then they've got Trump. And it's the same thing in all the countries that are more socialist like Canada and the EU countries. They always just sort of follow suit.

It always begins in the States and then it just sort of replicates. They've got a more populist or pseudo populist right wing faction. And then that suddenly pops up in England and whatever, in Holland and in France and so forth.

And then it will be radiating outwards in the colonies and in the dominion of Canada, the British dominion, and then in Australia and so forth, too. And it's just the dialectic that they stage over and over again. And all these people are for Israel or they're not.

They're not attacking Israel or the Jews or obviously the Jews. It's just, you know, fight amongst one another, right wing, left wing. That's basically the whole game.

Yeah. There's been an explosion of kosher nationalists since 2016. Yeah, it's a distinct trend.

And yeah, basically they've kept this conflict down at the level of like the normal tier faggots. They've kept it down at the level of the streets where like Antifa can go and shoot some guy in the head because he's a member of Patriot Prayer, you know, whatever the fuck that is. Some flag conservative Christian group, I guess.

I don't know. Some normal, some normie tier nonsense, obviously. And a guy gets his head blown open for that.

You know, they keep it down at that level where it's just like the normies getting killed over semantics, basically, where you got the guys in black and yellow that are capitalist, anarchist, atheist, materialist, sodomite, race mixers, and Jews. You got them fighting the guys in black and red that are the communist, anarchist, atheist, sodomite, race mixer, Jews. Yeah, they're keeping it down at that level.

They're not going to ever graduate to the level where, let's say, Bill Gates gets summoned, where Bill Gates gets arrested. You know, they're never going to take it up a notch to the level where, I don't know, Mike Siner gets summoned to court and has to

defend himself for what happened at Charlottesville. They're not going to take it up to the level where even the shit tier politicians like Jacob Frey, like, they're not going to even punish them.

They're not going to punish the mayor of fucking Portland. They're not going to punish the mayor of Minneapolis. They're not going to punish any of these fucking, like, they won't even go after the political minions.

They're keeping it down, like, as low as possible, just on the level of the streets, where you got niggers burning shit down and a bunch of communist Jew terrorists going around attacking some white kid who had a gun. And then he defends himself and it's a big summit. Somehow this is something we need to even hear about, that a kid defended himself as opposed to armed communist thugs.

As opposed to all non-white violence against white people, which is statistically, what, 75% of all murder and so forth is the non, as the negro, the nigger, whatever you want to call them, against white people in the States. Oh, you know what I want to call them. Yeah, yeah, I guess basically the programming that I received here in Canada, you know, we're just still programmed to not say politically incorrect terms.

So it's just something that you sort of choke on when it comes out, I guess. But the more you deal with them, the more that will be flying out of your mouth, basically. In a more white town, there's not as many of them as there were in the city where I was living before.

But after a while living in that city, that comes out of your mouth pretty quickly. Yeah. Well, I live in a tiny little village, so there's basically none of them here.

It's like 99% white. But there's some town nearby that's a college town. And I find that basically there's like a semester of hell.

There's a semester of chaos every year. That's when college is just starting up and it's football season. So they bring in all these coons to play ball and they're only there for about a semester because they flunk out afterwards.

And basically they just help them glide through. They just help them slide by so they can play ball. And then after that, you know, the grades start actually coming in and actually mattering.

And then they're gone, usually. Yeah. It's just a case where somebody could not even pass a college or university courses since they're so obviously very easy and dumbed down compared to what they were a hundred years ago.

Yeah. Or 50 years ago. Yeah.

Yeah. I mean, if these niggers were any smarter, they'd realize that they're just being played. Literally, literally, you're being played on a field.

They're just playing you, man. You're just there to fucking make money so they can just draw in people to go watch these ball games and donate to the school or whatever dumb shit, you know, even more, more political level. They're being played as basically just a terrorist faction to throw at white people.

And the hidden tyranny of Harold Rosenthal, I guess you're familiar with that. It says we'll probably just kill the Negroes when we're done with them. That was Senator Jacob Javits, his aide, Harold Rosenthal, who had then got assassinated after that interview.

Really? This Jew secretary got assassinated, really? Yeah. It says we'll probably just kill the Negroes when we're done with them. So, you know, that's what they're cannon fodder, basically, to be hurled at the white majority, basically.

Them and the Spics, who are also covering the Southwest. Yeah, I mean, yeah, the Spics are a problem, but they're really nothing like the niggers. Well, some of them are.

There's a good faction of them that are pretty niggerish. And the young ones, definitely the millennial Mexicans, like the Mexicans that were born here or grew up here, they talk and act like niggers and they listen to nigger music. But they still.

Yeah. I mean, there's definitely a good faction of them that are legit gangbangers that are just like stupid, violent thugs that definitely need to be done away with. But.

I don't know, maybe it's because I'm a working class guy. You know, I'm Doomguard. I forgot to introduce myself.

I'm a working class tough guy, a neo-Nazi and a heathen. But basically, because I'm a working class guy, I guess the ones that I work with that actually stick around and work, they're probably like a different social statistic, you know, a different category in social statistics than the ones that probably you deal with in places like, I don't know, Tucson, Arizona or Phoenix or any of the cities, mega, mega shithole cities in the Southwest. At the same time, though, just to qualify that biologically, they're still the same type.

So it just depends on the environment that they're in that will trigger that sort of behavioral reaction. So even if they're in a small town, if the pressure gets put on them in some way that, you know, they don't like something or whatever the case, something goes wrong, then they'll just fly off the handle. Because in Canada, obviously, there's the so-called Native Americans or the Redskins or whatever you want to call them.

And they basically represented the major crime source prior to the other non-whites being dumped in here from the third world. And, you know, it's just an ongoing thing in my very small town that I grew up in. You'd see them in the ditch all the time.

They'd have their bottles of liquor, smash them around and so forth. They'd come up from the reserves and they just waste all their money and so forth and just take craps all over the ground and so forth. So, yeah, it's pretty funny.

I used to call them Boggins when I was a child. Boggins? I don't know why. Well, they're not quite as bad.

OK, so they get drunk and they lay in the ditch. At least they're not as bad as the Aborigines in Australia. They'd get drunk and they'll lay in the road, they'll lay in the middle of the road.

That's a bit better than I guess. Yeah, they're not as bad as niggers then, because niggers, they just walk through the street, like through the middle of the damn street. If there's a sidewalk available, it doesn't matter.

I've seen actual video footage of that, the guys walking right into the traffic like he's protesting some whatever or something like that. But I'm not even talking about in the context of a protest. I mean, just literally any time they go out walking around town, they refuse to use sidewalks.

They refuse to use crosswalks. They just run through the road or walk through the road or walk in the middle of the fucking road. So, yeah.

So I guess in the in the hierarchy here, it goes Aborigines, then niggers and then redskins. All right. Well, as for the Mexicans, I don't know.

They're definitely a disintegrating element in the context of American democracy. They're definitely a tool that's being used. Ferment of decomposition, I think Evola would call it.

Yeah, I'm referring to the type of language that Spangler would use. He used it when speaking of the Jews. He said they were a disintegrating element.

Right. Well, basically diversity, it's the injection of disintegrating elements. You know, I think I saw a snippet of some stupid ass Tucker Carlson show where he was talking to some guy saying this critical race theory has infested the government and academia and it's ruining everything.

We have to stop this critical race theory. And then Tucker literally said, he's like, you know, diverse countries can't stand this sort of thing for very long. We have to stop it and come together.

We can't be divided. We have to unify. And I thought, you know, this is some really dumb shit.

I mean, maybe this is a game they're playing. I don't know. Yeah, I think it is, actually,

because they're playing to the moral majority, conservatard, white demographic through Tucker Carlson.

Yeah, that too. But I just thought these people, they say this stuff as if they're so fucking smart. And I just think diverse societies, they just can't, period.

Like a diverse society can't do anything for very long because it just can't even stand up for very long. It just inevitably collapses. And there's no example from history where that's not been the case.

So these idiots that are talking about this shit, like, oh, well, we need to have better historical education here in America. We need better history classes. And it's like, really? Is that really what you want? Are you sure about that? What they mean is they want to change the tone of the propaganda, I guess is what they mean.

Or maybe they don't even mean that. Maybe this is just bullshit. I don't know.

It's really weird here in America. Like recently the FBI released, the FBI Twitter page posted a link to the protocols of the elders of Zion. They just posted that.

And the FBI Twitter. I heard about that. Yeah.

The FBI Twitter has been posting a lot of weird shit. Like they post, they broke that, some pedophile conspiracy that the CIA was involved in. And actually they were partially involved.

But, you know, it was so redacted, you couldn't really learn anything. Just when you look at the report, it's just nothing but black redacted over the whole thing. It's interesting how you're familiar with William L. Pierce's Hunter, right? That novel of his.

Oh, yeah. Yeah. In that there's the character of William Ryan, the FBI director, and he, you know, like jockeying for power against the Jewish faction in there.

It seems like something like that, you know, maybe is going on. Questionable. I doubt it, but hopefully.

Yeah. I mean, it's kind of weird. Yeah.

We're going to have to see how it all unravels because it's kind of like, I remember saying this to this kid, Pat Siegman, when I was talking to him, I told him, well, you know, all that we need to happen is for Jewish criminality and Jewish methods of engineered chaos to come to light. And it's kind of almost like it's happening because there was this true news broadcast where this dude was on there talking about it. It's become a meme.

It's spreading around. He says Antifa is a Jewish organization. It always has been.

And it's always been a terrorist organization. And the reason why they're not labeled as a terrorist organization is because it's funded by rich Jews. So if it was labeled a terrorist organization, then all these rich Jews would be arrested.

So that's the reason why it's not happening. You know, that's the reason why it stays at the level of the street where, you know, normal working class Americans can be killed by these fucking welfare class niggers and kikes. And they're they're content to just leave it there at that level.

You know. Yeah, I'm not sure there might be there might be elite whites behind the scenes to some extent as well. I don't think that whites are totally powerless.

I just think maybe their power is masked by the the illusion machine of the Jew media. So that's all we can understand from our perspective at like a lower level, looking up from the bottom. Yeah, it could be.

I mean, there's been people around like like David Duke, who's not really part of the establishment, but he's been around for a long time and he has influence, obviously, because Trump was asked to disavow him and he he pretended he couldn't hear the interviewer and he wouldn't disavow him. Instead, he just had his son disavow him on Twitter like he had Trump Jr. or one of his sons go and slime David Duke on Twitter over some bullshit. And then you have people like Pat Buchanan, who was he's part of the Republican establishment, basically, and he's got some racial undertones to things that he'll say.

Right. Well, I mean, I mean, interestingly enough, in a political class, those who are sort of maybe in the corporate world or maybe maybe they are in the political class, but they just don't have any representation in the system through the media so that we cannot know or see them. You know, they're behind the scenes in a real sense, like invisible to us.

We would never be able to know who they are. That's what my hope be. But, you know, you can hope all you want.

It won't really change anything from your perspective. So. Mm hmm.

Sure. Yeah, from our perspective. Yeah, there's there's a lot of invisible factors we're not really privy to.

And if it's good or bad, we don't really know. So basically, we have to look out for, you know, our own families and our own future. Right.

It's basically what's left to us because you can't really trust any of these institutions. And there's no telling who is involved in just just sabotage. Like there was an incident recent recently here.

There's some guy called Kurt Doolittle who was a proprietarian. So he got all of his people together for a demoralization demonstration. So he pissed himself in front of them, basically, and told them that they all had small dicks and that niggers were stronger and better than them and all this shit.

Like, literally, he does this shit on camera right in front of his followers. You know, some spin off libertarian ideology. You know, so they have it turns out this guy was like he's worked for the federal government before.

He's worked in Ukraine doing psyops and weird shit like that. And he's admitted to doing this shit. And then he does a psyop here in America to demoralize the libertarian, you know, conservative type right wingers that are like sort of vaguely racially aware.

Yeah. So it's like the Yuri Bezmenov type techniques. Yeah.

So they do shit like that. So you never know who these fucking people are and if they're just another fucking, you know, just another shill, just another demoralization agent. They're using some kind of demoralization propaganda or they're planning some demoralization op.

There's a lot of that shit that goes on here, too, right? Like, I'm convinced that basically most of the people involved with the alt-right, they're basically that. I mean, even the terminology of the alt-right is just a little bit. It's really kind of cucked.

It's suspected. When I first heard of that through Red Ice Radio, which I was listening to long ago, but then I stopped. It just seemed like a total contrived fake.

I don't know, whatever, whatever we want to call it, a cultural phenomenon, sort of. I wrote a little collection of articles called Alt-Kyke Reputation of the Alt-Right about it, which refutes a lot of these alt-right claims and psyops that they put forth. In my mind, it's just more like a sort of covert pushing of Christianity and pushing of this Duganism, third position Duganism, is basically what its purpose is, is just to try to shift people away from more explicitly racial self-understanding and more walking along a more purity-spiraled path, if you want to call it that, towards more all these splintered, factional cul-de-sacs of culture that don't really lead to anything or have any meaning or value.

Like MGTOW, there is in there. Then there is, you know, white sharia, there's Duganism, sort of chaos, magic, nonsense, and, you know, worshipping Russia, worshipping Putin. Obviously, Russia has been Jewish since 1905 or whatever the case, and Putin's a Jew, Dugan's a Jew.

So what is alt-right really? You know, it's fag-enabling, it's doing all sorts of stuff like that. Either that or its so-called leaders are race-mixed or Jews themselves, crypto-Jews, like Richard Spencer, of course, is a crypto-Jew. Are you sure about that? Really? Yeah,

he was photographed with Laura Bush and so forth.

Well, I know he was photographed with her. I mean, I think he's a race-mixer, but I didn't know he was like actually a Jew. But the thing is, that's basically what I was going to say, is that just the terminology in itself is a semantic trick to befuddle people.

And all the things that they say, these are just basically semantic tricks that they presented as if it means one thing. They basically allow people to look at it or to hear it and come up with their own preconceived notions that allow them to support it. But in reality, to these people, it doesn't mean anything of the sort that a normal person would think it would mean.

For instance, when they say the word ethno-nationalism, obviously someone like me, I look at this and I say, okay, Northern European, Germanic racial nationalism. That's the only thing I'm really interested in, is splitting Europe up into various racial blocs, you know, the Mediterranean, the Nordic, the British, and the Slavic. And then we have a loose alliance in order to fight outsiders.

That's basically the only nationalism I'm really interested in. But the word ethnonationalism to these people, it means language, culture, financial systems, government systems, legal systems. I guarantee you that's what it means.

Anything to try to shift attention away from biological reality, in other words. It's just sort of this red herring that drags people's attention away from actual real solutions like national socialism and more legitimate alternatives to the current system to try to accommodate a lot of the elements of the system as a sort of a conservative compromise, basically. So it appeals to people who are not only superficial and sort of empty-headed, you know, the video game type, idiot phone generation.

But additionally, it appeals to, you know, the more conservatard types who are just, you know, interested in getting the money and feeling good or, you know, complaining about capitalism, I guess that sort of accommodates some of those types as well, with like Matt Heimbach and all these other people of that kind. I guess. I don't know.

I mean, maybe initially, but actually, I don't know that. I mean, I guess it somewhat seems like a form of strasserism in some ways. They do criticize capitalism, but they, I don't know what they offer that is really much, that is like a credible opposition to it.

I mean, like I said, with the ethnonationalism thing, it's like, it's like, I remember being at university, and I literally saw this Armenian Jewish bitch, this old hag from the Soviet Union who came over here as a refugee, basically, after the fall of the Soviet Union. When the Iron Curtain came down, we have all these fucking muds and half-Jews and gypsies and Jewish communists fleeing to come over here to America to then infiltrate and subvert our country and fuck it up in just exactly the same goddamn way they

fucked up half the planet under the Soviet regime. So we get their fucking garbage.

Well, this fucking bitch was part of their garbage. And she said, literally, why is it that you white Americans don't get along with the black Americans? You have the same language. You have the same culture.

There's no difference between you. This fucking subversive kike bitch literally says stupid shit like that, and that's ethnonationalism. So when you hear these neocommunist fucks say the word ethnonationalism, what they mean is, oh, well, they speak English, they were born here in America, or maybe they weren't even born here, but they speak English, and they're currently under this governmental system, and they subscribe to some political ideology that we've blessed off on.

Yeah, well, basically... So that's an ethnonationalist. They're operating on the confusion between race and culture, trying to create the false associations between ethnos and mere culture as opposed to biological reality. That's what they do in Quebec here also with the politics of that, with their francophone language or playing it off against the anglophones, and then that way they still have a bunch of negros being poured in from Africa who speak French.

So what does it matter, really? I mean, your language won't save your culture because your culture is an epiphenomenon of your biological identity. So if you don't preserve your identity biologically, then you don't have any culture anyway. So it's an absurdity to cling to these sorts of straws to try to prevent your kind from drowning in the mass.

You're not going to be able to overcome that through that means. And that's why these alt-right psyops and psyops like that are being staged so that they can use them as a dialectical shifting away from that which is the greatest threat to their power, which is just biological racism, perhaps of a higher form like Evola conceives of it, but still biologically based, based on physical. And the alt-right and counter-currents as well basically perverts and utilizes Evola and his theories but deliberately shunts under the rug the racial conceptions of Evola.

There's a book just recently translated, The Synthesis of Racial Doctrine by Evola, which is at Evolaasheis.wordpress.com. And that basically blows out of the water any of the claims that a lot of people like Renegade and people like that are trying to make that Evola advocated race mixing and so forth, which is in no way the case because he's got the race of the body, the race of the soul, and the race of the spirit. So, you can't just substitute totally different elements without a biological basis for some of these things. The physical is always a necessary factor in that tripartite conception of race.

Well, that's interesting. I'll have to read that work that you just mentioned because I recall reading his notes on the Third Reich and I came away with a different idea of what Julius Evola thought of race, but I don't know. It was a version that was published by

Arctos, so maybe they made some kind of renditions or mistranslations, I have no idea.

But in any case, yeah, as far as the alt-right is concerned, it strikes me as some weird morass, like some weird mishmash of sort of neo-Strausserism, but without, I guess it does have some ideas of palingenesis, of like a return of some ancient culture or ancient people or ancient way, but it's kind of like it's bastardized without the racial, without a hard component or at least without some seriousness regarding race. It just seems totally illegitimate, it seems bastardized to me. And then on top of it, it's these Duganist theories and I don't know, some sort of pseudo, because I don't really even see any conservatism really in it.

I mean, there are conservative groups that went under the banner and latched onto it, but in terms of the main figures that were like put in charge of it, like Richard, I don't really see that. In his case, I see like this weird sort of like intellectual neo-Nasbol-Strausserism, whatever. You know, maybe there were some decent ideas in Strausserism, but I just really hate Otto Strausser because he lied about Hitler.

He wrote a book of lies, just told lies about Hitler. Then on top of it, he hated anti-Semites and he once said anti-Semitism is dead. He just hated Hitler because Hitler was realistic about Jews and what has to be done.

Well, you have to. You have to. And so I hate the problem.

Yeah. The problem isn't language. The problem isn't culture.

It's not an ideology. It's not a system of ideas, a political economic system, whatever. It's obviously biological realities.

You know, it's a racial war. Yeah. And Otto Strausser was basically like Dugan.

He basically had Duganist ideas, this idea that every ethnic group, a little bit more racial language in Strausser's time because that was the, I mean, it wasn't taboo in that day and age. And also that was the popular current at the time was Germanic racial nationalism. So I don't know if he used the term ethno-nationalism.

I don't think he did. But essentially he had this similar idea that, oh, every ethnic group or every race is specially endowed by God with all these rights and they have to have this corresponding nation state that has to be recognized and blessed off on. And it kind of reminds me of like this, I can't remember exactly if it was the 30 years war or the hundred years war, but afterwards, basically this was the creation of ethno-nationalism, so to speak, or more like religious nationalism, which is kind of what ethno-nationalism also means is like some vague religious nationalism.

But essentially that was the beginning of this idea of like, of this, this idea of like a nationalism for all peoples and all creeds because they'd had such a huge battle, the Catholic church. And I think the Protestants, the reformers, they had this battle first for generations basically. And so they came to the conclusion.

Yeah. So they came to the conclusion that whatever the religion of the prince or king in charge of a country is, that's the official religion of the country. And we'll just allow it to stay that way.

Yeah, just divide and conquer again. Their ultimate objective is obviously the melted pot. This is just like a totalitarian tiptoe, as David Icke calls it, even though David Icke's an operative and a disinfo agent.

But this is just a way they have of working it toward that ultimate conclusion, which is so-called universal peace or equality by mixture, mongrelization, the Kalergi plan. And so, you know, obviously they do whatever they can in terms of specific tactics at specific times and places to achieve that objective. So sometimes you have to take a couple of steps backwards, but so long as they're moving forwards, that's all they care about.

That's their Fabian socialist, you know, Jewish motivation, basically. Their methodology is just by all means necessary so long as it's most efficient. Yeah, basically so long as they can sow absolute racial chaos so that there's no hope of any serious orderliness or any serious high culture after that.

Yeah, I guess I think that's obviously the objective. And they'll use any kind of semantic games or they'll sow any kind of confusion or disinfo in order to facilitate the attainment of that objective that is just pure racial chaos. Because they understand, and it's obvious, it's just plain to see.

What you were talking about with that kid from community TV where you said, look, they just have different thought forms, different races of people. They have a different thinking process. And the reality is, you know, to get spooky for a minute, the reality is that, you know, that person being like a different person in a different body and supposedly and allegedly they're over there, you know, there's distance between them and me.

You know, it appears that way to your eyes. To your eyeballs, it looks that way. But in reality, we're something a little bit more complex than that, I think.

And I mean, you've noticed this before. I've noticed this. Sorry, I keep cutting you off.

That's where Evola's conception of race comes in with the tripartite conception of race, body, soul and spirit. Right. Well, I'm speaking in terms of brainwaves, because I'm sure you've noticed, like if you had a girlfriend for a while, pretty soon she'll say something that you were thinking at exactly that moment.

Yeah, there are thought forms that exist concretely and objectively that are like

crystallizations of energy fields. There are certain patterns of energy fields that, you know, exist in a real in a real sense, not just like a psychological sense. Right.

Well, I'm convinced that it's real, because I remember just not too long ago, I was thinking about sending an email to Cultured Thug and I was going to ask him to send me some badass skinhead music. And I was thinking about it for about three days. And then on the third day, I finally got in my email and I was about to send it to him and I found out, oh, he sent me an email with more of this badass skinhead music.

And I was like, to me, all sorts of times where you basically the law of attraction and the law of manifestation, that if you think about something very hard for a consistent period of time, then you can actually manifest it into being. Or at least you can within the realm of probability, you know, you can increase the probability of its occurrence through thought, through concentration of the mind, basically. Yeah.

So essentially what I was saying before is that it might appear to your eyeballs that they're over there and you're here, but in reality, your brainwaves are clashing, like in reality, your brainwaves are interacting. You know that. So, I mean, I feel bad saying this.

I'm sorry to say this. I let you guys down. Any of my viewers, any of my guys that are watching this, sorry, boys, I let you down.

I started learning workplace Spanish recently. I cocked. I don't know what to tell you.

But I started learning workplace Spanish recently, and hopefully this isn't a slippery slope or something. But essentially, yeah, I think it's correct that if you spend enough time around people, their brainwaves start affecting you. Well, the entire thought process, like the entire mentality of these different races, it's not, they're just incongruent.

Yeah, even though it's not the same. So yeah, so diversity is never, ever really going to work out. I mean, it never has.

You should ask yourself, why has it never worked out? I mean, can anybody point to anything, anywhere where it worked out? No, you can't. I can't think of anything. And taking examples from culture, too, and from language, even though they have a language imposed on them, which is totally foreign to them, like French or Spanish, which is created by white people, or a constitution like in the Americas, in South America, they've got the U.S. Constitution or adapted to their, you know, banana republic countries and so forth.

And same with British dominionism. But none of those, you know, make the same country. And no economic system makes the same, you know, it doesn't solve the problem.

And language won't, and neither will culture, neither will coming around to what Patrick

calls the Freemasonic shopping mall of America, of why America. That's not going to help you. Just because you wear Nike shoes doesn't mean you don't have the nigger toes, I guess you could say.

You know, you might bounce a basketball, a basketball invented by a white man, but you're still, you know, you're still playing it as a nigger plays basketball, not as a white man would play. You know, Larry Bird is not Kobe Bryant, they're distinct entities. Even though they play on the same team, they're still different.

Shit. Shit, nigga. Wearing them fine ass kicks, that's the quickest way to get your ass fucking busted by these coons.

That's the quickest way for them to pull out their gat on you is if you're wearing a pair of shoes that they want. So yeah, that's the other thing about my workplace is that there's this kid there who for the longest time I thought he was Mexican or like half Mexican because he looks and dresses like a Mexican and he hangs out with the Mexicans and he is learning Spanish. But it turns out that he's Russian.

He's from Russia. He was adopted when he was a kid and brought over from Russia. Maybe he's a Russian.

Well, he's also, I don't know, he kind of looks like a gypsy maybe. But I thought he was Mexican, but it turns out he's Russian. So I don't know what that says about Russia, but I mean, my Bulgarian buddy is going to love this because he fucking hates the Russians.

But anyways, this kid's also a wigger and he just listens to rap every morning. And the only reason why this can fly is because it's a construction site and it's all men that work there and a bunch of Mexicans who can't understand it. They don't know what the lyrics are saying.

And even a white man who speaks English can barely tell what these fucking coons are saying. For one thing, because their fat lips get in the way of what they're trying to say. But for another thing, because their fucking brain doesn't process how the fucking English language works.

Obviously, the English language doesn't really. It's like you can't upload this fucking modern program to whatever CPU they're running. It just doesn't work.

Well, that's why he is onyx. Yeah, it's ebonics music. But like this kid, though, there's one thing from sterocysm that I realized was true.

He talks about capitalist propaganda or about capitalist advertisements stimulating and basically creating desires that wouldn't have been there before or that are basically frivolous and meaningless. Yeah, it creates. They're called simulacra, basically these created ideas that are created to engineer consciousness or modify consciousness, but

they just came out of nowhere and they never had any existent reality prior to that.

They're being manufactured out of the void, basically. Yeah, simulacrum. Well, this kid's the perfect example, because I remember being at work one day and the old white dude who was the manager of the whole workplace, he was having a bad day.

He was like 63, 65. So he was retirement age, you know, and he was starting to smell the gates, I think, like he was starting to get a little bit tired or working with these Mexican kids because one of them just has a temper problem. And if you try telling him anything, he just gets really mad about it.

So this old dude apparently tried correcting him and this kid like acted like he was going to hit him. And so the older guy, the old white guy was like, fuck, I'm sick and tired of this shit, because that same day, one of the fucking cranes broke down and they fucking blamed him for it because he is the manager. Right.

But he's supposed to have a maintenance guy, doesn't have a fucking maintenance guy. So these fucking bullshit companies, they just they won't they're always passing the buck to somebody else. It's always blame the other guy kind of thing and spend as little money as possible.

And so you don't maintain your shit and it busts down and you're going to blame somebody else for it other than the fucking owners who need to fucking pay for this shit. The construction sites around here, they just hire them from out of, in many cases, out of the city here all the way to Calgary, which is two hours and forty five minutes drive away. And what companies do they hire? Jewish foremen and Arab workers and Negro workers, almost no white people in a town that's like probably at least 75 percent white in this town.

Hold it. Hold it. You're saying Jews work in construction.

What? I've never seen that. I've never heard of it in this in this country. They're the they're like the foreman in many cases.

They own it with these mega companies. Well, the foreman in the sense of the ones who who basically dictate. On the site, not not necessarily that only in terms of the office workers, but even the foreman are basically Jews in a lot of these companies.

OK, I've never. All right. Canada must be strange.

This is strange to me. Either that or you've got like a next level judar, like you've got an advanced judar, man, because I've never seen any kikes and any in any capacity working in construction. But whatever.

In any case, so this old white dude, he finally quit and he retired. He's like, fuck this shit,

I retire. And so they've been trying to find somebody to replace him and haven't really found anyone.

So, you know, these beaners cost a white guy his job. Well, I'm sure he was ready to quit it anyways. But they basically have cost this company, you know, a resource that they can't replace easily.

You know, all these companies, they want to act like a good worker is is totally expendable. Oh, good workers. They just grow on trees.

But it's not really the fucking case, I'm afraid. So anyways, this guy has been gone for like a month or so now. But I was talking to this Russian wigger kid about it because he didn't like the guy.

Obviously, you know, some little fucking millennial wigger isn't going to like a white man with authority who has some balls. So he didn't like the guy. But I was talking to him and I said, yeah, he's off enjoying that wet ass retirement.

He's having that swisher sweet retirement. He's rolling up that swisher sweet retirement. You know, I'm in front of the kid because he's too stupid to know that I'm making fun of him.

Like I can talk like a nigger to him to make fun of him. He's too fucking dumb to know that I'm trolling him. So I have a lot of fun with this.

But anyways, the next day after I said that, you know, we had a chuckle over it. But the very next day after I said that, he came in smelling like a fucking swisher sweet, like one of those fucking shitty grape, grape flavored nigger cigarettes. He came in smoking those.

So all I had to do was mention it. And this little fucking wigger kids is smoking these fucking nasty ass stank cigars. So that's the power of like that.

That's what happens when you got these 90 IQ fucking consumers. OK, so in that case, Strasser ism is correct. On that account, they understood.

Yes, that's what's happening. OK, they're breeding these stupid people. They're they're degenerating the culture.

They're taking it down to such a low level that like literally advertisement, the stupid bullshit advertisement that they use nowadays that works on people on a good number of people. It works. You know that like all I had to do was say that.

And just the other day, this fucking kid was saying some shit. He's like, oh, you know, these this Mexican guy who works here, well, he's got a girlfriend who's also Mexican and they've been together for like 10 years or so or whatever. And they're fighting right

now because his girlfriend supports Trump, but he doesn't.

And so they're really mad at each other. And I just looked at him and I was like, it's kind of a silly thing for for a couple to be fighting over, don't you think? You know, fucking Trump, all people, these two Mexicans are going to fight over. One of them supports Trump and the other doesn't.

That's about the most asinine thing I've ever heard of. But then this kid is like keeping it real with me. And he says, you know, Trump would be one of the best presidents we've ever had.

I would support him if he didn't talk about grabbing the pussy and if he wasn't such a racist. And I just thought, see, this is the shit this kid will literally say to me. He's like, oh, he's he's the greatest president we've ever had.

He's just like George Washington or Teddy Roosevelt. He belongs on Mount Rushmore, except he said, grab the pussy and he's a racist. This is the dumb shit these fucks will say.

And so I just kind of looked at him askew and I said, well, I guess he is a racist. He's a Jewish supremacist. He thinks the only thing that matters is Israel and everybody else exists to work and pay taxes so he can give the money to the these fucking Jews over in Israel.

And surprisingly, the kid didn't really like contest what I said. He was just like, oh, yeah, yeah, I guess you're right. Yeah, that's one way to pull up about Trump, about how he's just a charlatan because of his affiliation with with Israel and so forth.

It's pretty easy to actually demonstrate to people, regardless of their IQ, how he is basically nothing but a tool of the Jews. And from there, you can jump right into the Jewish, you know, influence if you want to take that risk, of course, of being known as a critic of the so-called chosen ones. Yeah, I mean, I don't really give any fucks at this point, like this is the good thing about the workplace that I'm at, you know, is that like one day I was really pissed off because some fucking tool wasn't working the way I wanted it to.

So I just screamed the word faggot as loud as I could and nobody did anything or said anything. Nothing happened to me. This was like a month or two ago.

So I guess next I'm going to test it out. I'm going to scream the word nigger next time something doesn't work out for me like I can't get this fucking these fucking boards together. I'm just going to scream nigger as loud as possible and see if anything happens.

I don't think it will, though, because basically every morning like at six in the morning

when we show up to work, this kid has got his fucking stereo. That's the other thing. A stereo is like the most prized possession to these people.

And he's blasting this fucking rap music and literally every song they just say the word nigger like 50 times, a hundred times teenager also. But I guess we can go on to, you know, how to get ourselves out of this cultural morass, this cultural decay, because, you know, we could go on forever with all the minutiae degenerates and what they do, because they're basically for basically lost people. For the most part, they're not going to be redeemable at all.

So what do we do about that? Exactly. Other than like you maybe just remove yourself from society detachment. I've spoken to plenty of people about creating parallel societies.

I guess it's sort of a default thing. You don't really have a choice in the matter. You pretty much have to create a totally separate enclave of living, you know, a living space that's totally distinct from everything and anything else.

Sort of purify yourself from that influence to the extent you're able to do so. Mm hmm. Well, I'm disappointed that you don't want to rant and rave about niggers all night with me, but yeah, I guess we should try and yeah, we should probably try to discover.

I should probably try and between the two of us, think of something, some way, some smarter approach for dealing with this bullshit. And yeah, so for removing yourself, like I basically so far in my life. Man, sorry, dude, I do this a lot of times when people invite me on their show, I talk over them.

It's like a thing I do. I really hate it. Sorry.

The audio is going to be shit. I was just saying the best thing that I do is just detach myself to the extent possible and not immerse myself with them and their gossipy pettiness, because that's all it all it ever redounds to is just a dragging of yourself down intellectually and in every other sense spiritually, dragging yourself down to the to the depths, basically, of that, you know, soap opera, a reality that they live in, these types of people. I can still relate to an improvement, but I can still relate to people like that, try to wake them up to some extent.

But for the most part, it's not really worth the while. It's just a sort of wasteful expenditure of your energies for the most part, trying to reach people who are sub IQ. I guess you could say, you know, the pop stars, wannabes and so forth.

Yeah, I hope I didn't give the impression that that's like what I'm trying to do. I hope that what people took away from that was that some guy said some bullshit to me. And so I just kind of like matter of factly said, yeah, it's the kikes.

You know, I mean, I ain't saying it to convince the kid because no one gives a fuck. Like he's some little man who's like he knocked up some Mexican skank who's like this kid's like twenty one. The fucking bitch he knocked up is like twenty eight and she's got two kids already and all this shit.

So, yeah, believe me, I understand what you're saying. Like, yeah, lost causes and all that shit. But the thing is, I try to bring it back to like make some kind of a poignant statement.

But anyways, as far as removing yourself from society, I don't know how it's working for you so far for me. It just doesn't really work out. I mean, if you mean if you're saying remove yourself from society as in don't go hang out with these people and like get drunk and do drugs with them, like just avoid them and don't do stupid shit like that and basically live almost like a monk, like an insular life where you basically work and then go home and, you know, watch your instead of watching your shows, your channels, have your own, of course, with who I find who is worthy of associating with.

Yeah, what you mean on the Internet or you mean in real life, because it basically never happens in real life as far as I've seen, like it's hard to find people. It depends on your your socioeconomic demographic and your sphere of influence, who you touch base with, what organizations or groups you could or potentially could form or involve yourself in or find, you know, those that currently exist. There are ways to meet people who are decent, but most people are so turned off by anything racial then, especially if you're known as a so-called racialist or racist, then you're shunned immediately.

In this town, I'm basically gang stalked everywhere I go and I'm, you know, notoriously known because they publicize it in the paper and all over the national news with, you know, pictures of firearms and stuff like that. So national news. Yep.

Wow, man. Sorry. But the Canada government.

Wow. What about the Canadian everything? Whatever. It's the same shit we got going on here, except I don't know if they would do it to that extreme level for like, I don't know, are you like rich or something or politically active? Are you just like a normal guy? It sounds like they're doing this shit just to a normal working class guy.

And it's like it seems fucking insane to me. Even our fucking media and our fucking government wouldn't do it because they wouldn't be any point. But yeah, they're just looking for scapegoat.

They're looking for somebody to set up as if they were this monstrous figure, this socalled terrorist type. That's what they do as part of their theatre of the real. You know, they just take whatever phenomenon actually exists organically and then they just amplify it or blow it up to make it appear as if it's something, you know, whatever suits their purposes.

Something that, well, it's not organically real, but just a sort of cartoonish caricature, basically. Yeah, yeah, definitely. They're looking for someone to blame for their bullshit faggot society and bullshit faggot kike bullshit just working out.

Yeah, they desperately need somebody to blame for the fact that nothing that they said they were doing, that they said was the right thing to do. None of it has ever panned out. None of it is working.

It's just bullshit. Yeah, they need somebody to blame for all the nigger shenanigans and all the crime and all the social decay. But in any case, as far as insulating your consciousness from these people and developing some kind of healthier habits, well, I think basically the only way to do it is esoteric spiritual practice.

Yeah, I would say so. Not normal tier spiritual practice. You know, I mean, in an ideal world, all of us would be like, you know, we should have a community.

Right. Yeah. And it's like we we say we've complained about this for years and it's just never happened to my knowledge.

And it seems like the only I don't know, at least plausible options for making it happen is like, I don't know, moving to some obscure European country that's like not as bad as the Western European countries. And like, hopefully, knowing some people there before you move, I don't know. Of course, is that, you know, Europe is basically overshadowed by Russia and by, you know, the Islamic invasion.

And there's, you know, droves of savages there also. And there's not much in the way of guns or anything of that sort that you can have. So far as I know, at least legally, so far as I know anyway.

And it's also very difficult to get EU citizenship also. Yeah, those are the main hang ups that I've had with it. But yeah, I understand what you're saying.

In any case, recently I was hanging out with some Buddhists. And it's funny to me here in the United States, like here in America, Buddhists are basically all white, like it's probably the whitest religion. Like, definitely, you're never going to find a Christian church that is as white as like a Buddhist hangout or a Buddhist group of people.

They're all elderly or like older people. They're all old, white, and basically shit libs. I think I saw a Biden 2020 sticker on one of their vans.

Yeah, usually it's liberals who gravitate toward the sort of peacenik enlightenment, socalled Eastern religious philosophies, if you want to call them that. Yeah, of course, even that is not really the authentic tradition of Buddhism, the ones that currently exist. It's all distorted through the mongrelization of the whites who originally created it thousands of years ago in Tibet.

I don't know if you're familiar with Julius Evola's The Doctrine of Awakening. No, that's another one on the list. That book definitely is something to investigate.

It discusses the original Buddhism, sort of analyzes it or, you know, presents it as it is, I guess. Yeah, I'll have to look into that one as well then. Right.

Well, I think that, you know, Buddhism, Buddhism and its current manifestation, I agree with you. I guess I was just remarking that, you know, basically it's all white people. And I saw like a Biden sticker on their car, but I didn't like talk to them about anything.

All I did was go there and I showed up like literally as they were beginning. So I just sat down on one of these little cushions that they had and they started ringing their bells and they said a little chant, I guess, but I didn't really know what they were saying. So basically all it was, it was kind of a ritual.

You know, they were using these bells that they were ringing that had various tones. But I'd never, this was the first time that I'd ever associated with any Buddhist people. Like I still haven't read much about it.

I've read a lot more about other various religious paths or theologies or mythology and that sort of thing. Buddhism is something I still don't know much about. So now I'm digging into it and learning about it, but they didn't teach me anything.

Like they didn't tell me anything about it or how to do it, how to meditate. We just sat there and did Zen meditation and probably partially, maybe even mostly the reason why I worked was because I was there with a group of people, right? And so their consciousness was like bleeding into mine or affecting mine. Yeah, it's in light of you.

Huh? Well, yeah, I don't know. In a sense, I suppose. But basically all I knew about it was what I'd read before, which is that it's, it's just a sitting meditation in which you don't, you don't really try to control your thoughts.

You just don't really mind them is what it is. You try to observe things. You try to be aware

You have meditative awareness, observation of everything. Which means no mindedness in Chinese, I think. Yeah, maybe.

So essentially, it's just awareness without discrimination or without, you know, without reaction. Right. And we were doing this outdoors because it was a nice morning.

So we were doing this in like a park and it was in a quieter part of the city. So I just noticed after a while I was, you know, for a minute I was fighting with myself, but then I

realized, no, I'm just not going to fight any of these thoughts that are coming up, like the mantra from this other meditation school that I'd learned. It's trying to come up, you know, this, this goddess and her bija mantra is what it's called.

You know, these mantras are associated with various Shaktis. Well, she's trying to find her way into my thoughts and I'm like, whatever, I'll let her come in if she wants or I'll just ignore her. I'm just not going to react.

So eventually that mantra went away. You know, there's birds squawking in the trees. And I started thinking, huh, these birds are squawking.

Should I be annoyed? No, I'm just not going to mind it. And then I just realized, well, you know, why are these birds squawking at each other? You know, that really be communicating much of anything. It's just that they're impelled to do it.

Right. You notice that everything in nature is making a noise, right? Yeah, I'm sure they notice. They might be making some mating calls or they might be communicating something basic to each other, but like how sophisticated of a communication can that be? They're just impelled to do it is what I concluded or what I thought in the moment.

Right. You know, a dog is barking in the distance here and there, you know, I think something magical happened because I just settled down all of a sudden, you know, my legs were bothering me because I've never been good at setting in this folded legs posture. I've actually heard that that posture obstructs energy flows and it's not some posture that's suited to meditation.

Yeah, maybe that could be it. So it's kind of uncomfortable, but I just realized I'll just ignore it and I'll just sit here. So what I'm saying is eventually I came to the conclusion that, you know, the natural world is making its noise around you.

You know, the world around you is making all this noise and it's only operating in this very low mental space where it feels the need to make these noises and interact with, you know, the material world in this way. But if you're conscious of that, if you're cognizant of that fact, and if you don't react to it, then you can achieve peace within yourself and then you can no longer be angry or frustrated or upset. You can set those things aside for the moment.

For me, and I think for Evola as well, the goal is not peace, but it's mainly integration of all the elements of your soul so that you have a consciousness which is very powerful and well developed so that you can resist, you know, stimuli from without that impinge upon your consciousness. That way you're not affected and you can dissociate yourself or detach yourself from that sort of maelstrom of sensa, that maya, the mayic veil around you. I guess they're also called the corrosive waters.

That basically Joy of Satan Ministries has got a lot of good meditations, power

meditations, where it's an attempt to try to work up the so-called kundalini and so forth and to control the will. Whether there is such a thing as chakras is a question, of course. You know, a lot of these metaphysical systems are very arbitrarily and artificially constructed based on the septenary system of the seven planets and the seven bodies and all this stuff.

According to Evel, that's not really a reality, or at least so far as I can recall him saying that with respect to the bodies that there aren't any actual chakras at all in that sense. So it's, you know, his opinion or his perspective, what he'll reveal. I'm not too sure what is or what is not.

Myself, since I haven't seen any chakras with my eyes or, you know, not necessarily sensed them, it's debatable whether they are actually a reality or not. But I know that most of the so-called spirituality that exists today is largely contrived and serves the Jews and their interests. Otherwise, they'd probably just shut it down immediately or even assassinate the people who, you know, tried to congregate or disseminate the message or, you know, teach others that same they'd probably just kill them off if it were something really a threat to them.

Sure. Most of those religions, it's mind control, basically. Sure.

You could make that distinction. Perhaps you could call it fortitude and tranquility rather than peace. The word peace, I understand the word peace just sounds so faggy nowadays.

Yeah, I just get annoyed every time I hear it. So maybe me saying it also has that same effect on other people. So I probably shouldn't say it.

Maybe you can make the distinction. And so the objective is to arrive at a state of fortitude and tranquility within yourself. Speaking of yourself internally, not insinuating that you have to be at peace with the obvious ill influences around you.

So what I'm saying is peace on the one hand, which is like an inverted life rune, flipped upside down, you know, the life rune, the El Haz rune, whereas all life is struggle and inactivity is death and peace is inactivity. It's the opposite of struggle. So peace is death.

That's why they say rest in peace, because that's what peace ultimately leads to, is to extinction. And that even in terms of their general political program, or if you want to call it the spiritual program of this pantheistic egalitarianism, pacifism that they're pushing on people and have been for millennia, this near eastern flight from reality, that's all about peace and all it leads to is death. Not only do they kill everybody who's not willing to bow down and who's even a little bit better under communism and under Christianity and so on, and Islam, but they also, it leads to that, to stagnation, basically, to entropy, this static system, as Spengler would call it, a sort of Magian soul, I guess, which is the

lewish soul or the Near Easterner.

That's what peace is all about, is this basically self-extinction. Whereas I think original Buddhism, according to Evella, I'm not too sure exactly, is mainly just about overcoming the samsaric influence of the spatio-temporal context and trying to transcend that in imminence, and then to basically strengthen yourself in relation to all that which is around you. So you become like a diamond body, I guess, is the term.

I'm not too sure, but that seems to be what its original intent was, is basically immortality and God-making, theurgy, more than it was about calm and so forth. But yeah, it serves that effect as well, meditation and so on. But that's where all these hippie types, they want to have peace, but if you're just going to lie down, then you're either one's going to be slaughtered.

Right. Well, as far as Buddhism and what it may have been originally, well, this was a Zen Buddhist group. Well, the word Zen is Japanese, right? And it's derived from a Chinese word.

When they took Buddhism from China to Japan, they changed it to Zen. But originally in China, it was called Chana. And that itself was also a corruption of the Sanskrit word, which was dhyāna.

And dhyāna is like a form of awareness meditation. Yeah, that's actually a derivative form of Buddhism also. I think, you know who Brian Roo is, right? Yeah, I'm aware of him.

Yeah, he's a Theravada Buddhist, and Theravada is sort of like the original Buddhism, so far as I know. Okay. Well, a thought occurred to me while I was sitting out there, because we were kind of in a natural setting, not quite.

We were just in kind of a nice little park. But I had this thought that maybe this concept of sitting in a natural environment, in a natural context, and practicing this awareness meditation, I thought maybe this is something similar to what the Druids and the Germanic people might have done. You know, there's this concept in German culture, and I'm going to mispronounce it, but it's called Waldein Samkeit.

And basically, it means the spirit of walking in the woods, or this sense of peace that you get, or yeah, there's that troublesome word against the sense of bliss you get from walking in the woods, right? Yeah, there's a Wagner song called, I think it's Forest Murmurs, or something like that, in Die Walküre, The Ride of the Valkyries, or the Nibelungen Saga. That seems to, you know, sort of connote that walking in the forest, in the woods, because I grew up in the woods, and I was always walking around there also. And it definitely enhances your consciousness, your awareness of things, whereas the city basically dampens your consciousness, like you're being put under assault, basically.

Yep. So that occurred to me, and I think that there's some historical basis for supposing

this, because both Julius Caesar and Tacitus, they both recorded that the Druidic and the Germanic, both the Gallic and Germanic temples were actually shrines in the forest, either in sacred groves, or they'd be somewhere in some natural setting, right? And I recall that Varg Vikernes had this theory that in the old pagan traditions, you were meant to go out into a totally natural area, where there wasn't even any hunting allowed. It was like a nature preserve, basically, in the ancient world, where there was no cutting of any trees, no taking anything.

You went into these natural areas to contemplate on nature, to observe nature. And obviously, if you observe nature, you understand that it doesn't function according to these pseudo-moralistic laws of modern society, right? Nature is its own game. But you sit there and you're aware of it.

Right. Nature is just the continuous ebb and flow of vital force. So observing that, then afterwards, maybe you can make some theories or conclusions about it.

But in the moment, the purposes of this meditation, you're just aware of it. You're observing it as it is, without any impositions or without making any judgments or conclusions on it. And the value of that pragmatically is that it enhances your consciousness and your intuition as well.

So it enables you to better perform in a warrior context, to understand other people and their thoughts, to be able to sense what they're thinking and what they're feeling, and so forth, when you have a heightened awareness. So that's why that sort of wilderness retreat type thing is very valuable, you know, to do on a periodic basis. If you can't live in the woods all the time, you know, not many people have that option because they're trapped in their cities and so forth.

But if you have that chance, and by all means, you know, go off into the wilderness. But of course, you know, make sure you carry a personal defense weapon with you. Culture.

Sure. Right. What I would propose is that probably we should be practicing a Druidic form of meditation, and I think that Zen might be helpful just to learn that.

But then again, I don't know if it necessarily is, because like I said, I really wasn't taught anything. I just went and did it. So obviously, if I just went and, you know, it just naturally happened, well then obviously you can probably do the same thing and it will naturally happen.

And I think that that's the way that the ancient European religions were beforehand. I think they included these concepts that you find in things like the Vedic culture, because I think that it was, I mean, it was made by the same people. It was our people that made it.

It was white people that created the Vedic cultures, right? And it's obviously devolved

since then, because it's been taken over by brown people. But in any case, yeah, you're right. Well, you said before about serious religious leaders being assassinated.

I think that's true, because Prabhupada was pretty based. I mean, in a certain way, I'm sure there are certain Magian— Say what? Was he assassinated? I'm pretty sure. Yeah, there's pretty serious evidence.

I guess I can't say conclusively, but there's a lot of mounting evidence that he was poisoned by his own followers. And I think it's Mukunda Dasa who says that these were Jews that came up with this idea to poison him. So I can't say for certain, but that's definitely been talked about by other people that are interested in the movement or followers of the movement.

So it appears there's a lot of evidence that he was poisoned. Well, he was very much a racist and sexist. I mean, not in a spiteful way, but in the sense that he recognized the realities of race and sex.

And he wasn't shy about this because it was old-fashioned. So he took these things seriously, and he spoke about the history of Europeans as Aryans. He spoke about these things pretty candidly.

So yeah, I think they would definitely get rid of people like that. The reason why, when you talk about slave systems, religions being used as slave systems, well, I can kind of see what you're saying. And I think the reason why a lot of these supposedly Eastern mysticisms filtered through the lens of Judeo liberalism and modernity, they're allowed to come in.

If I could just interject, that itself derives itself from original Near Eastern influence, like liberalism, communism, Christianity, and so forth. It's actually that which preceded it, like Orphism in Greece, and the Phoenician religion, and also Babylon and so forth. They had those sorts of religious ideologies then.

They were supremacistic when the Jews took them over and used them for their own purposes, but they still had proselytization of egalitarianism for others throughout. It was always this priestly caste hiding behind the scenes, pretending it was all about the earth, and one God, like Parmenides being in the one. They're always pushing this monotheistic oneness, that that's the purpose of everyone is just to merge with the source.

And of course, the priestly caste will be the ones to guide you, because they're the shepherd kings. They're the flock leaders who lead the sheeple. And of course, they live a corrupt hypocrite life, and practice the real demonological rites that empower them, and or they are the tools of whatever sort of dark forces that use them to enslave the whole world, basically.

And that's all the source of it, is basically Near Eastern, that whole Levant region, which

is where the Phoenicians live in what is now modern Israel, the state of Israel. Right. Well, what I was going to say is that the reason why it's coming in now, well, I think actually maybe you have a more developed idea of why they're allowing these Eastern religions in, but you know, there was some company that Carly Fiorina used to run, or she was involved in it, and they had this logo that is basically this Japanese Buddhist symbol.

It's like a Zen Buddhist symbol, and it's like a ring or like a circle, kind of like the Ouroboros. I was just going to say, yeah. Yeah.

Well, what's funny to me is that this businesswoman was the one who picked it for the logo. And I think a lot of the reason why they allow these meditation techniques to come in is because they assume that they're basically harmless, and maybe they are. They're basically harmless.

But essentially what it is, is it's like a bailout method. All these rich business people are interested in this stuff because they've lived a Wolf of Wall Street lifestyle, and it's like taking a toll on them. They've realized you can't just keep getting high on cocaine.

You can't just keep getting drunk. Eventually you're going to OD. You can eventually catch venereal diseases if you keep living this lifestyle.

They discovered that, and it hit them hard. So they got interested in this Eastern mysticism, basically just because they want to meditate to relieve stress. And I think that's the reason why they're pushing it on the sheeple, because they're discovering that people are killing themselves because of all this stress of modern capitalists.

Religion is the opium of the people. It's basically a tool for opening up the consciousness of the slave class to be basically zombified and lobotomized. And I mean in a spiritual or demonic sense, to be possessed by entities, and basically to be utilized as pawns to continue to, you know, their intention is to create chaos and then to just foment revolution and war, just to kill off as many numbers as they possibly can.

And religion in general has been, and always will be probably, to the extent that it exists, just a means of the priestly caste enslavement of the laity or the sheeple. So it's always the same paradigm. It's the pastoral priest kings, which derives from the Middle East, with the shepherd kings.

They're shepherding the wandering through the desert. And then they, you know, they're the ones who will be the intermediary between the one, or the Messiah, or God, and these laity, the lay people, who will then just have, you know, slavish subordination to the priest caste, you know, the Freemasons and the Jews, basically the upper tier of the trapezoid of power on this earth. And that's pretty much their main motivation.

I'm sure it also has like a soporific effect on the consciousness of the population to try to,

you know, calm them down and so forth, so that they can endure their servitude more easily without causing too much stress or problems or blowing up, you know, because that creates disturbances and wastes the, you know, resources of the state and so forth. But for the most part, I think it's mainly just a result of, just in the intention of actually just having these entities possibly coming onto the earth and even possessing the population, even going to that extent. However crazy that might sound, it definitely seems like a lot of these upper tier people are either possessed themselves or are, you know, influenced by whatever sort of infernal forces, as Evola would call them, they're below the human, you know, infra-human, they're dark energy matter entities that are actually being brought onto this earth.

I noticed that your name that you had used was Sons of the Old Gods, which is sort of what Lovecraft speaks about. Are you familiar with that Lovecraft mythos? Yeah, I'm a little bit familiar with Lovecraft and some of his themes, and it seems like somebody told me that he was married to a Jewess and he ended up committing suicide because he was just, like, freaked out about life, I guess. But basically, yeah, I'm aware of the idea that he has, and it's similar to a bunch of other, like, eastern mystic ideas of this, like, collection of demonic entities that are not really... they're like some kind of spiritual entities, I guess, or some kind of elemental, like, entities that exist in the universe, and they have bred these various slave races that maintain shrines to them and give sacrifices to them and so on, and so they hybridized with these different, you know, races of humans or subhumans.

That would be the Jews. Well, that's basically the relationship that Yahweh has with the chosen race, and obviously the way that this guy got these ideas is from his Jew wife, I'd imagine. So yeah, I understand.

Well, his father was Freeman Sniper. Yeah, well, that's probably another source of his ideas. Another source of inspiration for him, then.

So yeah, that's definitely a theory. You know, it says in the Bhagavad Gita, I think Krishna said this to Arjuna, he said that the earth is like a cow, and both the demons and the gods are like bulls, and they will fight each other for possession of this cow. So that's what we've got.

It's kind of like a Mortal Kombat meme, you know, that's basically what Mortal Kombat is. It's like, oh, there's this Johnny Cage. Yeah, right.

Yeah, well, you have to fight the demons that are trying to invade earth, right? And if they win these tournaments, then they get to come and invade, you know, do whatever. The reason that they make these video games, you know, like Doom, as well as another game of a similar theme. Yeah, yeah, that too.

It makes your consciousness just flooded with demonic images, and you obsess over

demons and all this. But I mean, in Mortal Kombat, I mean, it basically is the same story, though. You know, you have the thunder god Raiden, who's basically like a combination of Thor with some sort of like, eastern deity.

And he's protecting the humans. Yeah. And he's fighting against the demons to protect the earth, right? Just given the pervasiveness of these motifs throughout all texts, you know, that were once originally Aryan, it does seem to me that this may very well be the actual reality.

Because I don't know if you've, you've heard of Bill White and his writings and his involvement in the movement. William A. White. I remember the name, I remember the name, but I can't, I'm not familiar with any of his material, though.

I do remember hearing about him. Yeah, Bill White. He wrote a book called The Tradition of the Mother, which, where he discusses these sorts of issues.

And he states that, you know, these sort of Cthulhu-like beings are actually in the earth, some of these entities. I don't know if you're familiar with that Gnostic intaglio of Yaldabaoth, that lion headed serpent entity. I know a little bit about Gnosticism.

It's probably something else I need to research more of, but I'm aware of their theory that basically, like, materialism is created by this demiurge. And it entraps souls, and they're trying to liberate themselves, you know. And even this Aeon Sophia is essentially like the world, right? She's this goddess of wisdom who's trying to find her way back to... Yeah, and that's first Hyperborea, according to Serrano.

She's basically dragged down. Yeah, I mentioned the lion-headed being Yaldabaoth is what they called them in, I think it was the hypostasis of the Archons, or the, no, the Pistis Sophia of the Gnostics. And this being is, like, depicted as a sort of worm-like, lion-headed entity.

And, you know, the Cthulhu beings are like this sort of octopus-headed entities that are, you know, sort of worm-like also. And there's what Bill White referred to in The Tradition of the Mother, which discusses this mother-goddess cult, which is a very interesting book. At the end of it, he refers to this Egyptian papyrus called the, what is it called, something about this sailor named Senuhi.

And he goes to an island, and he discovers this lion-headed serpent being. So, these are all very interesting and weird parallels, whether they actually exist in reality. You know, there are lots of themes of this nature, and I wouldn't discount that as a reality, because I'm, you know, open-minded enough not to be too literalist in the, you know, mainstream materialist sense, that it's just atoms and electrons, or psychological processes, or brain states.

It may very well be the case that something like that is going on at this very time. But of

course, it's all speculation, unless you've had personal experience of these sorts of things. I know I have personally had experience of, like, shadowy figures bombarding me at various times throughout the last decade.

So, I'm not too sure. You know, we could always say that that's just mind control, or it's just delusion, or, you know, figment of imagination, but I sense these sorts of things. So, to me, that is a reality, and not just, you know, a crazy fantasy, or something of that sort.

I would like to know more about it. I don't know what sources to consult, though. That's the thing.

Yeah. Well, your connection cut out a little bit, but I heard you say that you've seen shadow people, or shadow figures, or things like that. Is that what I heard? Yeah, like dark energy matter entities.

Yeah, well, I don't know what that means. Well, it's basically just entities. I don't know, energy and matter are like two different things, as far as I'm concerned.

But, yeah, well, I've seen the same thing, so I know what you're talking about. You know, I mean, it's been a long time ago now, for me. But, yeah, I understand the concept, and yeah, I think that, I mean, I'm not a, I don't know, I mean, materialist, you know, there's difference between materialist and materialist, right? Well, I'm not really a materialist, in the sense that it's commonly understood.

Like, I'm not like one of these atheist types, who just, yeah, who just denies everything that they perceive, or everything that they see, or sense, because they think that, like, literally, unless something physically touches them, or physically hits them, it didn't actually happen. You know, like, if they can't physically grab something, it doesn't exist. So, I'm not like that, really.

That's not my world view. Because I've had, you know, a lot of experiences that just are not, that don't fall into the category of, like, something tangible. But I experienced them, yeah.

But I experienced them, and I experienced them fairly regularly. I mean, not so much in the darker aspects anymore, because, you know, I've started meditating, and I do regular religious practice, so that doesn't happen as much anymore. But... that capacity.

Or maybe you're communing with some type of entities that are of a more positive, benevolent nature. Right, well, that's the whole impetus behind the name Sons of the Old Gods. Because according to our sagas, Odin sired the kings and heroes of the Nordic race.

And so we're descended from our gods. And also, Odin is called the All-Father, meaning he's the father of gods and men. He's the father of everyone, you know, of everything.

He's the creator, according to our sagas. So yeah, that's what that essentially means. And yeah, that's absolutely what my religious practice is all about, is that I give offerings to Thor.

Specifically, he's the one that I pray to the most, for protection, also to help me do the right thing. I think he was like more of the original god. I've heard that Odin is sort of, in a way, a syncretic figure that was introduced by whatever sort of cross-pollination of different mythologies, but not too sure about that.

But Thor is definitely the storm god or the lightning god. He's the one who's sort of like the creator. Mm-hmm.

Well, there are some people who argue that. Sorry, what? I was just going to ask you just in relation to the sons of the old god lineage, would you happen to have like webbed fingers or toes to some extent? No, why? Because I do. And my mother and grandmother both do, and they're both pure-blooded Danes from Denmark.

So that to me suggests that there's some sort of relationship, because if you look at the Babylonian and Sumerian mythos with Enki and things of that sort, Oannes in Babylon, they were all portrayed as these sort of like fish-type deities. Oh, you mean like Dogon or Dagon? Oh, not necessarily that, but Enki and these beings, I guess they were called the Anunnaki there, that that may very well be what these old gods are. And we are obviously, almost certainly, the ancestors of those beings.

You know, the blue-eyed, blonde-haired, white Nordic person being the purest of the types. Sure. Well, I'm not pure Nordic.

Sorry, guys, I hope I didn't mislead you. But I'm about like 25% Scandinavian. And then I'm also, you know, another 25% German.

And those are commonly, like those are generally assumed to be related ethnic groups, right? Or racial groups, rather. But sadly, the other half of my bloodline comes from the British Isles. So, unfortunately, I'm not like a good swimmer, you know, or one of the fish people or anything like that.

No, I'm not. That's interesting, though, I hadn't heard of that before. I didn't know that Danish people had like a high occurrence of webbed toes or webbed fingers.

I mean, I've heard various... Related to these sorts of beings, because these beings allegedly had six fingers on their hands, too. Right. I've heard of that before.

But, yeah, I mean, I've heard of cryptozoology theories that like there might have been people who, you know, were adapted to swimming really well, like they might have had, you know, almost like flippers or whatever. I've never delved too much into that, personally. But yeah, I would agree with you, though, with the previous point that you

made that a lot of this like Eastern mysticism and a lot of these modern priests and mystics and yogis or whatever, well, first of all, a lot of them are just outright frauds.

But yeah, I think it is a shepherding operation to a large degree. A lot of them, they just embrace these really ridiculous liberal ideas. It's astounding to me that they'll mention or reference or they'll cling to like Eastern traditions or like the Vedas, you know, when literally you read the Rig Veda and it talks about Indra being yellow haired as in blonde and how much he despises dark skinned races and how he's the protector of the Arvan race.

And they say specifically the Aryan color, which is white, because if you look at all these, if you look at all these Aryan figures like Bhishma, like he has several names that literally translate to fair skinned. He has a white body. He's white.

You look at Arjuna and I think his name literally means white. And it's also related to Aryan etymologically. Yeah.

Right. So like refers to the sun, I think. Yeah.

So it's very clear that these are racial terms that the language is speaking. And if you read things, if you read any of their law books like the Manusmriti, like it's a really hard, hardcore legal, legalistic culture. And they did not like sexual deviance and they did not like dark skinned people.

And it's just it's it's too plain, really. Whereas the Christian... And then you have these modern... They will they'll come in and they'll start saying, oh, your ancestors were pagans who were drinking baby blood out of goat skulls. You got to be a Christian identist because otherwise you're a faggot and a degenerate.

A Christian identist? That's what they call themselves, right? The identity, Christian identity types. I never paid very much attention to any of that stuff, to be honest. But anyways, yeah, a lot of these modern yogis and it's not even necessarily just the modern ones, like some of them like Dogen, who was a Japanese monk who started the Zen practice.

You know, I was reading a little bit about him and apparently he was always preaching on the equality of men and women. Right. And a lot of these modern yogis, too, they're always talking about how it's important that women aren't oppressed and how we have to have equality with women.

Women need to be free to do this. They need to be liberated and do that. Or they really hate Muslims because supposedly they're oppressive towards women, you know, so on and so forth.

Then on top of it, they preach defense of homosexuality. A lot of them, it's an astounding

number of them, preach tolerance of homosexuality, that homosexuals are not to be harmed. These precious faggots have to be protected, right? And women have to be regarded as equal in every way.

They have to have all these equal opportunities. And I'm just thinking, these are people that live in America or in the West. And I just cannot understand their obsession with these things, because for one thing, women are not really—you live in a white country, guy.

If you're so adamant about women not being oppressed, then you ought to come out with some integrity and say, yeah, that's why I practice in a white country. That's why we live here in white countries, is because women aren't treated like dogs here. That's just kind of the way we are.

If it's right or wrong, I don't know. I mean, when they talk about this ridiculous nonsense about the equality of men and women, I'm just wondering, what have you ever experienced that led you to believe this other than reading it somewhere or hearing it from some shit-lib faggot kike? Whatever convinced you that men and women were equal in any sense? Because it's intuitive that they're not equal in a physical sense. So therefore, you come to the realization, oh, they mean in a spiritual or a moral sense.

But in that case, we're definitely not equal, because women have certain intuition or certain spiritual abilities that most men don't have. Some men have it. Usually it takes a lot more effort for a man to cultivate it.

But in terms of spiritual things like honor or dharma, women are definitely not the equals of men, because they don't care about those things, generally. Generally, it takes a lot of effort to raise a woman to care about honor or dharma or integrity. Generally, women are spiteful.

They don't care about those things. So I cannot comprehend why anyone would think that we're equal to them in any sense, and definitely not in a moral sense, because we have to come up with all these extra both legal and extra legal protections, these moral protections and moral status and categories for women that do not apply to men at all in the slightest. Nor should they, and I'm not saying that that is wrong.

Obviously, women have to be protected. I don't think anyone could reasonably argue to the contrary. Yes, we have to have special protections for women, but I just cannot understand this equality nonsense.

Even the people who say, oh, we don't endorse equality here. Everybody is unique. It's like, well, then what is all of this male feminist bullshit about? Like Jason Reza Jorjani is one of these fucking people.

He's one of these new pseudo-mystics who's obsessed with feminism. It's like, you're not

an Iran guy. You're not in the Middle East.

You're here in America. You're not living in a sand nigger culture. Why are you harping on this shit? You're preaching to the fucking choir here.

And as far as I know, this has always been- Yeah, exactly. They're just trying to, that false association so that they can osmotically drip it in, or like a coffee maker, they're just to try to drip it into the consciousness of the population. That way they can shift attention away from what the chaos that they've caused towards a more universalist, egalitarian, slave religion, Mother Gaia worship, and whatever sort of messianic figure that they bring out.

It'll be Maitreya, the theosophical so-called messiah that they'll be trying to bring out that can unify people. And then the Muslims will think it's one thing, and the Christians will think it's Jesus, and so forth. So that way it will just subordinate everybody under the United Nations after the chaos that they stage.

And then they'll just claim that it's some sort of prophecies or historical inevitabilism, as in the case of theosophy, which is obviously their little psyop that they're running. So again, it's just a priestly caste, shepherd kings, architects of chaos, of destruction, trying to dialectically create their order. — Yeah, they're so shamelessly trying to graft on these concepts of feminism and sodomy and race mixing and the love of homosexuality.

They're trying to graft these things onto ancient traditions where they have no place, and it's explicit even in the text. They've done this with European traditions, and they do this because a lot of the records were destroyed. There's very little record of it.

But even what little record or information we have refutes what they say. Even the Romans, who didn't like our Germanic ancestors, they really did not see them as—definitely not as a friend, but they didn't see them as an equal culture. But even they with their records refuted this bullshit.

But in terms of the Vedas or the Sanskrit cultures, it's absolutely shameless, because all it takes is for you to just know what you're looking for and look it up, and you can see that, no, they clearly did not endorse that at all. — Well, most of these people, these New Age people especially, the liberals like you had encountered there, they're willfully ignorant reality deniers. Every time there's something unpleasant, they shift their consciousness away, because that's what that whole mentality is, that cowardly—like William L. Peirce said about liberals, that they have this sort of feminine cowardly

That's the sort of default mode of their consciousness, and that's why they gravitate toward those sorts of so-called pseudo-spiritual practices, is because they're just inherently effeminate. And so they naturally gravitate toward that which is pacifistic and

mentality where they just ignore anything that makes them feel unpleasant.

wimpy whereas myself, even though I may not be the toughest and roughest being on earth, I've always instinctively had an aversion toward anything that's sort of weak and wimpy and pacifistic. It always struck me as sort of, you know, completely repulsive, basically.

— Yeah, it always struck you as way too fucking gay. Yeah, well, you mentioned the prophecy fags and all this inevitable-ism of these dumbass fucking desert scrolls. I don't know where the fuck—obviously this comes from the general stupidity of people that just don't bother to look anything up or read anything.

If they knew anything about the Bible, they'd go to, I think it's 2 Kings. They'd go to Kings and the Bible. Okay, if you're all about this prophecy bullshit, if you really endorse, if you believe in the prophecies of Abrahamism, of the Yahweh tradition, okay, go to 2 Kings and the Bible.

Or just Google it. Just look up Qemash, the god of Moab, the Moabites. Look up the episode wherein Yahweh promised the victory to the Jews.

He foretold, he gave them a prophecy that the Israelites would defeat the Moabites. So he gave them this prophecy, he promised them the victory, and in the course of the battle, the king of Moab called on Qemash, his god, and Qemash came down and blasted the Israelis the fuck out. They lost.

So Yahweh's prophecy was overturned. Like that. — Yeah, there's a really— even in his own book, it admits that his prophecies are overturned.

So Yahweh was never anything other than like a dust devil competing with the other dust devils of the Middle East. And the funny thing is that Solomon adopted Qemash as his god later on. Solomon made offerings, he made shrines to Qemash, the Moabite god.

So I can't believe these people who think that this kike bullshit is like made of concrete when it's obviously made of fucking—of air, of hot air. What? — It's made of clay and iron, basically, as they say in the Bible. That's what their religion is made of.

Clay and iron. Yeah, because they can't - I mean, even that would be something. This is just shit that's made of paper.

— Well, yeah, it's a castle in the sky. There's an interesting article by Bill White in the tradition of the mother book called Yahweh Unmasked, which goes through the etymology and the history of this entity that is now called Yahweh. And it just turns out to be some sort of female deity that's like a syncretic deity with Baal, basically.

Baal and Asherah and a bunch of similar Near Eastern gods, not some sort of absolute man. Yahweh as a goddess. That's funny.

All the Semitic goddesses—all the Semitic deities started off as goddesses. Allah is the same way. — Yeah, it's interesting.

— And I heard that— yeah, what? — I was just going to say there's another interesting book called Moonotheism about that, that proves that Allah is a moon god. Yeah, I seem to recall hearing once that in the olden times there was this priesthood that maintained the Kaaba there in Mecca, and they were called the Sons of the Old Woman. That's what they referred to themselves as.

So these were some kind of weird goddess worshipers. And a lot of this goddess worship was really firmly established in the Middle East in ancient times. There was this certain temple design where they'd make these temples that were eight-sided, right? And the eight-sided star is also a symbol of these Middle Eastern goddesses.

Yeah, right. Semiramas or whatever the Babylonian or whatever the— — Astarte. — Yeah, Astarte, yeah, Astarte.

Everywhere you go now, you've got that eight-pointed star throwing itself in your face. In this contemporary world. — Yeah, right.

Well, Dugan and Heimbach and their boys were using it, and it's basically a symbol of Jesus, because, I mean, it says it pretty much point-blank in the New Testament that Jesus is the morning star. And it's funny to me that this, you know, twin crosses or eight-pointed star has been so commonly associated with him, and he says it pretty explicitly, I'm the morning star, right? — Yeah, so he's Venus, basically. He's a woman.

He looks like a woman, he acts like a woman, you know, he's always turning the other cheek and judging the knot, and he's washing the feet of lepers and wearing his diaphanous robe and having his long hair and so forth. You know, it's a pretty feminine figure, actually. — Yeah, I mean, he wears a white robe, which is basically, it's symbolic of a wedding gown, which is to say that he's symbolically married to the deity, right? I mean, that's the way a lot of the ancient priests used to do it, so I don't think that he really looked any different from any ancient priests of the time, right? Because they were practicing the same thing, you know, they were in these ritual marriages with their god, you're right.

So yeah, I'm aware of that. He would even wear a shawl, apparently it was depicted as wearing a shawl anyways, so yeah. It's kind of, he's like the perfect representative of Illuminati globo homo, right? Like of this sort of, like, nobody is a man and nobody's a woman, everybody's half and half, somewhere in between effeminate men or dykish women.

Androgyne of the Rosicrucians. — Yeah, right. Yeah, so religion, it's almost impossible to sort all the kinks out of it.

Yeah, it's very simple. — So basically I've concluded that I can only really rely on my own gods, right? And you mentioned that Thor, you think that he was the original god, and I've seen some, there's some basis for thinking that, I suppose. There are some people who theorize that originally Tyr was the ultimate god in Germanic mythology, you know, Tyr or Tiwaz.

Have you listened to that discussion I had with Nordlux Bellator on this channel? He goes into a lot of detail about the original gods from the Scythians and so forth, that were all related to Thor, that it's all the storm god, basically. Right, yeah, he's a buddy of mine, and yeah, I've talked to him about a lot of this stuff, and you know, he would tell me about the Bogateurs, or as the Russians call them, the Bogateurs. And so the word Bogateur contains both the Sanskrit word baga, which means lord, and tyr, the Germanic word which means, you know, the war god.

So basically these are the warriors of god, these are like holy warriors or warriors of god, right? Kind of like berserkers. So you might say that Odin is some kind of syncretic god, or maybe he was some sort of Scandinavian deity who was there before this sort of Germanic tradition, or yeah, it's almost like a pan. He's sort of like a rising and dying god himself, you know, Osiris, Dionysus, Christ, all these gods are rising and dying gods, and Orpheus, you know, they sacrifice themselves to themselves, and you know, they get banged up on a cross, or crucified, and so forth.

Right, well, in the case of Odin, he says explicitly that I sacrifice myself unto myself. Yeah, that's sort of the basis of Christ's story. Maybe, you could see it that way.

I don't know, I think the Romans made a difference. I'll just mention, there's a book called The Christ Conspiracy by Akaria S., who is probably assassinated afterwards, even though she's like a feminist New Age type, it still refutes Christianity pretty well, The Christ Conspiracy. Right, I've heard of that.

Well, in the case of Odin, he says that I sacrifice myself to myself, right? So, I feel like, obviously, this is a paradox that needs to be inspected, you know, this needs to be investigated. It's something you have to think about. Well, I don't know, I would say you have to think about it.

I guess you have to think about it in the way that I think. But essentially, what he's saying, while the very practice of sacrifice implies, it implies a offering or a transaction from a lower party to a higher party, right? I mean, to me, it does. If you're performing a sacrifice, you're giving up something in exchange for something else.

And in the case of the religious context, if you're performing a sacrifice, you're giving something to the gods, right? It's either out of devotion, or it's either that you're giving this to them out of devotion, or you're giving this to supplicate them, you're appealing to them for their help, right? Well, in the case of Odin, sorry, you're doing the whole robot

thing, you're cutting out. Oh, it could be an alchemical allegory as well of sacrificing your lower self to your higher self, you know, like a metaphor or whatever. That's essentially the route that I was going to take, because essentially, this is a theme that's in Aryan religion.

This is in the Vedas, right? That these various deities, these various devas, they recognize this ultimate god in the form of Vishnu or Narayana as their inner self, right? Because that's what the Vedic cosmology establishes, is that Vishnu, the preserver, or Narayana, Narayana, the ultimate source, he's the source of all beings, of their very essence, of their very consciousness. He's the source of their souls. So at various points, all of the other gods, including Indra and Rudra, or Shiva, these gods are found worshiping Narayana, right? So I think that there's something similar happening in this case with Odin, where he's sacrificing himself to himself.

What he's implying is that he is sacrificing his lower self to his higher self, or maybe his outer self to his inner self. So he's acknowledging that there is an ultimate form of himself, or a higher form of himself. Well, it's imminent transcendence.

Right. So when people cast aspersions at Odin, usually I just ignore it, because to me, it's far more complicated than most people will ever understand. And so, you know, from my own interactions with him, in terms of my own religious practices, I don't pay any mind to anyone who says anything derogatory towards Odin or any of the ancient Aryan gods, because they just don't understand them, as far as I'm concerned.

If you understood them, you wouldn't treat them in that way. That's just my personal experience. And then you have... And my experience is that Odin's incredibly powerful, and he's incredibly sophisticated.

He's a being that strikes down to the core of every Nordic man, whether they know it or not. Whether they know it or not, his influence is there. He gave his eye to the wisdom.

He gave his physical eye for, you know, the third eye, I guess you could say. Maybe so. That might also be another esoteric... That might be another metaphor for him sacrificing one of his sense organs to achieve higher wisdom, which is another theme in Aryan religion, is that you're to control the sense organs and cultivate the mind for the understanding of higher truth, of transcendent truth, you know, spirituality.

And then you have the Christians, of course, inventing Jesus, which is just being simply a physical man, being physically sacrificed so that he could go to some Jewish god, and all you have to do is worship a Jewish god, and the Jews render unto Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and, you know, don't bother opposing it. So it's the inverse of the Aryan tradition, assuming that is the Aryan tradition in its proper authentic original form with Odin sacrificing his lower self to his higher self. If that is the case, then the Jews basically just stole all the motifs of the Aryan religions, synthesized them together into this man-

god called Jesus, and then they just forced that onto Aryans at the point of a sword, and mind controlled them from birth through trauma-based mind control.

And then, you know, they ended up for 1700 or more years, depending on the country or the region of the earth, they ended up basically serving the Jews up to this present day. Right. In the case of Jesus and the human sacrifice, you might be onto something with the way that Christianity is commonly understood, or, well, it's not really understood, to be honest.

But the thing is, when we're talking about sacrifice in Aryanism, I think you're correct, or at least you're in the right direction, because in Aryanism this sacrifice exists called parusha-medha or nara-medha, and they both mean the sacrifice of a man, right? But I think that in the original understanding of it, this was a ritual by which somebody would give up their physical body in order to liberate their spirit, liberate their soul, right? Just think of me, it means— And this man's sacrifice— The lower states of consciousness that trap you in matter, that way you're transcending and imminent. You're not giving up your physical body, but you're spiritualizing your physical body because your consciousness is elevated. So it's like the concept of, I think it's Tao Te Ching, Wei Wu Wei, acting without acting, Zen Satori, where you're basically not being affected by things and you're controlling things and not being controlled by them.

You're not being pulled down into samsara. Right. Well, there's a number—I mean, I've heard of at least one guru who really tries to make this distinction between us and God, right? He is really offended by these people who think that— who try to connect or unite our individual self with our higher self, you know, meaning God, meaning the ultimate, because we're limited beings, right? I mean, at least our consciousness is conditioned so that we think that we're limited beings.

But according to this whole theology, if our soul is immortal and comes from an immortal source, then by necessity we have to be immortal and we also have to be part of that source, right? Yeah, but we're not necessarily— In our deluded state, we don't understand that. In the case of mainstream religions, with all this peace, you know, this pantheistic peace type talk, that is basically—leads to the extinction of yourself because you become weaker as a soul and then you just merge with the One. So, things like the Aryan tradition, in my opinion, so far as I know, the whole point of it is to resist the current of disintegration, to resist that—the weakness, you know, you're not allowing your soul to atrophy, you're keeping it strong, and that way you can attain immortality by properly integrating all the aspects of your soul through proper spiritual practice and life, and your life would be like a sort of a perpetual rite of spiritual practice in all dealings with all things, and that would make you sort of like a god-man or, you know, a gentleman, as it says in the Confucian tradition, that that is what the true, the higher man is, the superman of Nietzsche, is not merging with God for in the name of peace and so forth, but simply transcending in eminence and cultivating a spiritualized physical

body so that you attain literal immortality.

—Well, I don't know so much about theories of that kind. I know you mentioned something called Joy of Satan. I'm not really familiar with those theories very much, like things like maybe Alistair Crowley might have said.

—No, I squinted. —I mean, right. Well, I don't really know about that, but I guess the way I look at it is a little bit different from that.

I guess what you're saying reminds me of something that Varg Vikernes once said, that he thought that honorable people or virtuous people would continue to live on, they'd be reincarnated, they would have ongoing lives, you know, their soul would continue to live, whereas dishonorable people or degenerate people, their soul would essentially fizzle out, you know, like a flame dying. They'd basically cease to exist or they'd subsumed back into the collective vital force that would then be, you know, recycled into something else. But it would lose all of its consciousness and lose all of its spiritual progress, essentially.

—According to Julius Paul, you have lesions on your soul. So that basically creates like, you know, you shred your soul through living a life that's not harmonious, you know, that's not according to your proper true self. So it creates schism and tension, which causes fragmentation, not integration.

—Right. Well, that sort of idea kind of appeals to me in a way, because when I look at the low forms of consciousness around me, I just can't imagine that they're going to be—I just don't see that it's very efficient or very meaningful that they should continue to have lives over and over again just for the sake of playing out these cycles of karma they can't even recognize, that they're not even cognizant of. And, you know, allegedly at some point, by chance, they'll become aware of it.

I guess that maybe that's possible. I mean, it's kind of happened to me in my own life, you know, by various, you know, chance encounters or by, you know, finding various books or coming across various information, I've kind of come to understand things in a different light, you know. So maybe there is some—maybe there's something to be said for such an idea.

But I think the idea that you're going to reincarnate as like, I don't know, a dog or a snake or a bug or an insect or whatever, or vice versa, that an insect is going to become a human being, like, that never made much sense to me. No, it's just a question of, you know, basic, if you want to call it physics or metaphysics, you're a certain type of being of a certain structure. And when your physical body degrades and atrophies, you know, this might be correlated with the atrophy of your soul.

Also, if you live a dissolute, degenerate life, then it causes more atrophy and

degradation of your soul. But when your physical body dies, you know, whatever remnants of your consciousness, of that energetic pattern that is your soul, you know, they exist still within that same blueprint, that same soul blueprint. You know, it's not like something totally dissimilar, like an insect or whatever, because those are distinct forms.

We're basically differentiated forms of conscious entities. And so, you know, when we physically degenerate and die, die in the physical, the body ceases to exist, then the higher principles of consciousness just continue on. And then either they'll be absorbed into the collective consciousness of the race, because of the principle or the law of attraction, you know, like magnetism, because of its sympathetic resonance, it just goes back into the oversoul, or else it's powerful enough that it can just potentially transcend to a higher dimension or something, like going to a different region.

Like I've heard Orion is actually one of the regions that some of these claimants, they claim that the soul goes to. Because, you know, there's often a lot of symbolism and so forth related to the constellation of Orion and Sirius, Sirius B, like with the Egyptians. So, yeah, maybe that's the case.

But otherwise it would be your soul is not powerful enough to ascend, so you just reincarnate, if your soul is not too weak to fragment, in which case it would just be like recycling of the elements of your being. Right. Well, such an idea, I can kind of understand that, and I can kind of appreciate it a little bit more in some ways, especially in the case of the existence of a racial soul, right? That's something that I don't think I've ever seen any modern gurus or any modern priests ever discuss, you know, outside of like the Third Reich.

But after that time period, no one... Right. So, I need to read more about what Evola has to say about it, I suppose. I mean, I know that it was a concept in National Socialism of a race soul, of a folk soul, or a racial soul.

And that appeals to me because, I mean, just from my own experiences, when I went to Scandinavia, like when I went to Sweden and Iceland, and I went to the old Viking grave sites, in particular there was one instance where I saw the skeleton of a Viking warrior at a museum, and I saw his sword, and there were just a few bones of him left. Well, as I was walking through the museum, all of a sudden I felt something, felt like his spirit, like I could understand his feelings, like I could understand, you know, the circumstances of his death and his burial. And so, from that I... There's probably different times too, you know, like different aeons or whatever, where time for them and their dimension is probably like nothing compared to this.

Sure. So, that may very well be the case, that there were a presence there, even though they might have died thousands of years on this earth within the spatio-temporal time frame, you know, in the longevity of their soul form, probably or possibly, you know, could be something totally dissimilar to ours. Right.

Well, the sense that I felt at the time, and what it led me to believe, is that if we're all connected to each other through a racial soul, then it's possible for us to share experiences, or share feelings, share intuitions with each other, because we're connected by that overarching racial soul, or by that over-soul of the race, right? Yeah. Not necessarily that his spirit had to come as an individual entity to visit me, but maybe just that some part of its essence was able to bleed into my consciousness by virtue of that racial soul that we share. Yeah.

Well, in the Vedic system it does talk about ancestors, it calls them the Peters or the Peters, I think, which is basically related, yeah, which is kind of like the Latin word pater, you know, father. So, the ancestors are mentioned, and it's important to venerate them in Juva. Keep in mind there's Jupiter, as in Jupiter.

Right, yeah, Jupiter, or even Mars Pater, that's like an expression that they would use in, I think it was Ambervalia, was the festival, a harvest festival dedicated to Mars in Roman days. Yeah, well, so they'd refer to these gods as like their father, right? And in the Vedic tradition you're supposed to venerate your ancestors, right, and give offerings to them. So there is sort of a concept there, and this is a pan-European concept, because in like the Tuscan culture and like various cultures in Italy during the Roman days, you know, they would go into their ancestors' tombs and conduct rituals there and give offerings to their ancestors.

And what's interesting to me is that in their language they called them Aesir, you know, the spirits of their ancestors, they referred to them as Aesir, whereas in the Nordic tradition they called them Aesir. Yeah, there's lots of linguistic cognates in all these traditions because it's just a result of, you know, the migrations of the Aryans from Hyperborea originally that distributed themselves over the Earth, and then they took the runes with them, they took the language, and then it's just subtle variations on the theme throughout, you know, thousands of years of history on the Earth. Right, yeah, if you look at a lot of ancient alphabets or ancient symbols, a lot of them look like runes, like there's a lot of them that are like exactly like the runes.

Well, Chinese hexagrams are based on the runes because it's a hexagram, it's a six-sided figure, and all the runes fit into a six-sided figure. Yep, right, I've heard that before too. Yeah, so there's so much for the claims of the Chinese pretending that they're such ancient superstars of spirituality.

Yeah, I don't really treat with credibility anything that Chinese people say, I just regard them to be some kind of, they're just some kind of weird yellow apes, they're some kind of weird mongrels, and I don't really regard them with any seriousness. I think that if we'd let the Japanese deal with them, that we would not even be fucking talking about them or thinking about them now. They're just an inferior culture that basically, basically

the capitalist kikes decided to let them, I think really after America came in and bombed Germany, I think that after that, the capitalist higher-ups, they made the decision, we're going to tolerate the existence of all of the backward tribes and all the worst, most gangsterish, most degenerate cultures imaginable.

We're going to let them rise to prominence because they're not a threat. It's too easy to control them because they're just fucking dog work. They were basically brought to prominence as a means of genociding white people through empowering them and disempowering whites and then empowering them and inciting them to violence against white people, basically.

Have you ever read something like that, I guess, but read who? Jörg Lanz von Leibenfels, his Theozoology book. No. It was around the before the Third Reich.

Hitler was a big fan of his literature, his Ostra magazine. Man, you've read a lot of like you pretty well read. I'm impressed.

Yeah, it's basically all I did in the depths of poverty throughout my life is just read philosophy. You know, I had an interest in it. That was mainly my focus.

So that's what I've done with my life is just write and read, basically, because I've suffered massive abuse and harassment throughout my life. So, you know, I never had much of opportunities for any meaningful activities. So for various reasons, I got wound up in poverty at various times.

So that's the way it goes. So I guess it's a silver lining in the dark cloud of life for me because I've been doing that for 20 years, basically, since the year 2000. Just been reading for 20 years.

Well, it shows. That was always like the background, you know, like the background of

everything that I've done is always having the opportunity to do that, which I'm glad that I've had. But, you know, I'm hoping to try to transmit that to other people in various ways and serve as a sort of pedagogical role in trying to assist other people, you know, not to say that I'm any sort of standard, but, you know, I'm trying to just give some insight and guidance and then learn more for myself so I can just pay it forward back to the whites as a collective group.

That's why I'm trying to set up a website also with, you know, this giant collection of books and PDFs that I've gotten, like about 11,000 or so of them that I've gathered together that I'm going to put up on there so they can all be downloaded and so forth. Hopefully, that'll be coming in the next month, I would think. 11,000.

Damn. Yeah, it's pretty good work, man. Yeah, it's a lot of internet research there.

Right. Well, when you get it up and running, let me know. Oh, yeah.

speech laws here is you'll just get mauled by a bunch of wild niggers.

Yeah, I'll be spreading it around to whatever extent before whatever they do to me, they do to me here because I have no idea what's going to be happening to me. The sort of Damocles is sort of, you know, looming over my head with the shadows on the ground there. So, I can't tell you.

Yeah. God, I don't know what to even advise you to do. I mean, well, you probably don't need my advice, but I don't know.

Yeah, well, I remember just this year they strung up Augustus Sol Invictus and Chris Cantwell over basically both of them over domestic abuse shit or like domestic issues, you know, which I don't know. Both of those guys seem like they were a little bit crazy, so maybe they would do shit like that.

I have no idea, but that's one of their frame ups, one of the ways they frame people. For me, after this case, I got a bunch of emails periodically from Antifa people, anonymous people saying that, you know, yeah, we've captured we've observed you masturbating to pedophile porn on the Internet. We're going to route you to the police, you know, stuff like that, just sort of childish, petty nonsense.

Right. Every time I step out of the house here, they're gang stalking me, the Christians and the Antifa. Everywhere I go, they're like, you know, I don't know if you're familiar with gang stalking and those sorts of tactics, but it is a reality.

And it's definitely very psychologically disturbing that everywhere they go, everywhere you go, they'll follow you around. They've got like whole teams of these people that actually do this. They're probably funded to do that sort of activity.

Well, I've heard of gang stalking and I never really have thought about it too much. But yeah, I mean, these are people that, yeah, they probably don't have like probably their job is just to commit criminal mischief. But I don't know, man.

I mean, it sounds like you live in a small town. Do you think maybe it's about 70,000 people or so. So it's small.

Never mind. But not too small. Never mind.

I had the impression that you were living in like a really tiny town. Never mind. OK.

Yeah, I don't know what to tell you about that, man. Shit. Yeah, it's something this community need to know more about, because this is the way that they psychologically terrorize people, basically, is to, you know, make deliberately make huge amounts of noise outside of your residence periodically throughout, you know, often even 24 hours a day.

They'll be like, bang, bang, bang, bang, bang, bang. Or they'll deliberately run power

equipment or run car engines and just rev it like super loud at certain times. Whenever you're there, whenever they know that you're there, they'll monitor you.

And even though they'll break into your residence in some cases that I've heard. And then from there, you know, you've got the microwave weapons, the directed energy weapons that these people use, the Mossad and so forth. That's a reality.

You know, there's a NATO base near here. There's a Canadian Centre for Neuroscience Research just two hours away from here. And there's a biological weapons lab near that NATO base.

So, you know, this is definitely, in my opinion, an existential threat. Like, I don't look upon this lightly. I could send you some documents about it, actually.

I think it's pretty important for people to know about these sorts of issues, because they may very well encounter them themselves sometime. Sure. So what indications do you look for if you think that they're using some kind of a microwave weapon on you or some kind of directed energy weapon? Well, for that, it's headaches, heating of the body, things like that.

I've actually been experiencing that here. There's one website called gangstalkingmindcontrolcults.com. Gangstalkingmindcontrolcults.com. And that one, even though it's run by some professor or ex-professor of geography, who's like a Christian identist now for some reason, even though of that, even in spite of that, you know, it's a pretty good source of information on these sorts of subjects, that they actually use these sorts of techniques. It's what they used similarly in East Germany.

You know, it's called zur Setzung in East Germany, the sort of spy tactics, gangstalking. One in 65 people in East Germany was one of the spies in that country. So that is statistically proven.

So, you know, yeah, it goes beyond just doxing people and trying to get them fired. It goes to the extent where they create, you know, like a Truman Show reality for you, where basically you go, you're manipulated, you're controlled. You've got people trying to suddenly harass you or stand in your way.

Cars will drive up right to you and stop right in front of you. Or they'll, when you're trying to cross the street, if you're walking, then they will deliberately drive right up towards you. And or they'll pretend to stop.

And then as you try to cross the street, then they'll accelerate and try to run at you and then just stop right in front of you or something. And people will, you know, drag themselves across your path or they'll follow you on the opposite side of the street, you know, and they coordinate this through their phones, through text messages and so forth. There's always police working with them too.

You see them driving, you know, doing surveillance tactics on you. Definitely very disturbing things. But it goes beyond mere just that.

It goes to the levels of basically killing people eventually. So however paranoid that sounds, I mean, it does sound like that if you haven't experienced it yourself. But, you know, it's it's a reasonable presumption, even if you haven't, given the technology they have and the resources they have available to do this, you know, to pay all these street actors.

Of course, they have crisis actors, as everybody knows, for their false flag events that they stage. So they're not, you know, not without the outside of the bounds of probability, even if you have no direct experience of this. But now that I've had that experience, I definitely look upon that as a as an existential threat, because even though these people are sort of cowards and, you know, so forth, they do work with the criminal elements and they do work with Mossad and police.

So those are very serious problems or threats, in my opinion. Right. So that's what I'm facing right now.

I don't really know what I can do about it. But other than just, you know, if I had the money to make like a steel room to block microwave radiation or something like that, but, you know, there's really not too much you can do otherwise. My intention was to relocate to the country and just set up like a secan house.

But where I was, given that it's Canada, they've got so many regulations, you're not allowed to do that. So that never worked out for me. God.

Maybe just live out of this or something. Yes. All these fucking regulations, man.

Goddamn. Yeah. Well, that's more government bullshit for you.

I guess we've got like entire classes of people that have nothing better to do. Yeah. I mean, they're getting paid.

It's a guarantee that they're going to get money because they're taxing us. So they have a guaranteed income and nothing but time on their hands to fuck shit up. And yeah, that's where you get all these fucking laws from, I'm guessing.

Anyway. Before we go, I guess you're getting a little bit tired. But yeah, before we go, I just wanted to mention that that guy who interviewed me, he seems to be somebody who was brought into this town, which is a predominantly Zionist Christian town, as like a communist organizer, because he was him and some other Jew were setting up like this communist bike, you know, used bike fix store.

And I see this guy walking around the streets with like a fur coat on, and with some sort

of like jihadist Arabs hanging around him. And, you know, they're running this, this bike repair shop, you know, with with all sorts of marijuana and stuff like that, that they're always involved in. And to me, it seems like that's the sort of template that they use to try to hook people into, you know, their communist ideology.

And then once they start getting you in, you know, it's like, like a gateway, right? You marijuana, and then you do harder drugs, and then you're, you're involved in their perverted sex practices. And then from there, you know, they can compromise you because they've got, you know, maybe video footage on you, you know, sodomy or whatever the case. Or? Yeah, well, I don't know, the guy looked a little bit Jewish to me.

So it wouldn't surprise me that he's hanging out with other guys who look like they're look like they're part of ISIS. Because, you know, they've got that same genetic type. So yeah, really surprised me.

But on the other hand, I don't know, he kind of just seemed like a normal. I mean, obviously, it's subnormal and point of fact, but he seemed like a guy who's just like, into degeneracy, because that's like his mindset. All he cares about is all he cares about is just satisfying every urge that comes up.

You know, I mean, he basically said that to you in the course of the interview. He's like, like, that's basically what he said. He is that.

So it makes sense that he would just be smoking weed all day hanging out with the rest of his sand nigger cousins and I don't know, playing with their bikes or whatever dumb shit they do. I'm surprised it wasn't a skateboard shop. And I mean, I'm not disputing with you.

Yeah, definitely weed is is central to communist recruiting, like definitely getting people to smoke fucking weed all the time and just fuck everything that that opens up for them. Definitely, that's part of the communist programming. And it's the initial stage where they break you down.

So yeah, I understand that. But on the other hand, probably these people are just like, probably they're just stains. You know that? Like, say you have a white shirt and you get some fucking gnarly stain on it.

Well, you have a white town there and you just have a stain on it right now. And it's these communist liberalized little fucking punks. And they might be involved in more serious shit at some point because there's like limitless funding from all these kike organizations or kike nonprofits that are like masquerading as some kind of social work fucking program.

But in reality, they send money to like communist people to go. They send money to people that are just like kind of just punks, like the three with like the three kikes that

got shot by Kyle Rittenhouse at Kenosha, Wisconsin. They're just kind of like those people.

They're just lifelong miscreants and ne'er-do-wells. And they got nothing better to do than show up to a fucking protest because they're really upset about how some poor black boy was treated because that's the way they've been conditioned and psychologically damaged so much so that they about stupid shit like that. And they think that they think that because they're damaged, because they're damaged, because they they're in a diminutive state, they're diminished mentally and spiritually diminished.

That's why they think that stupid shit that happens to niggers matters because they're fucking brain damage. All right. And it's partly comes from all the fucking drugs they do.

So, yeah, definitely that's part of it. But I don't really know if it's quite as like, oh, yeah, organize. I think it's I mean, it's it's organized just because these people have limitless money, because their cousins run the printing press and they get all the fucking money they need.

But as in terms of like the stupid fucking stains that that are in the streets doing this shit, those are the dumbest fucking people, the most disorganized people, man. They got a free bus ticket to go there. They got a free van ride to go.

That's why they're there. They're organized by the police and by other people who are the official organizers above them. These are just the lower level pawns that they use because I've seen these people traveling around in vehicles monitoring these people from a distance.

They do that. So that's the sort of organized structure of the gang stalking techniques that they utilize. They have their lower level pawns and then they have their more sophisticated, organized managers, I guess you could call them.

Also, the Zionist Christians are very heavily involved in it here, even more so than the Antifa people. They're more of a presence in this town, even then than the communists. So they're they're major the major influence, just, you know, old retirees or Christians from their church and their token minority slaves, you know, they'll be the ones who are conscripted to do this dirty work.

So, yeah, it's something people need. Well, I would believe you when you say I would definitely believe you if you say that Zionist Christians are just a bunch of like minders or a bunch of they're they're a bunch of they they stick their nose in other people's business or they think they're some kind of like social police or more moral thugs. I would believe that of them.

Yes, I would believe that they would harass people over stupid kike bullshit that they believe. Yeah, I understand that. But I don't know with gang stalking, I just have never

been interested in it because I don't know.

It seems like people people get a little bit obsessed with it. But I kind of understand basically it's true, though, like basically it exists because essentially like I like I see it, I witness it. I mean, sure, they're not like gang stalking me.

It's not a coordinated thing, really. But essentially it's like targeted harassment. And what it is, is diversity programs.

I'll explain this. What it is, is diversity programs. They send these niggers to colleges in like some small town in the Midwest that's like 90 percent white or more.

They send these niggers around. They try to diversify white states or white towns or white neighborhoods by creating housing. Somehow, however they do it, they acquire housing and ship these niggers there for whatever reason.

They give them money to relocate there or they just make places for them to fucking stay. And basically what it is, is targeted harassment. It's basically gang stalking, essentially.

Maybe that's not what other people, maybe other people don't think that's what it is, but essentially that's what it is, is gang stalking. Yes, they're shipping these niggers or these communists or these kikes. They're shipping them to the Midwest.

They're shipping them to towns that used to be, you know, normal. Yeah. And they're fucking our shit up and they're harassing us.

It's true. Like that happens to a lot of these cities in the Midwest, that they only had like maybe 200,000 or 300,000 people, maybe less. Maybe it was like 100,000 people.

But then all of a sudden, out of nowhere, there's a bunch of shit baggots there in town. And so they start setting up all these fucking hipster hangouts, like these fucking video game cafes or these fucking skateboard shops or some dumb bullshit like that. And then there's fucking shitlib bugmen everywhere.

There's subhumans everywhere all of a sudden. And when you look at these fucking people, it is exactly what they are, is subhuman. Like I've seen these bugman fucks and you just look at them and you can tell like hormonally or just like psychically, you're just something you get the vibes from them.

They are fucking wrong, man. They look unhealthy. They just look disgusting.

Their features are just just disturbing. Usually they're fat and just fucking repulsive to look at fat and gay and just you can't really tell what gender they are. So I guess they're not big gay.

Are there? I don't fucking know. But essentially that's. These people are fucking everywhere all of a sudden, and it's like this used to be just some normal cuckservative Midwestern town.

Why the fuck are we suddenly swamped with these people who look like they're from San Francisco or Portland? Where did these fucking stains come from? Where did this fucking genetic trash come from? Where the where the fuck did they come from? And what they are, what they are is a stain. What they are is a stain. Seriously.

You know, this is what these fucking immature little shits would say in high school. They call somebody a fuck stain. But literally, that's what these people are.

They're the stain that's left over from dysgenic sex because their fucking parents were also losers and they couldn't control themselves. They couldn't put down their urges and realize it's probably not the best thing for the community for me to breed. And they just fucking did it anyways.

And now we're stuck tolerating these fuck stains. We have to fucking live with these fuck stains up to a point, probably, probably eventually there will be no possible way to live with them anymore because this is the way they make things. They just will not shut the fuck up and get the fuck out.

You're familiar with hear the cradle song that novel right by O.T. Gunnarsson. I don't know, man, I'm in the midst of a tirade, I can't really focus on. Yeah, because that's what happens to them there in that novel.

In that novel, they basically end up just killing them all in certain areas. Well, I mean, it's going to come down to either us or them at some point, I guess, because they do this stupid shit. They go to they show up at some town where they don't fucking belong and they just start burning shit down and tearing shit up or shooting people or killing people randomly.

And it's like the fucking the motherfucking politicians and motherfucking Trump and all these rich faggot assholes, they don't get there. They're fucking happy. They're laughing about this shit right now.

And I mean, I don't really care. It doesn't affect me. At least it hasn't yet.

But I don't know. They apparently have unlimited time and unlimited money that's given to them by these fucking bullshit social organ, social work organizations or or humanitarian aid organizations will just give money to communists to come riot. In some town, just pick a random fucking town.

Oh, we want to destroy this town because they have a factory or a couple couple places that, you know, normal people can go and work and make a living wage. Well, we got to

fucking put an end to that. And then they fucking come swamp your town and destroy shit.

OK, well, it hasn't affected me yet, but like we're all basically playing Russian roulette, pun intended. We're playing roulette with these Soviet fucks. Yeah.

And so, yeah, eventually it will come down to it that, yeah, they're just going to come to destroy your town. They're going to burn down the factory you work at or they're going to burn down shit. And then your life, your way of life is gone.

And yeah, I mean, in a way, it's like, I don't know, maybe it's a blessing in disguise because who wants to keep working for these capitalist fucks? But I'm like, people are just not self-sufficient. You know, you people go into work and they have to fucking work and. Yeah, well, they have to run it and then afterwards, the way the way that they get food, the way that they get food is they go and they go hunting at the local, you know, Kroger or Walmart.

They go and they forage and they forage from the from the produce and the meat and eggs aisles. It's not to collect. It wouldn't even be possible, actually, to be independent because you could just be raided yourself by others who want to take your stuff.

So it has to be a collective effort, like a community where people have their sustainable farms and communal, communally owned land and so forth, you know, like they used to have. Even in this country, they used to have dairies in their own farms just a couple of decades ago in their own towns and so forth, creameries and so forth. And that's how people survive.

You know, whereas now if you if you're living on the country in the country, on the farmland, the very farm next to where you're living, even if it's only a couple of meters away, you have to wait till all that food is shipped around to the big cities before it comes back to your grocery store. And then the grocery charges more than the city's grocery store. So it becomes an absurdity, basically.

Absurdity. Yes, exactly. That's the word for it.

So, yeah, eventually it's going to come down to like these people are in a they're definitely they are an existential threat. Definitely they're an exist an existential threat. But I mean, a myriad of problems are being caused by their existence and they won't fucking quit it.

So eventually it's going to come down to the point where, like, just to have a normal life at all or just to continue existing, like just to continue living. At some point, there's going to have to be a breaking point and people are going to have to say, look, all you communist faggots and all you glow in the darks, you need to get the fuck out. You need to get the fuck out now.

Well, get the fuck out and never come back. Another major problem is we know we need like a reverse. We need a reverse Iron Curtain to come down.

OK, basically what multiculturalism is, is a new Iron Curtain. What the diversity bullshit, this fucking faggot kike liberal bullshit, this liberalism, it's the fucking it's it's not the Iron Curtain. It's like the I don't know, neon pink satin, neon pink silk curtain.

The fag curtain is what it is. OK, well, it's a fucking curtain of death that's fucking strength this country and strangling the whole fucking Western world. And eventually it needs to come down and all these fucks need to be deported to fucking Russia or Siberia or Israel or the Levant or the Middle East.

They just need to be kicked the fuck out of here. In my opinion, Christianity is even more of a threat than communism is because it enables the Jew to be superior. Maybe they need to be deported, too.

Well, they need to be more VARG victims around. We need VARG. We need we need all these 19 year olds that are doing this stupid alt-right bullshit.

They need to become like VARG instead and just do what he did. And you know what I mean about him? Yeah, I agree with you. The Christians are the problem.

But Christianity is a boomer thing. And so I don't really think to that. Yeah, pretty much.

Christianity is a boomer thing. The boomers are basically extinct or close to it. To co-opt the youth, I guess, is the strategy that should be employed to try to shift them away from communism toward, you know, a more healthy minded traditionalism, an Aryan traditionalism.

And that can only be done through proper propaganda and reaching people and just living a life, an exemplary life yourself so that they can see, you know, that you're not a Christian. There's other alternatives to Christianity than communism. So maybe that would be the best alternative, you know, not libertarianism where you're all by yourself being selfish or communism.

Or Christianity, there are better alternatives than any of those ideologies. So that's what we need. Yeah, there are better alternatives to ideologies.

Yeah, there is a better alternative to ideology and it's not an ideology. It's no ideology. The better alternative to these ideologies would be, you know, living, like being a practical person, living in the real world.

That would be better than any fucking ideology. Oh, I don't think so. I don't think so.

I mean, National Socialism appeals to me. I'll admit that it's one ideology that appeals to me, but mostly it's because the people... Because if you don't have any higher principles

that you're living in accordance with, if you don't have a higher comprehension of reality spiritually, then you just wind up being a slave tilling the fields, like any Christian earning the bread through the sweat of your brow. And that's what they want, the people at the highest levels.

They want you to be their brainless puppet, right? So you've got to have an ideology or a system of ideas based upon the Aryan tradition. And you have to understand that. And yeah, it's a lived thing as well.

Obviously, it's not just purely intellectual, you know, thought without action is sterile, as Ben Classen said. So that's the whole theme of this show is basically, you know, practical idealism for Aryans, not just, you know, not just mental masturbation or intellectualism or scholarly asceticism. But, you know, an integration of those ideas of that spiritual way of thinking of life, which is not something exclusive to reason or anything of that sort or intellect, you know, because there really is no such thing as just living.

You know, there, as Evola said, there's more than living, you know, mer als libin, which is living according to, you know, an authentic tradition of the Aryan. So that's basically what I'm trying to do is to try to, you know, get means of reaching people who are actually reachable, to bring them to a higher level of understanding of things. That way, they get sucked into the traps that are laid for them by these, these disinformation agents, these priestly cast shepherd kings, bail priests, the Freemasons, the Jews, the Jesuits, and so forth.

But yeah, I should probably go to sleep now. I'm getting a little bit on the tired side. Well, you still are an hour behind me, man.

What do you mean you're getting tired? Man, this nigga's got to be up and at work. Well, yeah, I usually get up at five o'clock in the morning, so. Yeah, you too? Okay, well, all right, then.

Yeah, you probably better get some sleep. Well, it's been a pleasure. Thanks very much for having me.

And I guess all I can say is good luck. Okay, thanks a lot. I appreciate that.

Yeah, I wish you the best of luck, man. Okay, thanks again. All right, well, Godspeed.
