

Nordlux: Croatia and the Balkans

A new podcast, it is a pleasure for me to have Rudolf Baresic again and Zygarde, hello Zygarde. Hello Rudolf. So the topic, hello, so the topics will be unknown episodes of the Balkan history.

Interestingly enough, a lot of people don't know about the Balkan history, even though the Balkans, as I said, are the keys for Europe. It is very important for the European defense, it was very important for the European economy and it is very important, it looks like it will be very important for the future of the Europeans and maybe even for the white race, since it is a contact zone with Asia and with Africa and unfortunately we must be able to stop the future invasion in Europe, which of course there was one country that of course we will talk a little bit about them, of course the Serbs, that is usually quite friendly to the imperial power of the Russians and the Russians and their Zio friends, of course, are heavily investing in Serbia, in influence on the Balkans, of course not only Serbia, in the Bulgarian communists and maybe in Croatia there are some groups that are friendly to them, I don't know, maybe Rudolf will tell us about that. And another thing is how the Russians or Russian Zionists or whatever you call them, are infiltrated American nationalism, which means this is an outsider like me, is obviously seeing how the Russians are controlling the narratives and the propaganda of the Americans.

So maybe we will start with Rudolf, I mean maybe we must start with the creation of the Croatian, I mean we must first talk with some pre-history maybe with the Croatians. Thank you, thank you so much, I just want to say thank you so much for having me on again, it's a pleasure talking to both of you and I'm looking forward to doing this again. So yes, and like you said initially during the show, Balkan is a very strategic important region for several reasons, not least in the past all of the great powers have had some kind of shared interest and invested heavily in this region, so it's also like a chessboard for the great powers who will control the Balkan region and we saw the importance during the Second World War and we saw even in the aftermath what happened and also with the NATO expansion and so on and so forth.

And like you mentioned, the Serbs are definitely acting as Russia's proxy in that region and have been doing that throughout history, so yeah I think we will have a very interesting topic to talk about it. Yeah exactly, Sigurd being part of the Western world so to say, from North Africa, maybe he will ask us questions about the history and this will be an outer perspective. Yeah, I'll just come forth with like the ignorant North American perspective.

Yes, yes, so Rudolf, the nationalism in Croatia and the Croatian national idea, how it started, a little bit of perspective, maybe a little bit of history of Croatia, because I've heard ridiculous claims from the Serbs, like ridiculous, that basically all Slovenia or Slavs

or whatever term they're using from the Balkans are Serbs, including Bulgarians, including Croats, including everyone, so basically everyone is Serb, yeah. Well, that's the pan-Slavic narrative basically, that all of us share a certain genealogy, biologically speaking, that we are inseparable as people together based on bloodlines and so on, however that we share different history and we were divided between the East and the West, especially for us Croats with our Serbian neighbours, that's usually the narrative, but basically they say that all of us share the same genealogy and bloodline and that we have maybe different histories, different religions and dialectics and so on when it comes to linguistics, but overall we're the same people. Now that's bullshit, because if you look at way back in history, we had our independent state during the kingdom and it was way back, however we Croats were lured into the kingdom of Yugoslavia that was conceded in 1918, so and from there on started these upheavals, because we saw how the kingdom of Yugoslavia, the kingdom of Croats, Slovenes and the Serbs, they went together and forged this constellation, however what happened during the years that went on is that the Serbs accumulated an enormous amount of power due to the fact that their power was concentrated to the Serbian king, and from there on we had different types of nationalistic groups or actually even prior to this we had like peasant party wanting more autonomy for the Croats and so on, and then all of a sudden we had let's say the Ustasa regime that was one of the first I would say in Europe, apart from maybe Mussolini's Italy, that were a true fascist resistance against the kingdom of Yugoslavia, so that's basically to put it very short, but our history stretches way back than the kingdom of Yugoslavia ever did.

Yeah of course I will like a Bulgarian, I will support you, I know historical sources back from 8th century that differentiated from the Bulgarian sources that are differentiating between Serbs and Croats, so we're talking about quite Asian sources that are mentioning Serbs and Croats like different people. Yes and also because this is, how can I put it this way, it's like a controversy ever since for instance this war we had both during you know in the aftermath of the let's say of the first world war and then the second world war and then we had a formation of the socialist federal republic of Yugoslavia and then when this disintegrated as well Croatia became an independent state in 1991. Yes, do you know what is the, we mentioned this in this long talk that will be published in the next week, can you tell me a little bit about the pan-Slavic infiltration or creation of the pan-Slavism in Croatia, because I know that these pan-Slavic lodges started to spread in the end of 19th century and there were lodges supported by the Russians, so this is.

Well yeah, well the idea of pan-Slavism like you mentioned was I would say during the 1800s like you said during the 19th century and onwards we had this movement basically and it goes further back I would say than that as well but I would say that in the 19th century like you mentioned during the 1800s we saw a very strong movement connecting all of and I believe that this sincerely led to the creation of the kingdom of

Yugoslavia in 1918. I will say another thing that I mentioned before, another, this is a little bit controversial but another empire that was exploiting pan-Slavism in a specific way but not very successful at the end, it didn't look very nice was the Austro-Hungary. Yeah, that's true, I agree.

They had this idea that they could create this multicultural empire that a lot of these citizens or subjects I must say of the Austro-Hungary or basically Slovenia or Slavic or whatever and they started to research these things and I know that for example I'll try to find one of the first researchers in 1872 is Felix Kanitz. Now Felix Kanitz, his name is Felix Philipp Emanuel Kanitz, he's an Austro-Hungarian archaeologist ethnograph geographer but he's also Jew, he's converted Jew. So basically he started to, basically he was a spy if I'm honest, he was a spy, he was part of the lithographic institute of Weizgrin, he offered his service to Emperor Franz Josef, he started to research ancient Bulgarian history and honestly he started to falsify the different things of the Bulgarian history to fit the interests of the Austrians.

Austrians had these ideas basically to take all the ones from the dying Ottoman Empire. The Ottoman Empire was the sick man of Europe and they wanted basically to take as much as possible from these ones and to suppress any kind of nationality including I suppose of the Croatians, including of the Serbs, including of the Bulgarians if it's possible. It is very interesting that the First World War, usually people think that the Serbs were unfriendly towards the Austrians based on the First World War and what happened before that, like this struggle for basically Gavrilo Princip killing Ferdinand.

But it is interesting to know that in 1885 there was a war called Serbo-Bulgarian War when Serbia actually attacked Bulgaria, quite surprisingly honestly, because Bulgaria unified, Northern and Southern Bulgaria unified and Serbs with the support of Russia and Austro-Hungary attacked us. When they were defeated, and this was quite an amusing event in their history because they were supposedly the better prepared army, much more numerous with the modern equipment, with the officers and foreign help especially from Austria. When they were defeated, Bulgarian army entered the territory which is now Eastern Serbia, actually old Bulgarian territories inhabited Bulgaria at that moment like Nis, and they were stopped by an Austrian ambassador.

He sent a letter, he said that if Bulgarian troops continue the advance, they will be stopped by Austrian troops, which of course was impossible for a young state to fight this great power like the Austrian Empire. So we stopped the advance, so basically there was no territory against Serbia. So the question is why Serbia was supported by the Austrians at that point? Why was that? The answer is that all these Jews and these masons, they were supporting the Serbs like a balancing factor against Bulgaria and I suppose that they were supported against the Croatians too, because this is the imperial logic like divide and conquer, right? And on the later stage, they found out that Serbs receiving more and more help and influence from the Russians, so that's what caused these

conflicts and this led to the first world war basically.

Yeah and also if we look at for instance like during when Yugoslavia was formed in 1918 and then shortly after that I believe 10-11 years after they installed some kind of dictatorship by Alexander and at that time actual date when the Ustasa movement was founded was in 1929. It was actually exactly during those times when the Serbs installed this dictatorship in the Kingdom of Yugoslavia and the founder was the leader Ante Pavelic and naturally the Ustasa saw an opportunity to just carve up the Kingdom of Yugoslavia and just create their own independent state. Now this took a little bit longer and it happened in 1941 when we established our own state during the Ustasa government.

So, what was the situation of the Croats in the Kingdom of Yugoslavia or before that of Kingdom of the Serbs Croats? Yeah, somehow we were lured into this Kingdom project and all of a sudden and then shortly thereafter I believe it was in in 1929 when we had a crisis and the King Alexander he simply dissolved it and just installed a monarchical dictatorship under the guidance of the Serbs and way back until this we had like voices very strong political voices that wanted to separate the Croats from the rest of the Kingdoms. However, this did not happen and this the repression took much stronger force than it did and this eventually led to that we organized ourselves into a fascist unit that is. Yes, yes.

So, basically to intervene a little bit, I can talk about the Serbs and their basically genocide that the genocidal policies that they have against the Bulgarians in ex-Bulgarian territories. As I said before these were territories that were historically Bulgarian what is now Macedonia, what is now Eastern Serbia, like cities like Nis, were Bulgarian and even there was a Bulgarian quite large population around Belgrade which of course they managed to assimilate. There was even a rebellion that Bulgaria supported against the Ottomans and it looks like the Serbs used the Bulgarians like a meat shields because when the Bulgarians start to form Cheti, so basically units against the Turks, Serbs just forgot to help them so the Turks started to genocide Bulgarian population which of course was it looks like this was their plan from the get-go to basically to use the Turks like what is the term basically to do their dirty work.

So, I believe I don't mean to sorry I don't mean to interrupt you but if I recall correctly you had also this what is termed as the Balkan war I believe it was in 1912 to 1913. I believe at that point that the Serbs actually incorporated Macedonia into their square, correct? Yes, so basically the situation with Macedonia and the Balkan war was like that. The first Balkan war was basically a war of the Christian states so basically Bulgaria, Serbia, Montenegro and Greece against the Ottoman Empire.

This union was basically the situation is going back to the history to go to history basically there are a lot of ones that are right now are outside of I mean historically

Bulgarian rights that are right now outside of the present Bulgarian situation some of them in present Turkey some of them are in what is now northern Greece and some of them in minor parties in Romania in minor party and some quite large parties in Macedonia and Serbia. I think so the people can get a good understanding of this. I believe like depending on how long we want to go back in history but I believe it was in 1398 something like that when the Ottomans took over Serbia if I'm correct.

I think they lost a battle in Kosovo. I believe it was somewhere around there in the end of the 1300s in the beginning of the 1400s and this Ottoman rule it was very strong it took over like for instance Serbia what is now Macedonia and naturally Greece with Constantinople and then this lasted for almost 500 years this Ottoman rule and it was the rebellion from the Balkan wars that led to somehow a rebellion against the crumbling Ottoman Empire. However, we Croats we were a little bit more oriented toward the west if so we were not affected by that apart from Bosnia and Herzegovina naturally where we have in north eastern part a Croat enclave so the people can get an understanding.

So yeah during the Ottoman war we were not that affected but many of our neighbors were for instance the Serbs and so on and then when the Ottoman Empire started to crumble you had this Balkan war it was a rebellion against the Turks. However, the Serbs saw their opportunity naturally to capitalize on this and to create a greater Serbia which has always been their intention. Sorry I don't mean to cut you off.

Yeah so basically the first Balkan alliance was supported by the emperor the Russian emperor Nikolai so basically the idea was that Bulgaria started to militarize quite strongly at the end of the 19th century with the idea to restore more or less the old national borders. Like obviously we cannot restore the first or the second Bulgarian empire but at least the largely populated areas with Bulgaria could be restored. That's why Bismarck claimed at some point that Bulgaria is the Prussians of the Balkans in the 19th century at least this is his statement and obviously Bulgaria with a small much smaller population of the Ottoman Empire needed allies.

The Russian emperor intervened created this alliance between Greece, Serbia and Bulgaria and Montenegro of course. This is historically correct even though they were the smallest country obviously and Bulgaria started to the problem with Bulgaria was that we basically wanted and that that's why there was in 19th century created the inner revolutionary Macedonian organization which is even though the Macedonian the name it is Bulgarian organization if you look at the history most of the people the leaders like Goce Delcev, like Vance Mihailov, Todor Aleksandrov, so and so they are in one way or another stated that they're Bulgarians or they were born in Bulgaria what is now Bulgaria and they signed it with Bulgaria they followed they were studied in Bulgarian universities and most of the people in the organization basically knew that they're Bulgarians. Going back to the Balkan war so basically there was the problem of Bulgaria that we basically situated in a such way that we must fought the main Turkish powers in what is now

Thrace and our main interest was to take what is now Macedonia so this claimed a little bit of problems because basically Bulgaria fought and defeated the Turkish armies in the first Balkan war but the Greeks and the Serbs basically took what is now Macedonia which of course caused the Serbs and the Greeks had a quite aggressive policy and they started to prosecute Bulgarian population there.

Now Ferdinand our Tsar he had a quite let's say not very stable temper and he decided to start to attack the Serbian and Greek forces in Macedonia which led to the second Balkan war which was a great mistake obviously not to mention that the Turks and Romanians basically entered on the side of the Serbs and the Greeks so that's basically the Romania, Turkey, Serbia and Greece fought against us so this ended in defeat mostly because of the Turkish and Romanian forces were not opposed since we didn't expect it and on the later stage this led to Bulgarian participating in the German-Austrian alliance or the central powers against the Entente so this led to basically to the destruction of Serbia they were removed from the party and for occupation of Serbia from German, Bulgarian and Austrian troops. Now there was an element there that of course the Serbs claimed that Bulgarian and Austrian troops committed genocide created the gas chambers and they got 700,000 Serbs. Now the number 700,000 is repeating I've read that the Serbs claimed that the Ustasa killed 700,000 Serbs also.

Or even more I think they claim that 1 million Serbs died. That sounds like some sort of Kabbalistic number the seven for heaven or something. Sorry just to keep it I know that it's a little bit complicated for many people tuning in here but what is important to bear in mind here is that this region has been under heavily influenced from the great powers like you eloquently just described you know you had also for instance Italy had their share of interest as well when it took over Albania they took over a part of Dalmatia and Istria that now belongs to Croatia and so it was really how to say like a chessboard for the greater powers you know who will control and like you mentioned like in 1941 when Germany destroyed Yugoslavia it gave us a golden opportunity simply to create our own independent state and this happened at that time and since then we Croats we have been very loyal to Germany I would say and this actually during for instance I don't want to jump too fast forward in time but for instance when we sought our independence Germany was if you look at the greater powers it was in the beginning only Germany that were in favor of a Croat independent state in 1991 and it was actually proclaimed by at that time the German foreign minister Hans Dietrich Genscher who went against all others and said we want the Croats to go their own way and thankfully this led to it so we can so we could receive an independent state and then naturally we received also support from Bulgarians they were among the first and also Hungary not least yeah so there you have it yeah and then we went into a very dark bloody civil war from 1991 to 1995 and we emerged victorious from that time and then all of a sudden no conflict we will we went into some kind of a peaceful coexistence we are neighbors and so on however we know that this is far from over who knows what will happen the Russians

they have their influence in the Balkan region through their proxies for instance like you mentioned the Serbs too and who knows you know it's like a battlefield for influence and then in the end of 1990s NATO also went against Yugoslavia at that time especially Serbia and Montenegro were still in an entity that was named Yugoslavia so we see here again this pattern for influence in that region and not least like you in the beginning of the show mentioned that it becomes a transit route for all of these migrants entering for instance in Serbia and in Bosnia and so on so this is a huge huge problem too that needs to be addressed so it's very important region go ahead i don't mean to cut you off no no no you you uh uh with uh very valuable points here i will uh open the the brackets uh because most of the listeners most of the listeners have this very strange idea that all population of the Balkans hate each other which is not true actually it's not true there i will say that there are two groups of people let's say if we exclude the turks that are basically foreign element to the Balkans let's be sure that you can see that old alliances of the the Balkans are basically uh even in the 20s in the thirties you can see the uh in the Macedonian Revolutionary Organization and the Ustase movement are lying together uh plus the Albanians uh against the Yugoslavians and of course the Greeks are traditionally more inclined to avoid with the Serbs based on the this orthodoxy and the Bulgarians even being orthodox most likely because we uh with our national idea is not in in favor of this pun slavism or whatever the the Russians are pushing so so this uh how to say uh uh giving more common points with the Croatians than to for example with the Greeks or the Serbs so this is the i think i think also one of the reasons that i encountered for instance like in i mean Yugoslavia when when let's say if you take into consideration the socialist federal republic of Yugoslavia when Yugoslavia started disintegrating and let's say when NATO got involved in this conflict in 1994 to 1995 when they started bombing the the Bosnian Serb sides all of a sudden we noticed that the Serbs started their propagandah oh you know everyone else they received NATO support we are going against this new world order and this was never their intention in the first place i usually say that to people who if you look at Serbian history they have very strong ties for instance with with the Jews and Israelis they have never uttered any criticism against Zionism or internet or the international Jewry they always go against like for instance in the beginning in the in the beginning of the 1990s they say oh it's the catholic church always the Germans who seek to destroy us then all of a sudden when they were involved in genocide for instance against the Bosniaks or when they're starting their their campaign in Kosovo then when the NATO started bombarding them all then oh you know it's the US imperialism but never ever have i heard a Serb a nationalist say you know we have one issue and the problem is for instance international Jewry or the the Jewish lobby groups and so on or the Jewish influence in Russia so they never say anything about that it's always US imperialism or you know that there are victims of a fascist conspiracy from Croats or Germans or the catholic church it's always that narrative however i can understand it from a US dissident point of view when they view it they look like okay you the United States Great Britain they started bombarding you know Serbia and for what reason so the coast of Albanians can get their

independence who are Muslims by the way so i can understand that they are some kind lured by this and and see Serbs as brave you know resisting this new world order however we need to go back in time and figure this out because this is not the image they they still keep repeating that they are against fascism and so on so this is very important yeah go ahead so basically what i'm trying to to say that basically this thing with uh with the slavs the whole idea of the slavs is is a lot of there are a lot of bogus things in in the whole claim so the thing first of all the the term that was used in old bulgaria in slovenia so slovenia speakers of the the same language so slovo word and it could be like these people like czechs and poles and russians are our cousins but not exactly from the same group of people because of the balkans you have these first of you have these ancient balkan population connected with these first civilizations then you have these first waves of indo-europeans and then you have different things like for example illyrians especially in the area of croatia albania too but it doesn't even stop there these slavo files like i want to call them they they extend this they say also you know what even austria even eastern germany is is slavic people you know so they go beyond this you know like whenever you talk to them but you know oh you know austria was also it's filled with yugoslavs like they want to call so so this this conception of this slavophilia it's greater than everyone thinks you know they go beyond this go ahead yeah and basically uh basically uh the the whole thing started with the i don't say misunderstanding or i must say it was not something that is the whole thing started with but of course i will forget the name and maybe maybe you know more about that in i believe 16th century a croatian monk were writing the history of the croatians and he used the term slav like these for the whole group instead of yeah and this this was this of course this history was used later by a bulgarian pc helendarski and these these histories were taken by russian agents now people must understand that all these i mentioned before these jew that was a traveler cartographer anthropologist of for the for the austria the same thing was for the russians they wanted to expand on the balkans balkans are very important and we have to also understand that i mean in those areas at that time there was a strong jewish presence in eastern and central europe and this is extremely important for for people to understand so yes i this is very vital to address so i give you that yeah so so basically so basically the uh different groups like for example uh the the orthodox christians in the like serbs and greeks and and bulgarians they started to be more and more convinced by a russian propaganda that jadu ivan great father ivan will will come and this is the russian empire and liberate them but somehow somehow jadu ivan russians they always fucked the bulgarians in and the greeks the greeks uh uh the greeks were in very interesting situation because basically the ottoman empire uh look at themselves like like a islamic variant of the byzantine empire they yeah exactly they tried to replicate the byzantine empire yes i agree so they started to copy the symbols they started to copy the dresses even of the byzantines but this was muslim empire so they refer to the christian population like a room millet so basically uh romans roman roman people so so that's why that's why they started to suppress the national identity of the bulgarians being competitors for the for the byzantium back in

medieval time and they started to feed the national identity of the greeks in the same way because they used the basic greek paid patriarch which was the constantinople poland patriot and later the russians used the same scheme so to say the same system they started to feed the serbian nationalism the greek nationalism to extend and to spread the influence and of course they saw at some point that bulgarians are looking more or less for their nationalization to national ideas which are in the they are not the same like the interest of russian empire and the serbs had the their interest of the so basically very favorable to the interest of the of the russians so this is the beginning of the symbiosis so to say between the serbs and the russians the 18th and 19th century so exactly that that that's correct yeah yeah true and when you start to understand these things you start to understand the ideology for example of dugin so basically they started to adopt this byzantium model uh from if you want from the bizarre from the ancient history or from the ottomans they start to adopt this thing like multicultural empire which this very vague identity called swabs which is very i mean it's i don't know i don't know how how identified but i bet they identify first like croatians and then like no i can just give you an example when i did this the latest show that i did on youtube with jeff neil quid i did a show that was entitled can civil nationalism save the us and in that show he kind of he kind of view it from a sloppy regional perspective that that serbs croats and bosnians were same people and so on and i did not i i just explained a little bit i did not want to counter signal him too much because it was not the main topic of the show but one of my subscribers from croatia he was so angry at me he wrote to me you have to you have to point out the distinctiveness of our nation and our peoples and so on this was a very special individual he viewed that he very like you know ethnically conscious croat typical croat that lives abroad that does not want to associate himself with anything that goes with yugoslavia or the slav people and so on and i do get him but i and i told him look i understand where you're coming from and i see it too i did not it was not the main topic of the show but it is correct like you said there are certain elements of the croat population especially those living abroad that does not want to do anything they have throughout you know that their entire identity is built upon differentiating him or herself from everything that has to do with slavs you know with yugo slavs and so on and i do understand that but however many many many people that maybe live abroad and so on that have a different a little bit of wider perspective when they see it they are not so maybe familiar with the let's say the particularity of these people how they actually are different they're not the same people and this is good that you bring this up yeah i think but but wait a second now if there was a similar origin let's say that accepting this this theory because i'm not sure about the the particular details of the i know for example that uh croatians definitely had a lot of illyrian a lot of gothic uh blood and even if there was a similar origin with the asian serbs the modern serbs could be a little bit different from the what they had in back in time and also also i pointed out in the beginning of the show that from what i've known from bulgarian sources bulgarians made the difference between croatians and the serbs like 1200 1300 years ago so yeah it looks like they were different from the from the maybe

with similar origin but just different people just yeah and i like there is you know and and it's of course and i think it's very and i do understand some croats that are very worried about this they don't want to be lumped together into this region with these people because it might in the future give a pretext for serbs you know to go in take those parts or that we have to subordinate ourselves again in a new yugoslavia under a different constellation and i do understand that i think it's very important that we should that we should point out our differences as well i mean i think yeah but i thought that this is the point of nationalism if you want to live in your own nation you're you're you're hunting principle i agree i agree with that i agree with that i do and i i think in and when you when you raise these questions you know some people are maybe more inclined toward looking in in in one one aspect out of it and maybe others they can view it from a broader perspective where they say okay well they are different but anyways they share the same language now i mean if you look at linguistic wise i can understand that bosnia can assert perfectly fine no doubt i mean we can have a full conversation it's not that a big linguistic barrier between us you know however if you look at the characteristics and so one of the peoples and also the mentality and so on oh well there you see a huge difference i would say yeah i understand i understand the difference so basically i don't understand why why people were if you have a separate groups that are formed for for thousands even for what macedonians were formed for for what 60 years 70 years you have a you you started to have these differences and the difference in the in the world view so to say so i don't understand why why they have problems with that uh i think like you said i i'm sorry i don't mean to cut you off but i think what you said these slavophilic let's say movements and so on i think it's gained up you know i mean a much larger impact than anyone would expect for instance the entire creation of the socialist socialist federal republic of yugoslavia was based on these pan-slavic sentiments definitely but i think when they created this socialist identity and this is very important because i this especially for how other europeans view us for instance when i was a child i mean many people they said oh you know you're yugoslavs and so on and and for instance my parents they were shocked they were like no we have nothing to do with yugoslavia we we went we went away we have our own distinctive identity and so on and what is quite interesting up until these days despite the fact that we have a civil war we're separated we have our own sovereign entities that's one until this day some people living in europe in other countries can say look at these yugoslavs you know the you it's i find it it's so so the impact of this state and we can go into this it was of huge because importance because when they created this yugoslavian identity i mean the serbs they never said in the past when yugoslavia existed oh you know we're serbians they were oh you know they were yugoslav totally even this guy for instance who is considered as the chetnik leader vojislav seselj if you look at his recordings during the 80s i'm a proud yugoslav and this is a hardcore you know technique but the serbs the serbs they really had something with the jews i'm not sure about this book the hebrew origin of the serbs but tell something with these people i think if they share they share look if you look at the i would say this that the serbian diaspora is is is copying

everything what jewish diaspora is doing albeit they're a little bit more stupid than them i would say but overall the same talking point the same talking point you know we are you know victims under a fascist conspiracy we were genocide you know the croats they killed 1 million serbs and we were we we went through the exact same pattern as the jews did you know and never ever have these hardcore serbian nationalists ever uttered anything about international zionism their problem with that they always go with this always the germans always the u.s imperialists they're jealous of us they want to control us because we're such a great power and we are and and what is interesting also with the serbs is that the russians can do anything if whatever the russians are doing they're gladly accepted you know i never seen more cacophony people for the russians than the serbs never ever yeah i mean a question about that about the uh sort of israeli identity of the serbs did they adopt that sort of psyop for themselves to make themselves uh you know have some sort of genetic relationship to jews i i think i don't know i don't know if they share some same gene pool i i don't know to be honest with you or if the uh because i'm thinking that it's like a psyop that the jews are always running when they always try to convince ethnic indigenous population that they have some sort of like tribal affiliation with jews so that the jews get their foothold in the door or their toe in the door yeah yeah i mean that's the case because i just wanted when because this is very important to understand when yugoslavia started to crumble in in the beginning of the 1990s and definitely when when the 1991 when the war started between the serbs and the croats and so on the the yugoslav authorities which were dominant dominated by by serbian officials and so on they did everything that they possibly could to you know uh virtue thing all for for the jewish lobby and so on and they said look we're dealing with here an evil fascist you know and they killed us and they killed you during the second world war so they tried to they went through everything that they possibly could to just keep a good you know good relationship with with israel and and especially with with these lobby groups as well however along the way it got out of hand and the us became involved and then i don't know but but nevertheless for instance if if you are very critical of the new world order and you never mention anything about that i'm looking from the nationalistic side of them and they have never ever criticized anything like that they did not ever had any kind of issues with with the jews especially the checking movement that that lord luck describes i have not encountered anything that the jews were prosecuted or that they had troubles with the chickens have you heard anything about that no no no no honestly i mean they seem they seem to be allies in that sense do you remember this article that i've sent you about the serbian orthodox church in ohrid which is in modern day macedonia and by the way the ohrid patriarchy was and it's very important bulgarian city because uh the creation of the kirilic alphabet and there was a little school that was led by bulgarians that they were so bogus that they signed themselves like clement bulgarian anyway so basically these uh these people the serbian orthodox uh church with the jewish organization with the greek orthodox church which i pointed out before that with the orthodox church and with the organization of the jews they they claimed that they were the victims they all serbs and jews were the

victims and basically there were brothers in the whatever in their suffering and things like that so and i think i think this is a huge problem this victimology you know self-identification they constantly bring this up like you said in this infamous concentration camp of the asenovas that they say you know there was sasha killed one million imagine one million serbs were just just slaughtered just for the sake of it you know just for fun they were butchers and they were killing jews they were killing gypsies and they had a death machinery and so on and and they i don't know and they really they really they went to great lengths to convince this so-called international community the croats are you know fascist and so on but uh yeah so basically so basically they really copying the jewish points because i've read that ustasha killed with uh this knife uh circle whatever is the name you can uh correct me here uh around 100 000 serbs with the knife i mean you hear you hear all those stories about the asenovas that yeah they were torturing people you know making them you know looking to the sun for hours or their their eyes burn out it's just so exaggerated and so on and and for instance sounds like tales from the holocaust and it's however yeah yeah so they go through these lengths you know and they try to convince everyone oh you know these evil utasha and it's so funny also they always bring up the catholic church the catholic church and the germans conspire to bring down yugoslavia this fantastic entity that proclaimed brotherhood and unity and so on however with this brotherhood in unity during 1945 they actually the partisans killed you know so many innocent croats that that had that laid down their guns in that post-war era you know and then suddenly they had to went through this you know reconciliation they were going to coexist together and so on however what did yugoslav authorities do well naturally they externally tried to wipe out wipe out the croatian diaspora because they knew that the croats eventually when the time will come they will seek their own independence so and and and it's and in every conflict for instance you always hear the israelis going oh you know it's so croats the fascist for instance not long ago when when for instance it was in 2018 when the croats they they with the world cup in in soccer for instance you had israeli newspaper look at the croat the croat the the prime minister she's posing next to this fascist flag you know and so on so we are constantly and i believe that that's the reason that that croats are constantly under the scope from these from the international community what they're doing what they're saying and so on so yeah i think it's it's it's part of our history that will i think it doesn't look good i mean i'm very worried about this yeah it's interesting that i always liked the croatian soccer team for some reason just like i intuitively gravitated toward it for some reason like they they didn't seem sort of corny maybe it was just the way they were portrayed by the jewish media but i had a question about uh you know how in the weimar republic they were deliberately creating what they're creating in america now the sort of why degenerate culture were they doing the same thing in the uh austro-hungarian empire and then the serbian empire i think is it the same sort of uh cloaca gentian style empire well i would say it was a moral decay during that era not least considering the economic circumstances and the societies were not advanced technologically so yeah you had lots of moral decay yeah i would say so definitely do you

think that that was something deliberately done by the jews to you know as a typical uh you know ferment of decision technique well if you look at the population at that time in you know those people they were highly they were populated a lot in those areas all over eastern and central europe so i i would yeah i would believe so that that is the case yeah so you you that there was uh i know that yugoslavia was a very interesting entity because it was mediator between the east and the the west we can go through that this is this is very important what you say for instance when you were when when when when tito you know conceived this wonderful entity like many people seem to think that it is both from both from the left and the right i don't know why but but okay and and and if you look at the foreign policy discourse at that time they wanted to create this alliance non-alliance movement they wanted to go this third way they wanted to balance the east and the west however this was done from a real political point of view because tito knew if he received support both from the east and both from the west so he can balance those two to to to sustain this country i mean that was the general plan so um and and yeah i mean it's quite interesting yeah in that sense that they because they broke from the warsaw pact i can explain for the listeners too in 1948 that was the time that tito despite the fact that he was a bolshevik but he knew at that time that look there is a problem with stalling and so on so that's why he he broke away from it and at least that was kind of good for our sake because we if we would not be under russian influence i think we would never have received our independence it is good also for us because as i told you the previous time there was a plan of how to say joining bulgaria to yugoslavia so it will be really a confederation of of all southern swabs so imagine if you guys would have joined you would have a conflict with the macedonians yeah no no i i don't even think that it will be a problem with macedonians but definitely will be a problem with the serbs and this was that's that that's why that's why uh basically tito started to create these fake macedonian identity to basically uh buffer or negate the bulgarian influence eventually yugoslavia and also to to negate the uh so basically the balanced uh uh serbs and to balance the croatian nationalism because basically uh this if uh the ancient or i must say the older claims of the serbs are that these macedonians these basically bulgarians were southern serbs and they were talking about uh end of the 19th century beginning of 20th century they called serbi now one of the ideologists of the velika serbia great serbia he was uh seeing serbs basically next to the black sea he he called all these bulgarian serbs right and they use these claims as a set from these jew uh yosef uh kanitz uh for the turks so they use this idea that a great old bulgarians were turks and all the the tribes of the bulgars were serbs or swabs they use the term interchangeably and they claim that all these people were enslaved and so and so so they were serbs so these victims yeah we hear that yeah so basically because they were obviously quite uh difference linguistically and anthropologically including between serbs and bulgarians and they change they change the tactics through macedonia so they decided that these southern serbs it doesn't it won't work so they started to they created this macedonian language based on bulgarian language because it's a dialect i remember how my granddad that is uh from what is uh perin macedonia which is now in

bulgaria they in 1945 were forced to to uh to change the ethnicity in their documents there were bulgarian ethnicity and they were forced to change the ethnicity to macedonian this is this is all at that point tito and stalin were friends yeah and i just wanted to point that story i don't mean to cut you off but we had this on the previous podcast you and i when we had this discussion if you look at for instance the macedonians that then constituted part of this republic in in yugoslavia during tito they were all hardcore you know partisans they were all you know they totally embraced the yugoslav the yugoslavian identity just as the bosnians did and actually the serbs too but the serbs they were they constituted the upper echelons of the yugoslavian communist party so yeah so basically this yugoslavia is just a continuation of the greater serbia this is you know i had this is very interesting because i was once it was a few years ago in a debate with i mean a real chetnik you know and and he and he told me and this is because we croats we named for instance as a child of dissidents i will never forget that for instance when when my parents came here and uncle and so on we we called yugoslavia serbo slavia and this and all of us that were nationalistic oriented we always knew look the upper excellence of the government bodies they were all in the hands of the serbs naturally the military as well intellectuals and so on so they had a monopoly of power in that sense and what this serb told me is that oh no it's not true you know the croat communists they they held power and they were in control and i told them well why would they go through the croats to genocide their own people and to wipe out the entire diaspora for what reason would they do so i mean it's just so stupid i mean however i i do understand this guy where he's coming from because he views it from a greater serbian perspective however what needs to be in discussed here is if you look at who were in power who i mean who controlled yugoslavia and usually what the serbs did when yugoslavia crumbled and when tito died in 1981 sorry 1980 and then they say oh you know tito was a croat hence you know it was a croat construction it's so stupid because everyone knows that the serbs were heavily invested in this yugoslavian project why on god's earth would they go through this enormous length to sustain this entity if they were not in power it's a simple logical reasoning but you know yeah but the thing with tito well he was by origin he was croatian most likely because i've heard different stories but uh he was communist he was uh and communism ideologically speaking you cannot belong to certain nationality because they're international that's why bulgarian traitors they created macedonian one which they created this this bullshit that is basically the same like macedonian bulgarian dialect it is to claim that bavarian dialect is different from the german let's say well i agree here i i agree here that they have an internationalist perspective and they don't view it in ethnic terms however i i will say one thing that under the surface you still have some kind of ethnocentrism involved just look at for instance ember hoja in albania for instance okay he was a hardcore marxist leninist and so on but under the surface for instance there there is a good case to to point out that there there it exists some kind of ethnocentrism in that regime i would say to be honest yeah i think the jews just have to use whatever they can get at any given point and then they just you know take an organic movement and then just twist it

toward their agenda i think so too they want they they are they're pretty they are very you know working with this divide and conquer strategy and so on however they need allies and they're they need friends too and i would say the way that i have studied the serbian diaspora both in the past and president so on and also the nationalistic movement within serbia at this current moment i just see it as the they are simply you know on a good foot with the israelis you know they i just don't see any kind of resistance against the new world order stemming from serbia whatsoever they just pro russians and so on and if you look at how russia is contemporary russia is heavily infiltrated by zionist interests it will shock you i mean it's unbelievable i mean for instance this movement of habad lubavitch it's extremely nested within you know for instance united russia cadres all of them are on good hands with the zionists i will add this book which is written by stefan tomovic phd the hebrew origin of the serbs which i've never read it's interesting yeah yeah but it's it sounds interesting it is with these menorah on the on the background is the serbian flag so it's it's interesting interesting maybe i will try to find something and to read it but yeah interesting another interesting thing is that you know maybe you know a little bit more about velika serbia but i know that one of the one of the names behind the velika serbia great serbia project was actually jewish professor and he started he started to create this idea of these serbian uh tribes that conquered the balkans and they're everyone that is uh that is woven or slav or whatever is is basically serbs and interestingly enough a lot of these people that right now in the nationalist circles and this is kind of mind-blowing why they're nationalists why they call themselves nationalists but also they're supporting entity like like yugoslavia that is international that is anti-national how why why they're supporting that exactly to wipe out these national differences and create like a yugoslavian identity pretty much to the similar project that the soviets went through you know with the sovietization of their citizens that's exactly the the same pattern here why support this if you are in favor of nationalistic sentiments it doesn't make any sense exactly exactly and and what what i found is the serbs that for example uh they claim that of course uh macedonians were southern serbs they they changed their position tito created this idea of total different uh macedonian slavs that descendants of alexander or whatever this bullshit then they started to use uh basically the croatians that was just uh serbian catholics which is also total bullshit that's a typical greater serbian you know thought you know oh you know these are catholic serbs and macedonia just northern part of serbia and so on you know typical we have heard this before you know it's however what surprises me even more is how some elements within this dissident right can see like stalin as a base man i just find it i just like that brian rue guy he thinks that too and he's he's putting forth his uh nas bowl and alien agenda and also when they downplayed this heinous genocide the hollow domore i mean i mean with one of the chief architects involved with this lazar kaganovich we all know his origin i mean how can they just simply not view it what really happened i mean just it's just shocking just because stalin wiped out some some jews i mean he wiped out today entirely i mean ukrainian dissidents georgian yeah it's all basically just a sigh up on the part of the so-called alt-

right which is tied into the nas bowl type of thing whatever particular you know version that it puts forth it's always this sort of like strasserist uh crypto non-racial or crypto anything but nationalist in a real sense which is blood and soil it's anything that works against that agenda and that creates false associations between you know the agenda of the internationalists in their expansion of empires and whatever organic nationalism actually pre-exists it so that i can sort of insert those uh thought forms in there those those sort of ideologies and then they use that to fragment the currently existing nations or it's just the same sort of like uh fragmentation uh psyop and it's also what what i think because this is a little bit interesting for instance if you look at the foreign policy discourse or for instance these naz balls or even i mean they automatically it's so predicted whenever the u.s dumped something they automatically you know take a diametrical opposed position and and i mean it's it's so it's so oversimplified and this is exactly what happened during the balkan crisis for instance like i heard people saying to me like when yugoslavia you know disintegrated oh you croats you received help from the nato so hentai support the serbs who were very based and so on but people people don't understand for instance when when the war started in yugoslavia the croats received zero support from the international community because the international community at that time gave the serbs a green light you must do everything you can to preserve this wonderful multicultural entity you know it can never however what happened was that in the battle of vukovar in the eastern side of croatia the entire yugoslav military contingency they they tried to destroy this town however and in three months the yugoslavian army had enormous casualties and then the war spread to bosnia and herzegovina and so on and then all of a sudden the serbs were not able to sustain this entity and then all and then afterwards in 94 95 when when the serbs were involved in the conflicts in balkan they started wiping out muslims and so on and well then all of a sudden i give that to people the international community well they started the bombarding serbian installations in bosnia and then afterwards few years later in 1999 due to what happened in kosovo the southern part of serbia which is now separated well then nato started bombing serbia too as a reprisal for what they did over there so and i can understand someone who is not into this oh okay well why obviously i have to support the basers because they were going against these radical muslims and so on which which is not true either for that case but yeah i will i will interject a little bit there was uh bulgarian but i i forget nowadays this is uh i think a conspiracy theory so basically bulgarian intelligence intercept i believe in 1998 or 1997 uh intercept uh messaging between the serbian high command uh about uh eventual genocide and operation uh cleaning operation uh against the cost of the cost of albanians and they gave this information to the germans being a close intelligence service and from that day they decided to to start these operations now pro-communist pro-serbian uh claims that this was uh basically some kind of fake fake uh basically some kind of mystification from the side of bulgarian intelligence against the serbs the problem of this is that the bulgaria is heavily infiltrated by or ruled i must say by these communists so i don't see a reason for them to to create these uh mystification they just intercepted the uh the

serbian messages and they gave it to the germans and that's it basically this is what what i can get and another thing is because you you said that basically this was serbs serbo-slavia uh who who had the the command of the yugoslavian army that was quite powerful at that time who who had this uh you mean the population it was entirely concentrated into serb hands exactly exactly it was totally i mean if you look at the structure i mean if you look at the upper echelon of the communist party well naturally ethnic serbs if you look at the police also the military police also in the hands if you look at the army also in the hands of the serbs now if you look at for instance the conflict what many people do not understand for instance is that i would say it's two peoples that that made yugoslavia a very difficult project one naturally the croats but what is also not talked about so much is the kosovo albanians i mean they had all these upheavals during the 70s during the 80s and so on and especially during the 80s when when tito died and and the kosovo albanians lost their autonomy and so on they were also very critical of this yugoslavian entity and i believe and the conflicts they existed there you had for instance alexander rankovic who was the head of the secret service and so on and he was involved in various types of suspicious activities in kosovo albania as well however you know due to the fact that nato you know intervened and started bombing serbia on behalf of the albanians all of a sudden the albanians are viewed as radical idiots who are siding with nato and this is not entirely true either i mean if you look at because i mean the serbs they really wanted to preserve this kosovo folia that that they call this kosovo region which they argue is part of their national heritage and so on this is very questionable too because if you look at the gene pool of the albanians they're very different from the serbs yeah so basically what i'm looking for uh in wikipedia is operation horseshoe operation horseshoe was on 1999 it was 1999 1998 alleged plan to ethnically cleanse albanian in kosovo the plan was to be carried out by the serbian police and yugoslav army so yugoslav army was still a thing in 1999 claims that the plan was being implemented where nato justification for bombing of yugoslavia during the kosovo war human rights watch said in early 1999 that yugoslav army and the serbian police in an organized manner with a significant use of state resources conducted a broad campaign of violence against albanian civilians to expel them from kosovo and thus maintain political control belgrade over the province uh in 2011 the former foreign minister nadeshda mihajlova uh that is uh half jewish by the way just saying uh related in tv documentary that the bulgarian government had turned over the to the german uh unverified report compiled by its military agency which made clear the existence of the plan even though the military intelligence warned the information could not be verified now honestly honestly the serbs had a quite a long tradition of cleaning yeah i just wanted to tell this is very important if i would be for instance view it from a u.s perspective i would immediately think you know this is bullshit you know it's nato propaganda it's not true and so on however by viewing history further back in time and if you look at how it was during during tito's time as well you had enormous enormous problems with controlling the albanian population from that point on now wow if if everything was so good why would they rebel against yugoslavia would they do it just for

the fun of it of course not they were repressed heavily just as the croats were i mean i'm just being honest on that and the reason why this conflict happened with with kosovo albania is that when when tito died and the serbian especially afterwards during the he simply dissolved the autonomy for the albanians he wanted to integrate it because he saw it as an i don't know why he did this i mean the best thing would be just to give them autonomy and to just let them out it was totally unnecessary to wage a war like that it's it's paradigmatic to what putin did in chechnya now i mean now he will never get rid of the chechen putin if they're integrated into this this russian squares now me i don't know maybe because the albanians get a very high birth rate and they had a high look if you look at this they had a high birth rate i give you that however i mean i just see it i i so why why dissolve the the autonomy i think it was a attempt to just sustain this country too now when when the croats the slovenes and the bosnians were all separated from it and macedonians too naturally it was a desperate attempt to do so but i don't know i think it went out of hand over there i mean totally and it was predicted i mean anyone could have predicted it that this conflict would would happen over there and nationally i don't know it's very difficult to say i would i would say that they just messed up over there totally how was how was the propaganda during yugoslavian time how was the official propaganda about the history of the croatians i mean we established that the croatians are quite old asian people with a different origin from the serbs even though there was a similarity in the language that but uh well i'm gonna explain to you how the discourse the public discourse was at that time like for instance the croat they were like fighting in the eastern front as well during the war against the soviet union and they fought on the in the balkan region too now now all of a sudden and when they when when it became a reality the germans were going to lose that war all of a sudden they lay down their arms and so on now tito he proclaimed the discourse of unity and brotherhood it's called in croatia however it went very wrong because in the in the austrian city of blyburg when the croats surrendered there was asia well naturally the british handed over them to tito's partisan and they slaughtered these people so it was not a good path of reconciliation to go with that now afterwards what they did in every yugoslav movie that you saw it was always an ustasha and a german and some brave partisan wiping out an entire unit you know it was so stupid you know constantly what like one drunk partisan you know it's going out and wiping out the entire german croat unit and the croats that then that that suddenly came to power well they were very communist as well even franjo tujman the first croat president he was actually a partisan soldier did you know that nordlund no but i i was not very surprised here but he was but but what happened to him was this is another different matter he was also one of the youngest generals of yugoslavia at that time however when he went to study history he totally you know went against the official narrative that the croats killed so many people so what the yugoslav authorities did they put him into prison for this and then when he came back he started agitating for a free croatian country and so on and he has until this day considered by the serbs as a as a seeker as a crypto ustasha who nested into you know so but but basically what they wanted to do was like this they started with this

path of unity and brotherhood however the yugoslav authorities especially the udba the secret service they knew instantly you have cells of croat migrants living in germany living in canada living in sweden for instance where i live now and what did they do well they authorize x they authorize extra judicial killings on croat dissidents similar models operandi that the israelis are using when they want to wipe out you know anyone threatening them you know it's exactly the same pattern they had a huge network of traders everywhere you know for instance if they wanted to spot someone in canada or in germany and so on well then they started wiping them out and this of course this does not resonate with unity and brotherhood when you suppress one people on behalf of the others however the serbs enjoyed this naturally it was perfect way for them to utilize power you know yes sure just wanted to make a statement about that the network of sort of like uh clandestine assassins presumably organized and uh controlled or mobilized by massad agents that's basically what's going on right now and i'm sure it's always been that way but in the in the case of like gang stalking and things like that they've got people they target right away and i'm pretty sure that they're just sort of using the social media and stuff and all these other antifa people and various other jews and zionists to spy on uh so-called white nationalists and then they they uh further take that into the real life and then they spy on them in real life tail after them and then once they get sufficient uh you know sufficient numbers or they're this their time to make a strike then they're just gonna basically strike at all of the people all at once exactly and it's extremely dangerous like for instance like you just said that uh secret service what they're doing these extrajudicial killings you know it's and how their capability of infiltrating every kind of movement and so on i i believe i mean in that sense their power is enormous and yeah it's a fourth generational warfare technique exactly exactly i will make a little bit of historical reference so basically this was the case with the inner revolutionary macedonian organization or the bulgarian secret organization that operate in what is now macedonia and what is now northern what's a southern trace or northern greece and what is now turkey turkey greece so basically this organization of the bulgarians it was created by bulgarian uh officers that worked for the military intelligence in many cases and the idea was liberation of the uh bulgarians living there from the turkish yoke and from the yoke of the greeks and the serbs especially the serbs because the serbs were quite brutal the greeks were also quite brutal but the serbs were i mean some people suggest that they were much more that they were worse than the turks which must be telling you something so so basically that this organization created in 19th century they were quite active there was a thing called elinden uh rebellion or uprising that was quite a large uprising against the turks then they formed these people formed the units of the macedonian macedonian infantry divisions that fought for the bulgarian army things like that and these organizations started to be infiltrated by masons and communists uh leftists that started to to push this pansorism in bulgaria in this movement so these uh these people started to uh create these uh secret pacts basically for example uh for example there was a so-called main manifesto in 1924 so this main manifesto was a paper in which the objectives of unified macedonian liberation

movement were presented independence and unification of part of partitioned region of macedonia and fighting all the neighboring balkan monarchies supporting the balkan communist confederation uh so basically the idea of the balkan federation was to include all the countries there all the countries and they must be unified by the communist uh communist ideology and this was pushed by the uh international so in 1990 the balkan communist federation was established as an umbrella group for various balkan communist parties now this is under the these uh the agents are basically soviet jews that are pushing this and masons interestingly enough uh this first meeting was called in sofia to promote balkan communist macedonian question policy it was heavily influenced by the policy of the bulgarian communist party that as i said there were uh they were not bulgarian nationalists they were internationalist and they were rejecting uh they were rejecting bulgarian national identity they were creating this slavo communist identity this is quite quite interesting or so heavily heavily influenced by the policy of bulgarian communist party which had the strongest following of uh either the greek or yugoslavian parties so supposedly at that time the bulgarian communist was stronger than the yugoslavian colonists the bulgarian communist party agenda was endorsed by the soviets who felt it best served their goals of spreading communism on the balkans they felt that the bulgarians were the most revolutionary in desiring the to overthrow the first world war peace settlements that were very uh the after basically the versailles treaty was very very heavy on the germans and on the bulgarians so uh in enforced by the national bourgeoisie establishment of the balkan states they could also play the macedonian card as a source of revolution macedonia was used by the balkan communists as a relying point to overthrow the existing socio-political order for the code for the communist macedonia was to to be a political entity of various nationalities the bulgarian communist party took a full advantage of this bias the further to further its goal the bulgarian communist party is the support on the leftist in the form of international macedonian andrionopol revolutionary organization who is is post pro-balkan federation views they changed their name to macedonia federative so basically this is the beginning of of this creation of separate entity was macedonia and macedonian language and all these things it was forced by the international so yeah so sorry go ahead sorry i didn't mean to cut you off yeah so so basically to uh one of the uh leaders that started to to basically was bribed in the original uh nationalistic uh organization was a general alexander progerov he was bulgarian general he was a leading figure in the bulgarian nationalist movement of the inner revolutionary but he was a mason he was a grandmaster and he signed this uh my manifesto with the communists so this caused uh this caused basically uh his assassination so basically there was uh there was a right wing uh i would say proto-fascist or fascist in the in the revolutionary organization that were led by ivan mikhailov and ivan mikhailov was a close friend with another figure in the croatian movement uh very important figure called uh anti-pavlich so this this is the connection and they are uh also uh basically uh uh trading camps for the mustache and the bulgarian revolutionary that's all a common enemy against the yugoslavian government and against the powers that enforce the

yugoslavian power and it's always i i usually say this to many croats and so on what is extremely important so they can get a good understanding is that bulgaria was one of the absolute first countries that gave our our independence which we are super grateful for i mean yeah so so it gives you that historical connection that we do have now and now what is very important to understand is that what will happen in the future with the balkan region we mentioned this initially like for instance it's always been like a chess chessboard for the greater powers to exert their influence and control this area for various reasons naturally you have like you mentioned the harbors over there the adriatic coast and so on which is extremely important another i would say problem with this is that we see these arrivals of these third worldists coming in in that place you know seeking you know to come into the west where they can you know enjoy you know search for this you know dream of you know so so so we have a huge problem here what's going on here both when it comes to geopolitics and also as a route for for these migrants entering so in the future i i don't know what is i mean can i ask how i mean how is the perception of of russia within alternative circles in the u.s at this very moment is it still is russia still considered as a base country going against you know jewish only card i think there's a lot of people in the so-called truther type movement not necessarily the racist movement but you know like jeff rents and rents.com and things like that i think a lot of those people are still uh you know idolizing putin as some sort of savior or something like that trying to create that appearance he's uh all this russian bear riding the russian bear or something i understand because if i'd be honest with you i would understand let's say during the civil war with the bolsheviks and the whites and so on i would understand if they would take part with the white traditionalist and so on i i can really understand that from that point of view however when they view putin as some kind of a based man who is a neo-bolshevik and who is completely you know nested with these oligarchs like valery kogan michael friedman i mean michael friedman is a is one of these oligarchs that i want to emphasize on because he is the one who is extremely let's say not only that he is rich but he also controls various types of financial institutions in russia and he has a hardcore israeli and also with the with the elements from khabar the lubavitch also connected to putin and his inner circle so that is one issue and the second issue i don't understand either is if you if you utter anything against what happened during the second world war or if you're a russian ethnocentric you know nationalist you might end up in prison so i i mean i mean i i just very surprised that uh that there still is some kind of a support for vladimir putin i mean the americans especially the americans and the germans unfortunately heavily the germans the germans really surprised me in that particular sense not least because i mean i mean guys if you look at what happened you know when the soviet entered you know for instance germany i know that some would say oh you know it's just you know they were under the this idiot this maniac ilia eren buri who was of jewish descent and so on but but nevertheless the atrocities that that that the soviets committed then it's just unbelievable how anyone can see you know russia is based in that sense yes and the the thing is that the russian narrative is basically there was no raping uh of of germany there

was a no no committing crimes there but i mean sorry i don't mean to cut you off but this is a true story this is a really true story i'm not making this up i heard from one of my you know acquaintances who lived and he recently passed away he told me this story when when the soviets entered even in in belgrade they started they went on a let's say raping over there as well and one of the stories that i heard and this was that that's one of the soviet soldier raped a dead woman in serbia imagine i mean this is just i mean the atrocities committed there is unbelievable i think that kind of atrocities reminds of the mongol invasion exactly i mean in modern times i mean so many they raped so many so for the germans it's it's completely i cannot understand why they would ever view russia is based in that sense because they're brainwashed and they they forgot the history and they and and you must understand i i mean most of the people that are listening me know know that i'm not christian and i see christianity like the root of all these things but even if i was christian i i will see this uh this uh empire the russian empire and dugin and all these uh yugoslavian project like satanic like uh like uh inspired by this uh i'll say dark force in the in the in the world because first of all i don't mean to say i don't mean to interrupt you i i am a christian of a traditional sense you know not that i have bought into the spirituality out of it we croats we have some kind of a ties with the vaticans and i was brought up as a christian in that sense however i do agree with you i have shifted a little bit away from christianity due to other reasons i mean i i just however it does not even resonate these atrocities with the christian thinking either so i just don't understand them you know i mean it just blows my mind away because we really have to understand that this was the most atrocious you know um let's say state ever the soviet union it should have been dismantled immediately if if the soviet union would have been dismantled we would not be in this horrible position where we are right now i believe that that is one of the tragedies of history that this state actually was able to survive i have any any thoughts guys on this i mean because we croat sacrificed our lives to just get rid of this bolshevik state i believe that i believe that the the thing with the soviet union is they survived the second world war but actually they kind of lost the war i mean they didn't fulfill their their initial plan to take over all europe and the middle east no but they just gave them a golden opportunity to i mean due to the loss they went into central europe and eastern europe and gained enormous amount of influence in that sense however this if this would have been curtailed somehow we i mean the way i see it from a white nationalist perspective is that if the soviet union would have been dismantled we would not have a greater china at this moment you know expanding and taking over the position as a great economic power we would not have these migrant crises and everything like that it would have been a total it would have been a total different you know scenario there were people like esra pound and charles linberg and henry ford and various other people in the united states william pele who are all trying to put a stop to the second world war because they knew that it was obviously siding with russia was not not their ally and they were more oriented toward germany yes and then exactly and if you hear let's say the russian apparatchiks apparatchiks right now the russian cutters they're saying you know all of

them we have wiped out everyone we have wiped out and called the 12 from sweden we have wiped out napoleon we have wiped out hitler everyone who is externally trying to go into you know russia and so on will get their butt kicked however when it comes to the second world war what needs needs to be addressed here is that they received enormous support from from the british and the united states otherwise they would never never have won that war i mean it's just a simple fact and now they did due to external help that they received however it it would have been a game changer in history and now we are in this horrible post-war situation that is still dominant where germany is suffocated heavily both from the east and the west and this is the reason and not not least to mention these lobby groups are profiting from this heavily to to just vilify germany now yeah and this this is very bad for us i would say i think this is the reason that we are in this horrible mess right now yes i agree i mean if you look at germany it's the heart of europe geographically but also but also culturally and spiritually it's the heart of europe i agree there yeah i agree there 100 percent and after this basically rape of germany and also this this uh this period of uh divide dividing uh germany into two different uh states the eastern germany as we know western germany had a little bit different uh path uh this this cause this cause kind of problems for the germans in their mentality in their culture even to this day you know that there are differences between eastern and western germany and the only thing that i would say that is a little bit more positive we had this uh what you had another guest on from germany and last time i was with you and he told me for instance when i view around stockholm how it is we see many these third world is you know hooking up with swedish women and so on and he told me the last time that you don't see that kind of uh let's say family constellation in germany well that's a big hope for me that this country maybe maybe can be a little bit you know and that it is a future for germany in comparison to sweden that is i think i think that there was a there was a still spirit in the germans especially in these southern and eastern parts of germany they are still especially in the east they're still quite conservative and they're still quite nationalistic so this give me a hope plus the recent events in france and i still are trying to contact this guy uh from uh the ex leader of the youth uh from national now uh and i will i will contact him one way or another but just don't uh answer my my phone calls uh but uh still the thing the thing is that france and germany are the the how to say the leading country in europe especially after leaving uh after united kingdom leaving the european union i believe this this could be nothing but positive for the europeans it's true like you said when britain is out of equation when it comes to european politics that is you have these two core states you know germany and france this artificial alliance i would like to say that is engineered by the bureaucrats in brussels and so on i believe if any one of these will crack you know and and one of them will leave or somehow we will have a nationalistic uprising i think that this will signify the end of the european union which i am welcoming very much however what is worrisome here as well we need to see it how the russians will view it because it will give them also a possibility however i would say that russia is quite considerably weak it is still not fully modernized society i think it's highly exaggerated you know the power of

the russians because the entire russian economy is like maybe italy or like the new york state i think it's highly weak to project some kind of a global power i i think it's it's it's only way to articulate any kind of significance in the world politics is due to the alliance that they have with the chinese and i believe that this will hurt the ethnic russians more than it will benefit them and any thoughts on this i mean don't you think that the uh the military of russia is strong or is that not true that's a paper tiger 2 i think that look i i think when it comes to they could easily flip over estonia latvia and lithuania i think that would be no problem for them i think maybe if the war prolongs in the region that they would maybe even advance into kiev i think that's not a problem however to project that kind of a militaristic power that they will be able to do that on their own i think it's it's a little bit exaggerated in that sense i have a guest on who is a civ nat you know by the name of jeff nyquist and he usually takes this position that russia is so strong and you know it can topple governments and stuff like that i think it is highly exaggerated i think the only way that they're able to to make this happen would be with some kind of alliance with the chinese however i do believe that this alliance will actually hurt the nationalistic sentiments of the russian people too because they would automatically have to reverse you know to a eurasian concept of empire building and i think this will destroy the ethnic russians because look what many people they they can say oh you're so anti-russian and so on i'm not anti-russian i have only i have no problem with ethnic russians and so on i think you know it's a quite a decent society if you look at it there are many engineers many intellectual people over there as well however they are under this they are under also this nightmarish scenario of a multi-racial society with central asian you know people from the caucasus region and so on and i and especially what is very alarming is with the decline of the birth rate of the ethnic russians so i think somehow the russian people will have to choose the path will they embark on this you know imperialist path this eurasian imperialist path with china or will they seek an alternative solution you know for a ethno-nationalistic revival and i prefer definitely the latter i mean yeah i don't think that the russians will choose ethno-nationalism because in a sense duggin it and putting their right in a sense if the russians embrace ethno-nationalism they will lose the empire but if they don't know they will have to yeah exactly they will have to sacrifice this imperial thought and and and like we had the show previously every empire you know that embarks on this expansionist path has been heterogeneous apart from one apart from only one one one and that is the chinese example the the chinese are really doing their job quite good if you look at when it comes to the nationalistic sentiment the foundations of the country and also when it comes to their imperial ambitions however it's not benefiting us who are white nationalist that's kind of a we will lose on this if they become a new economic power it's it's kind of interesting because russians as a as a whole we must dismantle the whole thing with the slav ic identity and then you must dismantle the whole thing with orthodox identity and then you must i agree i agree that that's probably you brought up a very important you know for instance this labophilia this thought or slavs being together and and you know unified under one umbrella it's it's simply it's it's it's a construction constructed project i agree

here too i am and and i would say the issue is also with the orthodoxy and with with the orthodox church as well it's it's equally corrupt as the vatican as the protestant community similar we we have this issue too and not least like like and this is important too with with the zionist tentacles controlling all of these movements it's it's like i i i'm very worried that we will somehow end up in a geopolitical conflict that will wipe us out even more especially now when our birth rates are declining we don't need any unnecessary war we need to like reorganize ourselves and just you know look after our own interests you know it doesn't we we we cannot look anymore you know what either moscow or washington is saying or brussels and so on we need to find another kind of strategy to survive and to give you the exact model of this i don't know maybe a regional perspective where we can network together and survive because another you know like for instance this conflict in ukraine it's total necessary they're killing each other in in a time where we're faced from this invasion from the third world countries i mean i just want to shut down this conflict immediately i mean any thoughts on this because we are in in a different historical situation now i think the uh the greatest danger is in the the jews internationally as a network working with chinese to try to uh impose these weapons on people in the form of the vaccination i think it's a very good point you you just brought up because like for instance i i don't understand either how some alt-rightists can simply side with the chinese because if you studied chinese history i mean the chinese from the cultural revolution i mean if you look at era that was initiated to where they are now as an economic power it has gone sensationally fast you know when it comes to their economic growth and also the power that they project in eastern asia however if you look at also what is interesting they have the chinese let's say officials they only praise the jews you know we have to replicate them we have to include them you know they're part of this silk road you know initiative they're gonna they they are going to play a pencil role in in this scheme and so on so i i just don't understand how they can just simply take the side and think oh the chinese are doing great like you said with the biological weapons that they have you know elaborated on it it's it just become very problematic and we are losing on that china has become a huge power in the in an economic term it has it has suffocated the middle class in europe and the united states i would say when it comes to outsourcing of jobs and everything like that yeah go ahead uh chinese power is basically dependent on american consumerism though so once america undergoes a civil war or whatever uh chaos or obviously even now the whole economy has been deliberately crashed because of this covid crisis that the chinese economy will necessarily go down and so how could they maintain their power that will necessitate some sort of military action on their part and i think that my speculation is that they're working with the jews to deliberately depopulate the north american continent at least if not others through the bioweapon of the vaccine and that's in an actual document by some chinese general where he had stated that uh you know there's a justification for uh basically killing off the americans because of uh whatever whatever excuses so they can take over north america totally for themselves that could be i mean definitely they want to outmaneuver the united states yeah i mean that's definitely the

case and we have seen so many strange things happening but also it's a very expansionist state if you look at their activities in himalaya and so on and you know it just goes beyond that so i just don't see china as something that will benefit us europeans whatsoever i think we will just be in their hands totally so yeah and if like you said if the united states would lose its position as a hegemonic power whoever takes over will not maybe benefit us either so yeah it's not a pleasant scenario for us why i'm pretty i'm pretty confident that the u.s will necessarily undergo further disintegration because you can just see how that's obviously their intention with all the political machinations and the you know political theater the donald trump versus biden and the you know the deceptions there but don't you think if for instance now the u.s has been engaging this horrible war on terror for so many years but however don't you think when this war on terror ends that the u.s will somehow engage in a maybe a geopolitical conflict with the china i mean it could actually happen for instance when in taiwan or anything like that i think that's probably you know one of the uh one of the game theoretic scenarios of the jews that if uh if they feel that it's most effective then they'll basically just have some type of preemptive strike against china you know like with hydrogen bombs or something uh taking out you know military uh military bases in beijing or you know whatever sort of major arteries in china i don't think that the war on terror will ever end it will be like this pandemic it will never end maybe not end but it will take a different you know path than it has been in the past because i usually take this into consideration you know this is very important for instance you obviously both of you guys are familiar with um christopher bolin or yeah yeah yeah and bolin he keeps repeating that it's the same like it was in 9-11 and so on however i see i see it a little bit differently now he i mean usually bolin he he is a little bit special he thinks that every every terrorist act that happens from the salafist is some kind of a false flag in order to advance the israeli interest i don't view it absolutely as this you know any longer could be in the past somewhere false flag to advance the interest of israel and so on but nowadays for instance the liberal media whenever a muslim terrorist commits a crime the illiberal media will immediately say oh no it's he that individual was not a muslim he was not tied to any network it's an act of a lone wolf attack for instance however if if some right winger a sidnat would attack an antifa member or anything like that well then it's a grand conspiracy of a fascist network encompassing the half of the globe of the society it's so stupid so i just don't see it as a false flag anymore the only conclusion that i have reached is just to fill in so many migrants in europe in the us in eastern central europe so so eventually we reach the ratio 45 50 percent and then it's total chaos and then it's much easier for these oligarch families to just dominate handing out free gifts to these stupid you know morons running around the streets and so on they're so duped and this is and this is highly interesting because some alt-rightist and they shocked me they view it you know as this islamic insurgency oh they're natural allies because they will topple this zionist regime i simply don't see that that the case whatsoever to be honest with you i don't whenever we receive migrants let's say from middle eastern countries i don't even want to mention the africans but if you take the middle eastern

migrants entering they are always adopting an anti-racist agenda a left-wing liberal politics and they're always going against nationalists in germany and sweden and so on so i i i just don't see any resisting coming from the islamic world any thoughts on this from from you uh i mean i want to get your take on this islamic world about islamist globalist religion like like christianity but yeah but what is positive with them i i don't understand they keep chanting you know we want to destroy easel and stuff like that however they always go against for instance u.s imperialism they always go against you know for instance the vatican as well i i don't see them as as like like some nationalists have said that they will lead a path and they will destroy zionism and so on i think zionism will prosper even more under on if we have the salafist communities all over any thoughts on this we we know from history that jews are prospering in the islamic worlds i mean the only people that actually resisting them are the europeans and not only and not only christian europeans but also even a pagan roman empire or resisting them in in one way or another the problem with the jews is the problem with the juice is that they always find a way to exploit some weakness in the their host society so if even quite conservative religious states like the bizantium empire like eventually the russian empire they were infiltrated because they were based there they're viewing the jews just like a different religion and the really the the people that uh seeing their real racial ethnic cultural differences with between the jews and the europeans are the basically the germans in the third try as simple as that so from my perspective from my perspective the the muslims cannot be real oppositions of the jews first of all because they had similar origin i mean even if you read their origin myths ishmael is illegitimate or i must say half breed son of avram so abraham or avram he's the the forefather of the jews and of the muslims of the arabs so even from that perspective this is this is uh just showing questionable yeah but so you see it from that perspective but look at also these migrants entering you know and also constantly you know adopting this so-called anti-racist agenda siding with antifa and so on oh everyone is a racist and so on i don't understand how they can view them as allies not even from a geo-strategic point of view they're they're not our allies i mean that this is this is the thing that i was asking some of the bosnian uh some of the connections that i have with the bosniaks what i would love to be in with them if you can have them on i i'm trying to bring someone from bosnia to my show it will be interesting because they're not let me be on the show yes yes i will try but but they're not muslims so they they had quite uh different uh how do you mean are they orthodox or catholics or i believe that one of them is at least my connection said that he's a christian bogomile or whatever which is quite interesting does it still exist the bogomilism maybe they were restoring them but it was kind of anyway it was kind of one of the reasons of of the the balkans falling to the ottomans yes i know i know i know but it would be fine to get i would be fine because every bosnian that i have met for instance living in sweden or living in denmark or living in germany they automatically side with the powers that be that we have to stop racism we have to embrace migrants we have to bring them into the country and give them rights and so on because the bosniaks they were refugees from a war so they they they saw themselves being targeted both both by

croats and by first so i would really want to i mean i would appreciate to have a conversation with a bosniak who is a bit more inclined toward our side that would be very interesting to to hear those thoughts because my interest was what was the influence of the arabs of these saudis in bosnia and he said that actually they had a quite strong influence there which is kind of frightening also because these these arabs they are even more militant than the turks and they're trying to spread this southeast did you know when these extremists came to the balkan you know during the 1990s war yes they were very terrified because they saw both you know one unit come came from hezbollah one other one came from palestine the other one came from you know you know saudi arabia like you said and like you just mentioned these peoples were very militant very aggressive even for the bosnian taste you know they were like oh my god who are these people and they all try to compete to win the hearts and minds of the bosniaks yeah and i think and i think i think it's sad to be honest with you that conflict that they were squeezed in between if you look at the the map of bosnia and herzegovina there was squeezed between croats interest and serbian interest and then all of a sudden when they lost their identity they were very schizophrenic they did not know you know where to go and so on so it's it's i think it's it's it's very sad but but then again it would be very interesting to have a conversation with a bosniak who is a little bit more oriented toward our side because i've only encountered those who are left and liberal leaning and i think it just it just makes me i just feel so it's not good you know for instance because i'm very much caring for what will happen to this country too in sweden in germany and in all over western europe and i think i mean we need to just have so many people on our side as possible that will stop this invasion i i ask i ask this guy is it possible even though they were because i know that there was ss division uh that one i know i know i know i know that so even though that i've heard some christians say that they are actually uh croatia muslim christians yeah that's true i know i know i know and i get this all the time because you know the problem is like this in 1992 i'm gonna give it a you have for instance like the Herzegovina and croat they're considered the most radical croat fascist you know that there are in in bosnia for instance and they told me for instance like this that like some parts like for instance the central central bosnia you had some croats living there and so on and they're very mistreated and so on so i mean when i spoke to them oh what about the second world war and so on and i get the same thing that you get oh you know it's croat croat turks that that it is not not the bosniaks nowadays um so basically they're cooking okay so so but i think it's but but i think it's very important because i always wanted to explain to them look you have to fled this country you know for instance for various reasons which which i can agree but don't you think that it's very important to to to stop this invasion and so on and then some of them then think twice and maybe okay yeah that's correct and if you and if you look now what happened in bosnia for instance when these migrants are coming in oh they're attacking the bosnian women too so so you know so they maybe there is a chance to make them understand look it's not good what's what's happening here you should you know at least have an open eye on this migrant crises that are happening all

the time yeah yeah this is quite because i've watched these old videos of these quite tall white in many blondes uh bosniaks that were dressed dressed like two meters oh two meters yeah yeah and uh by the way the serbs were spreading this disease for that day these were the arabs uh but that's not true yeah no look look i'm gonna give you look i'm i'm gonna give you that my honest opinion of what i think it was a huge tragedy that because they felt they were okay the croats are attacking us from one side the serbs are attacking us from the other we are european muslims we don't have anything to do with the middle east and and that is true that is true on on the one hand however the problem is that due to the fact what happened during the war in the 1990s we have all of a sudden seen a shift of these young bosniaks siding with the islamic state so i feel bad but still it's a minority in comparison because i believe that they wanted they did not have any opportunity to retort with alia is a bag which they thought okay we're going to create our own state as well but it was never islamic fundamentalist like the serbs say so i give you that and furthermore and furthermore i'm going to give another example the bosniaks knew quite well rather we stick with the croats than we stick with the serbs because the chess would have wiped them out and and we saw this in serebrenica what happened the serbs totally and and that's however what makes me a little bit i mean nowadays when i look and when i find a bosnian bosniak botanas or whatever we want to call them and and when i talk to that what do you think about the migrant oh you know we especially the the female ones they're like oh no we have to take them in and i think fuck you you know we don't need more migrants what the hell you know listen we're facing the biggest historical challenge ever we have openly invited the strangers into our own community for instance in the past we would have put out some kind of resistance now we invite morocco tunisians uh you know algerians you know the sub-saharan people and so on this is the biggest biggest biggest problem that we have if we not come to end with this we're screwed and i think yeah go ahead my friend yeah interestingly enough i told you that i was in albania in 2019 some albanians even though they're muslims they got what is going on in europe and they don't like it and this is kind of controversial because islam as i said it's a it's militaristic and they want to create a global uh islamic domination so this is the you know you pointed look i'm gonna give you my my honest opinion about albanians too because i know them quite well the albanians what saves them is this that they have this connection you know a very nationalistic sentiment based on skanderberg and skanderberg was a christian who fought against the ottoman and this is paradoxical how so skanderberg is integrated into their nationalistic sentiment however they also cherish turkey so they're a little bit so so this is very special so if you ask an albanian look what do you think they're very ethnocentric they understand they have a very good understanding what's going on in the west and they're very endogamous they want to keep within their group so somehow i have always seen them look it's the national sentiment that saves them more because they cannot open up to embrace islam you know this because if you embrace islam you embrace some kind of cosmopolitanism look at the isis fighters they have somalis with one teeth you know in their mouth fighting for the country that's true for the caliphate so

i think nationalism like you like you have said it's a so strong power to be reckoned with and i think we should just i i think we should just support albanian nationalism too i think it's very sound i don't view it as negative to be honest with you have i ever talked with with the serb that had a normal stance on the questions that we are discussing to be honest with you one of the best discussions i had with the serb was with uh was actually with a very i think he was uh i i think he is uh the aspirant served because i tried to talk with him you know in our language and he could not understand so i think he's very assimilated a very intellectual guy i give him i mean we have very good discussion about you and so on that was what happened he was very very good and uh but the worst i think that i have conversation with with the yugoslavia with the communist serbs the worst the worst possible conversation you can have everything was like the ustasha it was legitimate to kill them and so on but when i talk to this when i talk to this everything i think he resides in canada or the us i would love to have him on i have it was actually the reason why i started this youtube channel he was one of the first who gave quite good arguments i was able to pick him apart quite easily but he was he was very good i would love to have him on he view is from a great serbian perspective but he understands what's going on he understands also for instance that voicelove sheshelly was a clown he gave me that argument he said voicelove sheshelle and blotting me to chirinoski you know controlled opposition he understood these things so i would love to have someone like that on however however it was nevertheless it was a very anti-croat stance that he took um but but he was very interesting i would love to have him on if i get the opportunity what was his position that basically you're fascist oh my god he was like he he he he he insisted saying all the time when i called it serbo slavia that he said oh no the croats the communists were resolved in this he even went and pick apart the regional parts of croatia for instance istria dalmatia and so on and he he gave he was very good i'll give you that the only thing that shocked me that he was so much for a great serbian empire and but he was very good understanding on this uh zionist issue i i give him that and he also understood the path that that serbia took was not good but he was an exception to be honest with you i don't know if he was a really ethnic serb because i tried to talk with him on you know on our language and so on and no response there so i don't know i mean but but overall but but he was the one who who got me started into this youtube channel so we had very good discussions uh and so on this was kind of interesting because the the service that i have met they were like sieve nets going against islam you know preaching for a greater russia same old bullshit it's so easy to pick apart these fools you know it's my my answer my uh conversations with balkan nationalists were back in the early 2000s and let's say that they gave me a lot of bad taste because every nationalists had their own propaganda including bulgarian nationalists believe in some a lot of bullshit uh without many and i don't know it's very hard to talk with these people without basically uh entering in the area of these um how to say chauvinism and and the other hand some nations obviously had big problems with their identity but i just wanted i just want to say that you're doing a tremendous a good amount of work i just want to give you that respect you know and i i'm very glad

that you have invited me to your shows and i think i think the work that you're doing is extremely extremely important to cast a light on this what's going on you know with this with this nasible infiltration of a greater eurasian you know empire i think it's very good and furthermore i would like to say and i always say that that you can have internet discussions like for instance you know who has done what who has done this and that but what i respect with you extremely is that you have put this active you have put your your your mouth where the money is in 2015 when we had one of the worst refugee crisis you actually took you know with your friends the hands into your own matter stop this insurgency you know with all these migrants entry and for that i give you my outmost respect for what you have done and i think this should be an example for what true activism is and i believe that in in the future for instance i will have to be active myself as well you know not just you know with these internet discussions i think it's very important i don't want to downplay it but somehow we will enter a very tough phase in our society and i think the only way to stop this will be with activism you know so i think i always and this is a thing that i'm trying to tell including to our american friends i was always for the direct action and in nowadays it's very easy to to become a nationalist just talking and sharing and i was for direct action and i was active in my teenage years so early 2000s in the nationalist movements and 2016 not 15 16 when these these happened with these big wave this is just because you see since 2006 when i entered this bulgarian national alliance i'm talking with the younger members and i was saying that the collapse is coming i mean even back in the early 2000s we can see the the crumbling of the of the system exactly and i think and i think for this for this amount of work like i i i told some croats that i know that i have you know encountered you know you and your show and the work that you're doing i told i i think this man deserves all of the respect you know that there is and for that i'm gonna give it to you and and furthermore i would like to say is that in the future who knows what will happen i think we will embark on a very you know problematic path and i think we should you know work together because i believe that activism will be the only way in the future if we want to sustain our society so i think it's for for for balkan nationals is relatively easy to to uh how to say to gain our traditions from the past because you see ustasha was very active in direct action against the communists the serbian chetniks and other enemies it is very easy for the young generation of just to look at these historians to to take the same path the same for bulgarian nationalists we have these revolutionary movements against the turks against the serbs against the greeks and against the communists and this is very easy when you know history to just to to see what is the yes yes but i want to say something i agree and i think you you you you see it from the perspective and i think look to be honest with you i think it's very easy for us to enroll younger croats younger bulgarians into our cause and i think it's it will inevitably lead to this because look the the way i see it right now it's swarming in these migrants like it never has and we have also a corrupt elite not only of course they're there's some kind of they're controlled by these oligarch families and so on but nevertheless this indoctrination has gone so far that even the average joe you know thinks oh i think it's good to have these

migrants entering they're suffering you know and and and and this problem is that i don't think that it can ever be resolved through parliamentary means in my younger years i used to talk okay maybe through parliamentary regime we can read if we can revert this and so on i don't think that this ever will happen i think our societies will break down and when to break down the ones who really have done something is the one who who have been active and i think this is the only way to to stop this madness so i think you have done something that many people have not and this is a huge huge respect from my side thank you uh i'm propagating uh this uh i mean we must work on networking i mean at some point i will i will visit croatia and i hope to to see and to me if you come to me you can stay at my place i will show you around everything i mean you will be my guest of honor and i mean the most definitely and i would love to visit your country too i have friends that have been in bulgaria sadly i have i have been all over eastern and central europe but i have never put my foot into bulgarian soil but i would love to do so maybe sofia will be a place that i will go to to look around i i don't know but i i think it's i think it's good to we understand i mean the thing that i like about you is i mean due to the fact that you understand history from a very good point you understand the different how to say how the differences among these people too you understand also the zionist issue you understand definitely the racial issues too and for me those are the most important aspects out of it if you comprehend these aspects and if you have balls to to let's say that you want to preserve your country because i don't see this among swedes now i'm going to give you an example the swedes they bitch and moan about what's happening the younger kids you know they have like the nordic resistance movement what is it 0.001 percent of the population or maybe they will do something but it's but they're leaning they're gravitating toward the civil net side with the swedish democrats and when i see for instance these migrants acting so horribly they're like oh you know i don't know what to do they're very spoiled you know from the welfare state from the swedish culture in the society we need people that that are reaffirming their beliefs that look i can be active i don't want this we can go head-to-head with these people and i think we need this because obviously the governments will not support us ever you know they will not i think it's a result the more affluent the country is the more uh more lazy the people are and the less willing they are to actually participate in anything that's contrary to political correctness that's mainly what that causes yeah well that's one of the aspects but if you look at for instance like nordloks you and i have discussed this in the past for instance if migrants would enter my my native homeland and if they would let's say go on uh they would go on a raping spree or they would groom people they will see immediately they will burn down all of these you know they would they would they would actually kill them i mean it's not like in sweden oh we you know we're gonna have to contact our authorities we're gonna have to do this you know we had one one maniac who was running around you know driving and killing people and so on and the swedes they left their they went to look after and call the ambulance for this guy if this would happen in bulgaria or in croatia we would immediately kill this individual who has done this you know and and i think i think in one way or another i

think that that eastern and central europe one way or another will become a safe haven i mean you mentioned on the previous shows that there are some brits you know who have left great britain and they have settled down in bulgaria and so on and i think i think that that we would demand these people to show an appreciation for what our countries and our peoples are doing you know because oh sorry go ahead no i i think we should show these these people an appreciation for doing not to try to you know transform these societies oh they have to be more civilized because i heard this bullshit too when english people are buying you know houses in dalmatia where i'm from and so on in croatia oh you know the croats they need to they need to move beyond this narrow mind and view it from the wall and i think why why are you coming here you know we want to preserve a safe haven we care for our people and i think it will boil down to activism in one way or another because as i said the governments somehow through parliamentary means change this we already see this it's not happening if we install national government nationalistic governments we will have even more problems i think it's easier for us to facilitate our politics if we have left the liberal governments in power any thoughts on this yeah let me make a comment from the perspective of someone in north america here since i've been trying to participate in what would possibly be a movement in this in the country where i'm in uh i've never been able to find a single person who is actually legitimately involved in any activism ever ever everywhere i've ever been in across like the whole country so no matter how much effort i put in i try to contact people but there's absolutely nothing so there's nothing you can do in this country uh to participate in any like pro-white or racist orientation because it simply doesn't exist because guys sorry sorry go ahead my friend yeah the only hope that i can see as you are saying is people migrating to eastern europe and using that as some sort of safe haven uh that they can participate in and actually become more actively involved in something in real life uh because otherwise it's just going to become like a sweden in this country in all the uh so-called westernized countries or south africa because things are exactly it's too affluent here and the people are too uh they have that uh mind set of that sort of christian liberal uh mentality and they don't have sufficient experience with hardship to be able to understand the necessity of basic natural life in other words actual opposition to foreign invaders and so forth they're just so uh sheep-like in their behavior that they don't have the that life experience that only people like you have no because because you know for instance i'm going to give you my example for instance like when for instance i have um children you know and uh by a swedish you know woman you know and and she was like when she met me she was like shocked you know how can you you know it's so and and i always you know teach my children to be very proud of the northern heritage you know you have to you know you have to be proud you have to look after your interests and so on and when i see these other i live in a middle class neighborhood and so on and when i interact with these youngsters and so on i see that they're very spoiled they're not used to you know especially when someone is coming in from you know middle east or africa and so on and they are like spoiled kids and i try to you look these these invaders are coming to take over you they want to

totally destroy you take over your women take over your society and everything you have to be more proactive you have to fight for what's yours they're like a little bird basically you know thankfully i've managed to make my kids at least ethnically aware what's going on without indoctrinating them too much because you might end into trouble if you do so here but but nevertheless and and and the way i see it is that the resistance that will come obviously i mean my native country and bulgaria and other countries too they went through wars they have you know seen what's going on as well so nationally we'll have a resistance there but i i think number one number one is that we have to we have to network we have to cooperate because it's a little bit different now than it was like 50 years ago in in history we are under constant threat now the biggest scenario the worst case scenario we saw in south africa you know these looters going crazy you know and the food supplies you know are you know are are diminished and so on so this is a perfect example what might happen you know to us if we don't act now i would say i think that's what they're doing they're trying to orchestrate the uh food shortages and once they do that then there's going to be a lot of riots on the part of the non-whites in north america because in the last year they deliberately destroyed huge amounts of the crops and farm animals in in america and in canada also they basically severed the supply chain from vancouver just in the last month or so they deliberately used harp technology to melt down the railroad tracks coming in from vancouver which basically shuts down the whole supply chain you're based in canada or that's right yeah yeah okay okay vancouver vancouver i think there's any croats living there or not too sure but yeah i think so yeah i think i think so too yeah but i think i think you know we need to have some kind of uh i mean we need to organize ourselves i mean it's not look it looks pretty bleak on what's going on with us you know how many europeans are in existence right now ethnically europeans i mean and hard to say i mean if we include what is it they they claim what 900 million but i believe it's less 450 450 million maybe perhaps europeans or maybe maybe something like that yeah something like that and if you look at it we have one 1 billion indians we have 1.3 billion chinese we have 1.6 or 7 billion muslims from all corner of the world so we in we in 2045 2050 we'll have 2 billion african you know i mean it's not looking that good i mean to be honest and in spite of this we have these traitorous governments okay they could be i agree with this i'm designing influence but they're also cultural marxist totally brainwashed and we have also this problem with these liberals from the economic spectrum who are you know for a neoliberal order they believe in free movement of goods people and services and capital so i mean look obviously wall street is against us the communists are against us the other ones too the special people are against us i mean i mean i mean we need to organize ourselves because i mean with the french with the germans with the danes with the swedes i mean okay i see some kind of resistance the only positive thought is that in in my work where i have i have younger lads working with me and i try to subtile you know make them understand what's going on and they understand they see it too despite that they're living a let's say a middle-class life they're seeing it i can see a lot of generations having more hope in that regard because they don't have that affluence that

the current uh well established generations have like the millennials even they're more established in their careers so they have vested interests and you know clinging to the lies of society that continues to give them what they want yeah but i think i think look it's it's like and i i mean the biggest issue that i have is with people who only look after their career interests especially the boomer generation that can say look like this german guy nord lux the guy who was last time he was yeah yeah he told me and this was very interesting that the boomer generation germany are thinking like this you know okay we have 10 15 years i will try to prosper the best as i possibly have and then all of a sudden the country will decay into total chaos and i think it's such a disgusting thought you don't think about the younger generation what will happen about your kids your grandchildren and so on and i think this is something that we need to really accentuate and think about it you know because what the baby boomers should be doing is using the resources they have to benefit posterity in the form of uh you know buying up arable farmland and so forth hobby farms and so on but they're not going to do that because they're so indoctrinated with their possessive individualist ideology that they can't think beyond that that's all their their whole world view it consists of exactly and also their view was like short-sighted you know just think okay it will work out for me career wise and and also we have this issue with feminism and so on and this is a horrible horrible plague that has hit sweden so extremely hard it's it's unbelievable so um yeah we're into we have to look into our interest number one i usually say this you know to to put it to boil it down quite simple i'm a euro centrist mainly i don't care what's happening in the middle east i don't care what's happening in the far east either or you know the sub-saharan continent as well i only care that we could sustain and prosper us europeans that's the number one priority number one i think especially oh yeah go ahead and especially for canadians and u.s and whites too go ahead yeah i was gonna say about the feminist and women issue that you know they seem to they gravitate quite a lot toward the more uh non-whites at least to some extent and various other types because they display more of a of a macho type of personality or exterior sure sure you can always naturally gravitate toward that so obviously if you want to attract women then you have to be willing to demonstrate that you can stand up and actually oppose what is going on otherwise you're just going to repel basically i'm going to give you two examples for instance in sweden maybe this pattern is applicable to other countries in europe as well but the thing is like this one is the upper classes in sweden they are traitorous they don't care about the low income white swedes or the swedish working class so money is one issue and that leads to definitely power especially for the upper middle classes and so on and the second thing is like you said with the macho culture from these migrants coming in you know and taking over to have this war tribe mentality who want to conquer conquer and to some stupid feminist this can actually appeal to something that's because be conquered yeah exactly one way either financially speaking if they side with someone who has a lot of cash or if they side with someone who is more macho either way for let's say the lower middle class on the one and the working class we were both screwed in that sense you know so the best way would be now i would like to say this now with the left

has suffered such a legit legitimacy crisis especially now with all of this bulkism and so on we will have a unique opportunity to just enroll all of these you know working class into our movement i think it will be very easy to do so i think that's a good technique because that's really the only demographic that you can appeal to because they've obviously betrayed the what they previously claimed where they were champions of you know the working class as marks exactly and then they shifted over to the cultural marxism so they shot themselves in the foot that way and there's really no way that the jews can possibly co-op that except through the nazbol siop that sort of uh you know nebulous ill-defined uh national bullshitism which doesn't really mean anything it's just garbage but i agree with you 100 this is a golden opportunity but there is another thing that we must take in mind i don't think that in croatia there are a lot of nazbols around no i think nazbolism is a little bit difficult uh to to i mean because i mean the problems would be huge with the russian influence so i think it's difficult to take them into this but this is uh i i think that nazbol is created specifically for the needs of the imperials imperial uh countries like russia maybe eventually america this is that basically pull the wool over the eyes of the gullible americans because the americans don't know anything about history or politics in any global sense because they have a very myopic worldview so they'll basically swallow whatever comes from without because they they don't have critical distance or capacity for reasoning i mean i mean who knows what will happen because i think that somehow you have the certain lobby groups you have you know for instance the party at davos you have the wall street club you have for instance these cultural socialists within the media and all of them are working so much to just fill in fill in europe you know so in the future maybe the the western you know civilization will be partitioned you know on the one hand you have the eastern and central europe that will preserve their heritage and on the other hand you will have some kind of a weird you know metamorphosis of you know islam and these non-white migrants you know living in a liberal society who knows what will happen but for our sake the best thing is definitely to side with the ones who are active who want to be doing something not just talking you know my my speculation is that the kalergi plan is deliberately designed uh for that purpose to try to basically uh you know make america the sort of mongrelized melting pot that was the whole plan from the beginning was basically even from the inception of america when it was first created to deliberately uh use the white slave labor as the builders of the nation and then once they do that then they can start you know immigration crises or whatever and deliberately dilute the white population through the flood of mud and then from there yeah they can create their new jerusalem which is what they intended from the beginning basically through that dialectic yeah well yeah i mean it's it's one way of looking at it i mean yeah and obviously the fears of going into that this devastating path it will cause huge turmoil uh but the way i did it the way i see it the resistance is definitely eastern and central europe and i only hope that they will put the resistance against the brussels because i know for instance my homeland is uh is very much in favor of this liberal capitalistic order so they can be quite receptive to what's going on in at least the elitist are what's going on in brussels however to to just

make the peoples go hand in hand with this will become virtually impossible i would say and the same goes for bulgaria too any thought i mean we will not accept this i will move to bulgaria i don't think that croatia will have a problem with nationalism and honestly i think that we must revive the old alliances like ustashe with the bulgarian nationalist that would be the most ideal that would be the most ideal and eventually i i don't see any other albanians as i said and the bosniaks a little bit specific because of majority of their religion but we can enroll them it's no problem i think it's like you said if the shift would happen in bulgaria in croatia i think it's very easy that the other ones would adapt automatically to our side the only problems that we have is with these serbs who still would you know cacophy so much for russia that we need russian empire and so on and this is not good this is not good i think that the russians will use the turks like a factor on the balkans and this is this is one thing that you pointed out look in 2015 we had a crisis on a micro political level between turks and russians however two years after this all of a sudden there was a geopolitical alliance between russia and turkey now isn't that kind of interesting because imagine these serbs who are so duped by russians they thought that the russians will help them against this islamic insurgency all of the sudden the russians well they have simply co-opted chechnya and russia into their square in a greater geopolitical scheme to outmaneuver the west so i mean it's like you said obviously they the geopolitical scheme is to create a schism between you know turkey and nato so they can simply enroll turkey into the greater scheme of a geopolitical competition to outmaneuver the west and i believe that this is the path that we're heading towards the thing is that i'm not sure basically turkey must be i mean turks must realize that they cannot compete with the russians on the military level economically and geopolitically russia is much stronger than turkey but the turks they had their grand idea of pan-turkic empire with all these central asian states and of course the mediator for this is russia because they cannot so basically we're we're talking about can i ask you can i ask you about turkey because i've been to turkey on several occasions and i must ask you this some turks that i have talked to they are for instance they're also very much you know thorn in the one hand they don't want to see an islamic cloud all over their country because then they will lose their camalistic nationalist sentiments on the other on the other hand you have these fundamentalists wouldn't it be wouldn't it be better if somehow we would if turks would remain nationalistic i think that would be a better option for us because what do they have they have three million arabs under their territory that they are currently controlling now i know that they're using this as an extortion racket for erdogan to advance his political interests and so on but wouldn't it be better if turkey i mean my theory is if a dark cloud would sweep over turkey we would be in a horrible situation then because then we'll send all those migrants to us any thoughts on this yeah yeah so i thought about that so basically the thing with the turks is that at one hand it's it's it's it's dangerous because they want to restore the ottoman empire on the other at the other hand today for now they they look like ally of russia which is also also dangerous and quite unpleasant but at the other hand we need the country to keep these these middle easterners away from us because when i was in

turkey and when i talked to people they told me like this like these syrians these you know other arab migrants coming in from afghanistan and everywhere and the turks told me they were fed up with this too and i was like a little bit surprised are they acting like this here too and i said yeah they're acting like this too but the only difference is that the turks you know they're much more fierce than what the germans or the swedes are doing and then i thought to myself wait a minute i mean i think i mean if they remain kamalistic and and and nationalistic i think it's better way to control them because then if we have good relationship with turkey they can curtail this insurgency obviously we've seen when libya fell well then it has become just a transit route into italy much easier maybe the best thing would be maybe the best thing would be if we have nationalistic turks running the show so we can just so they can keep them under their territory because honestly i just want to stop this invasion this is number one priority for us can i ask in what part of turkey in the you were in the of course of course in the european in the european no i was i was i was actually in ankara for a business meeting and then i was also in a forest resort with my family as well so i was in both parts and both parts opened my eyes a little bit i saw quite good sentiments in in ankara when i was there too i was very surprised i thought i thought i would be in a trouble and so on but i got quite good quite good response back from those that i spoke to but ankara was very divided on the one hand you had um let's say government offices and so on very modern very like the west and on the other side it was like iraq is right now so it was very divided ankara because my perspective is that these european turks that in many cases they had much more european ancestry than the the anatolian turks they are more inclined to to to european culture and civilization meanwhile the most of the electoral electorate of erdogan from anatolia and they prefer their civilization a culture the islamic ottoman turkey so and this is the problem because basically we have these two societies that they're looking to the future of turkey of different directions and at one hand basically the existence of the turkish state is a is a threat for europe because well if they're nationalistic what kind of nationalism they will practice exactly exactly exactly that's true that's true i agree because basically from from what i can see yes uh at the turk basically this uh policy of uh at the turk this naturally naturally uh was accepted for turkey because the turks was was in very bad situation after the first world war of course the crumbling of the ottoman empire the only way to to survive was to act in that mode and i agree with it however we need to reconsider i mean it's a little bit complicated in that sense i don't i don't uh i i i just see it we need to just form some kind of alliance there i mean i don't know if you know maybe you know better i mean maybe maybe but i still don't see i mean the natural interest of the turks what are the natural interests of the turks they want to to keep their very strong influence on the balkans and in the middle east and also and also they had a very strong diaspora in germany yeah which is which is uh how many three million three million in germany three and a half i believe ah nice yeah but did you know what happened did you see the footages when for instance uh i saw these couples between these migrants from syria and so on and the turks were were going against the syrians did you see that no but i can suggest that this is true and

i also spoke with some turks that that told me oh you know berlin berlin was so wonderful during that time now we have syrians now we have somalians and so on and then i thought when this turk is saying this oh maybe there can be some kind of a you know you know some kind of alliance eventually eventually but but it depends you see russia is pumping enormous amount of money in turkey like uh what i saw was uh was more than trillion dollars or something like that in turkey which is enormous amount of money for for my understanding and turks will i think that truth will inclined to to accept this pan-europeanism because in in a sense this is the only way to unite and to engage in their pan-turkic ideal idea this is the only way to accept duganism to accept this pan-europeanism because basically it's not contradictory with the islamic ideology it's not contradictory with pan-turkish ideology and basically the only and also also uh this will buffer china because chinese against sure the geopolitical geopolitically they will see as an opportunity to take over a nato country of course for the russians the only thing that i can see is basically i don't know basically some kind of of split in turkey between on the on the european and asiatic part of turkey maybe this this could be that could be that could be that's a very good point that you brought up yeah that could be maybe this this could could help europe a little bit because basically uh european turks will want to to uh to uh maintain the european type of living meanwhile the anatolian turks they i don't know i don't know what what they want actually but my suspicion is that they want to re-establish this islamic state this sharia like it was during the time of the ottoman empire probably that's a very good case it is a little bit complicated with uh with them and uh i mean we we have to look after our interests what is best for us you know and uh just some way out of this madness at this very moment and i i mean some some view turkey as a base country that's going against zionism and so on but they have excellent relationship with israel you know extra especially for the water supplies to israel and especially also with them i spoke to some turks that are critical of zionism and they say that they are very in in in istanbul very pro-zionist forces and so on so yeah it's it's a little bit conflict complicated than that and like you said but also it's very interesting like the jews they really wanted to make the ottoman empire crumble so they can create their own state you know and so yeah and it it fits into what we have discussed here earlier you know like the slavophilia mobilization against the turks a greater serbia you know yugoslavia and so on and just goes into this pattern somehow the the pattern is basically you know my position maybe i told it many times that basically behind all these politics and geopolitics and the economy there were some occult ideas these occult ideas and they are believing in these mythos and they want basically these global globalist empires and behind the data these imperialist globalistic egalitarian religions like islam like christianity like buddhism if you want and they want these uh the the they're opening the gates for this next level of of egalitarian societies that uh yeah i'm agreeing i agree so so basically basically the the whole system must be dismantled uh not only not only modern egalitarian egalitarian ideologies but also the ancient egalitarian ideologies because you cannot claim that you're nationalist and christian okay you can claim that you're nationalist and christian but in reality the the the

ideology of christianity is equality without nationalism exactly and that yeah and that's yeah well eloquently put it to you exactly equality in a supranational you know entity and so on we'll all get along and i think it's something that has played us from the past and i think it will it will really come across us now i think yeah probably and it goes hand in hand with this universalist conception whether it's socialism whether it's neo-liberalism it goes hand in hand with this so i agree so because the conversation is going in the more than three hours my suspicion is that we must continue the conversation at first i was planning to talk about historical figures like uh antipa village and evab michailov because they're good example you see i had this conversation with patrick and he said oh he's always talking about these lefties that are terrorists and things like that and that the left is exemplary for political terrorism and how they're forcing their will but actually it's not exactly like that i mean the nationalist movements they were also quite well organized much better than if i'm honest much better than these lefties and for a very long time actually they were these secret underground organizations that were organized well enough to fight these terrorists so my idea for the next podcast is just a historical uh historical presentation of for example uh anti-publish i will do so gladly next time we have the podcast i will do yeah a good explanation for you with the anti-publish and with the ustasha movement from 1929 and onwards that happened no problem yeah i think what's with the ustasha what's quite unique i just want to mention this is that for instance many you know peoples that fought on the eastern front and so on i i think if you look at history from that sense we have a tradition of uh fighting bolshevism on a grander scale i mean in comparison if you look at the poles what they did is nothing likely to what the croats did you know we had uh we we advanced very quick into the eastern front we did very well and i think that this eventually led to our independence as a croat state for what we have done historically what would you say i would say that these i was watching back in the time years ago i was watching these uh young ustasha and these very nice looking girls with the ustasha uniforms and making these uh concerts uh what was this singer Tomic i believe yeah yeah yeah yeah yeah and i thought that uh overall the ustasha is more like uh popular like much more popular in the present day croatia than uh than the nationalism in bulgaria even though the nationalism in bulgaria could be said that it's accepted like establishing ideology i thought that those stashes are much more popular and this is a good example at least in my mind that i think it's very important to understand here and i don't want to go like that but if you look at for instance the yugoslav army was the fourth largest army in europe and we and we actually in in the battle of vukovar or anyone who wants to go into this can check it out we actually crippled the yugoslav army with our bare hands and this is even acknowledged among the serbs and sorry about the russians and montenegrin they they they even say that to serbs the croats defeated you with their bare hands you know it's embarrassing for us you know even the russians said so so and and i usually say this to my serbian counterparts and they're not very happy with this but then when they go and check the the sources and they will see that even it was an embarrassment for the russians they were god how could they fucking destroy you like

this so yeah i mean i think we did a lot we we fought on the eastern front we had antepavlović definitely and and during the 1990s as well so we really showed the world what we can do you know and i my only hope is now as a croat and as a patriot that we will put out a new resistance against this new current wave that is hitting us you know so i embrace everyone who is going against this sincerely from from the bottom of my heart who is going against it if it's france if it's hungary i don't care we have to stop this immediately because i care not only for the what happened historically but even for the futures for our children grandchildren and so on so we can sustain ourselves i i mean if it's bulgaria i'm more than happy to join the bulgarian movement you know i mean i think it's it's people like you have done tremendous work and not just sitting and watching and and for that i i give my utmost respect for a lot of you doing this so that will be my final words i will say that as i said we will continue establishing connections and we will i mean let let's be honest for for the western europeans there are several choices the same for more or less for the americans america obviously will fall i mean unfortunately will fall without establishing a national national government it will be much easy if they manage to establish national government and then america could be a platform for the like a protector of the white race but unfortunately it looked like it won't happen i hope that a certain group of nationalists in in america will take power but most likely it won't happen for the western europeans that there are several choices so first obviously obviously they must form network and their own land and trying to resist the invasion but i don't think that this will happen on the basis that then there they will be outnumbered they the nationalism is not very popular in western europe the the other the other choice is to move here now if they are normal people uh like like conservative and they will of course embrace our culture and and from what i can get croatia is very beautiful country with very nice people and if even these brits and whatever germans are moving to croatia it will be beneficial for them also to embrace the culture i hope so i don't i don't i hope so i don't like this i mean i think i think i would wish for for instance for us croats living abroad that we will go back all of us you know that would be the most ideal i mean but i i hope that they have good intentions with my homeland and i hope they don't seek to transform it to a shithole country like the others you know because we we i want only what is best for the people of my country i want always best for all of europe i love europe i mean i'm pro-european i'm a croat nationalist at heart and i'm pro-european i'm pro-white that's number one that that's everywhere i look at it of course yeah so so so so so that's why i think it's important to have these shows to network and to get along with people and to we need to figure out a way to we can survive this madness because it's it's no other option we have to organize ourselves that's number one now and then we have to look at all the geopolitical alternatives and so on so we have to always be suspicious we know who are looking upon us right now and who don't want us any good and that's the number one thing number one yeah which reminds me which reminds me what do you think of hungary and the hunger hungarian nationalism i think hungary is quite good i uh it's a little bit of a moral decay i've been to budapest i like it i think it's a little bit too much influence from liberalism

hungarians are a little bit special i uh i respect them our i don't like i i don't like too much zionism involved in this i uh i hope that uh hungarians are very special people man i mean uh i i do respect them but i i think we need much broader than this i think we cannot rely solely on poland or hungary i think we need to look at bulgaria we need to look at croatia we need to look at other countries too yeah yep but yeah yeah yeah i i accept that and also i know that uh orban is basically pro-putinist and he's uh he's a zionist show basically he's directly yeah he's zionist i mean you wouldn't influence i think too much well yeah that would be my thought so uh when the jews and they have always they thought on eastern and central europe i think it will eventually come to that they will they will target croatia which i'm very worried about because of yes animals what happened there and i think yeah i think this will happen to us too and i hopefully we will remain very strong and with you guys i have only optimistic views of what will happen with us i must think that way i mean otherwise we will perish i don't want that i think we have unique civilization i think it's only unique i only have love for us you know i i think i think we have gone through many phases in history that will make us prosper and i think we should never let the struggle never never let the struggle you know just bury us never and i don't care what people think oh you know sivna you know you're infiltrated i don't care i care about the survival for us that's number one priority number one so uh any final words if i could just say one thing i think uh being very conscientious about infiltration and all these other sort of divisive whatever you want to call them sort of uh people who introduce irrelevancies and divisions various ideas or plans or proposals that are not conducive to more purity spiraled basic national socialist principles or principles of nationalism in general which is blood and soil people like that very often are infiltrators so people need to be especially wary and also involving yourself with anybody who uh you should you assess them based upon the nuremberg laws yeah have any features that look jewish then they should be more or less you know looked upon with under a magnifying glass great i just want to utter one statement if i can go um croatian too uh uh uh i just want to thank you two guys thank you for having me on so much and i think we should just continue this i think you're doing a great job both of you i'm very happy to join this show and i think we have uh i think i think the next generation will have to look upon us and think look these guys are really thinking of something you know we're under severe threat and i i think if we don't organize ourselves if we don't become stronger we will perish and nobody wants that even i don't care if you think in career turns if you think of this look we will not be able to exist as a people and we'll be just flooded by these foreigners that have no they haven't they have nothing to do in europe and that's what i wanted to say that would be my final words my friends i will add and i will uh say like a witcher and hail victory hail victory and victory okay
