

The New Testament is very different. Jesus is an incarnation of the Aryan Saviour. But, he is preceded by Peter, who is the Devil. Matthew 16:23. Then there is Peter, not Petros, "rock", but, Hebrew Petras, which means "interpreter" - a name of Hermes, but, also the Hierophant of the Eleusinian Mysteries. And early Church occult writers, like Dionysos the Areopagite, refers to the line of Popes as "our Hierophants", who teach the doctrine of the "Darkness above the Light", the Ain above the Shekinah.

Further, the Crucifixion and Resurrection borrow the motifs of the death and rebirth of Dionysos.

So, the New Testament is a mixture of true and false material.

As to the Evangelical fascination with eschatology. Biblical eschatology is the long-awaited tikkudam, the union of Christ and Anti-Christ. There is the explicit proclamation of 2 Peter 1:19 that Jesus is Lucifer. But, there is also Revelation, which is a Zoroastrian fantasy. YHWH the Messiah appears with his seven Elohim Revelation 4:5. These are the Seven angels of Revelation 1-3 and elsewhere. But YHWH the Shaitan appears as Leviathan, the Red Dragon, Revelation 12:3, etc. The seven and the ten are the seven worlds of the Elohim and the ten Sephiroth of the Kabbalah. Revelation 12:3, 13:1. This is the mystery religion of Babylon. Revelation 17:3-5. YHWH is three-fold: dragon, beast, prophet. Revelation 12-13. And at the end, Jesus declares himself to be Lucifer. Revelation 22:16.

Satan is threefold, Iudah, YHWH, the Ain. And the Bible as a whole is yet another of Satanic books of lies; it completely perverts Jesus' actual message as to how to get out of this world - this prison - and the cycle of birth and rebirth.

I am familiar with Manichaean doctrine, but, their analyses don't interest me. Why read some didactic application of Satanic lies when I can read the originals? :-)

Gnosticism and Manichaeism are both more of what I'm talking about here - I won't go into great detail. The important difference between Traditional Kabbalah, though, is this: Traditionally, Light and Dark are completely distinct, opposing principles. In Kabbalah, there is only Darkness, and good and evil - equated with light and dark - are but two sides of a single creative god - sides to be reconciled because they are not really opposed.

Lastly, you are right to avoid all "white supremacist extremism" - this "I'm angry, I'm frustrated, my people are dying" stuff. Our intelligence agencies, particularly the FBI, create this stuff because
