

Introduction by Jack Donovan

It was while Simon Sheppard was obliged to stay in a probation hostel following a lengthy prison sentence that my friend Trevor Blake put me in touch with him. Mr. Blake, a passionate advocate for free speech, had been writing Sheppard letters of support for several years. Whether you agree with all, some or none of what Sheppard has written, he has been punished by the state for publishing prohibited thoughts.

In the United States we take freedom of speech for granted. People who make politically incorrect statements in public are bound to face social and professional consequences, but they don't expect to go to prison. The people of England aren't so lucky. They have no such freedom.

No people can claim to be free when they fear imprisonment for merely expressing thoughts – however wrong, unpopular or inconvenient to their leaders.

In this short but punchy book, Sheppard's arguments are presented simply and concisely, supplemented with charts and quotations. He is nothing if not quotable. His 'procedural analysis' – a kind of a field guide to women – offers a novel list of theories about female strategies and a humorous selection of female stereotypes. These include the Scatterbrained Female, Liability Girl, Able Woman, and my personal favorite, Thug Woman. Further highlights are his list of female sexual signals, the Dynamical Laws, and his DSoD Theory. Nothing characterizes feminist apologists so much as the tendency to 'make large differences small and small differences larger.'

In the past decade there has been a growing interest in human biodiversity and using evolutionary psychology to make sense of the 'war between the sexes.' An online 'manosphere' has emerged. First published in 1998, *All About Women* was ahead of its time.

Foreword to the First Edition

Little did I think that my work would be first published like this. I was in Amsterdam, was just about to publish two novel medical scientific papers and had already done enough experiments to know that I was onto something big. When these papers appeared — the equivalent of two Ph.D's, independently undertaken — I thought that doors would open, opportunities would present themselves and my new system of Procedural Analysis, by which human behaviour can be completely understood, would be a Big Thing. I hadn't arrived at the notion of Big Sister yet.

This booklet is designed to present the maximum information in the minimum space, and some omissions will be inevitable. It is a collection of conclusions, not a documentary of how they were arrived upon. My findings, obtained by logical deduction, came as quite a surprise. If anyone is still under the illusion that males and females are the same except for a few superficial differences, as I once was, they should read *Brainsex* by Moir and Jessel. This is a good, informal summary of my university course on Sex Differences.

A common reaction to my attitude now is to think that I don't like women. This is not true at all, indeed I have loved several of the fairer sex to bits. But it is not sane to hold in high esteem someone – or some group – that is bleeding you dry. One does not respect the burglar who carries away your valuables, the invader who kills your family or the con man who swindles your inheritance. It is not a question of liking: the burglar might be a lovable rogue, the invader could be your brother in a civil war, the con man might be so skilled as to inspire admiration. Emotions don't come into it. The reality, I contend, is that we men – particularly Occidental males – are being taken to the cleaners. It is time for this to stop, for when it does it will be to the ultimate benefit of everyone, including our women.

Biology, Evolution and History

Most of history has not been written; it lies within us. Instincts have evolved just as organs to give us advantage in a competitive, often hostile environment. During early human history women were constantly either pregnant or breast-feeding (which inhibits conception). In the Upper Palaeolithic Period (40,000-10,000BC) the life-expectancy of males was 33.3 years and of females 28.7, with the major cause of female mortality being childbearing and attempts to induce abortions (e.g. putting a plank over a woman's stomach and jumping on it until blood spurted out of the vagina). Male mortality would have been mainly due to hunting accidents and fights over women. According to Darwin the Best Man tradition derives from him being an accomplice in the act of stealing a wife from a neighbouring village. Indeed this practice continues in some regions today.

Marvin Harris concluded that around 10,000BC the population of several cultures suddenly increased, having been relatively constant up till then, and there was a consequent sharp decline in health and living standards.

To obtain anything approaching an accurate perspective on human behaviour, and male-female interaction in particular, we have to be aware of humans' evolutionary history: in the biological jargon, our phylogeny. The bulk of our evolutionary conditioning took place during the two-million-year prehistoric period. It is here that we find the origins of behaviour and the reasons we are what we are.

Parasites and Symbionts

A parasite is a load on a host, giving nothing in return, while a symbiont co-exists with the host and is of some benefit to it. The distinction between a parasite and a symbiont can be fine however. Parasites are very common in nature and it is difficult to accept that such systems do not occur in man.

No arts, no letters, no society, and, which is worst of all, continual fear and danger of violent death, and the life of man solitary, poor, nasty, brutish, and short.

A model symbiont in biology is large fish, such as groupers, being cleaned by small cleaner fish which feed on fungus and parasites on the large fish. Cleaner fish inhabit sites (e.g. coral reef) which the large fish visit. Individual fish return to a site repeatedly to be cleaned, at which time the cleaner fish swim inside the gills and even inside the mouths of the large fish. In this exchange, the cleaner cooperates by cleaning and the large fish cooperates by not eating its cleaner. Surprisingly few cleaner fish end up in the stomach of the large fish. Repeated interactions are essential to this and other forms of cooperation.

Ants are very interesting for the study of social behaviour and more appropriate as examples than might be supposed. Man's intelligence has enabled him to install social structures like government and armies relatively quickly, but ants have been mechanistically perfecting these structures by evolutionary trial and error over a much longer period.

Richard Dawkins provides examples of how cunning parasites can be, and how easy it is to be fooled. The sophistication of some ant species make the cuckoo look like a novice. He describes a parasitic ant which invades a neighbouring colony, seeks out its queen, climbs on top of it and methodically gnaws off its head. Having usurped the top of this social hierarchy, the alien queen produces eggs which are tended by the invaded colonies' workers, and new queens then go off to invade other colonies.

Even this strategy has been improved upon by another ant species. To quote Dawkins in *The Selfish Gene*, p. 252:

lpha THE AGE OF THE EARTH, 4,500,000,000 YEARS lpha

INSECTS, 600,000,000 YEARS MONKEYS, 50,000,000 YEARS MAN (Homo habilis), 2,000,000 YEARS With savages, for instance, the Australians, the women are the constant cause of war both between members of the same tribe and between distinct tribes.

'But sawing off heads is a bit of a chore. Parasites are not accustomed to exerting themselves if they can coerce a stand-in. My favourite character in [Edward] Wilson's The Insect Societies is Monomorium santschii. This species, over evolutionary time, has lost its worker caste altogether. The host workers do everything for their parasites, even the most terrible task of all. At the behest of the invading parasite queen, they actually perform the deed of murdering their own mother. The usurper doesn't need to use her jaws. She uses mind-control. How she does it is a mystery; she probably employs a chemical, for ant nervous systems are generally highly attuned to them. If her weapon is indeed chemical, then it is as insidious a drug as any known to science. For think what it accomplishes. It floods the brain of the worker ant, grabs the reins of her muscles, woos her from deeply ingrained duties and turns her against her own mother. For ants, matricide is an act of special genetic madness and formidable indeed must be the drug that drives them to it. In the world of the extended phenotype, ask not how an animal's behaviour benefits its genes; ask instead whose genes it is benefiting.'

Male-Female Symbiosis

Probably the three dominant factors at the root of male-female interaction are the following, operating at the primal, the physical and the psychological level:

1. Primal. The abundance and ready availability of sperm versus the finite supply of eggs. This is the biological origin of the different amounts of parental investment required by males and females, particularly the child-bearing and nurturing role of the female. In biological terms, the female is gravid: egg-bearing. (Evolutionarily, post-menopausal females are practically null.)

Females oblige males to be dishonest in order to obtain sex.

- 2. Physical. The female is physically weaker than the male. To compensate for this handicap the female has evolved numerous mechanisms for manipulating males, and her mate in particular. Males must be unaware of these mechanisms for them to be fully effective. (An obvious long-term female strategy would be to deny reproductive facilities to males who are impervious to female manipulation.)
- **3.** Psychological. During sexual selection, telling the female anything she doesn't want to hear, regardless of how true it is, immediately mars a male's chances. Since the female is inherently more perceptive than the male, and likely to detect a conscious attempt to deceive her, the male, in order to improve his reproductive success, deceives himself. The most convincing liar is one who has deluded himself.

Several psychologists have investigated male pick-up lines and the consistently least successful is 'Come back with me and have sex right now.' That is, if the male is direct and honest, he does not generally succeed. (Males using such an approach statement outside of an experiment are likely to be doing so in an attempt to resolve excessive neurosis.) If a female approaches a male, what she says in the Approach Statement is irrelevant.

Actually females, if given free choice, prefer males who express female characteristics. This is because of the 'selfishness of the gene' – the gene promotes itself. Hence the female affinity for homosexuals: male homosexuals express female characteristics. (Then it is true that when males express female characteristics they often do so with masculine force.)

Mature males feign disinterest in a female in order to arouse her interest: the difficult part here is engineering a situation where the relationship may progress without obviously declaring a desire.

Sometimes males make no attempt to hide their intentions and occasionally succeed. A likely reason for this is that the female is

offered a relationship on such favourable terms that she cannot resist, because she is given all control of the relationship at the outset. Also, females try to keep all *Ambiguity of Intention* for themselves, so that their objective can be ambiguous while the male's is not.

Modern History

A hundred years ago the inferiority of women was obvious to all. Two hundred years before that scolding caps were used. Whole families slept in one bed, and with increased population density they were probably more riddled with parasites and disease than during prehistoric times. Beating women was regarded as a necessary last resort, civilisation being fragile enough as it was. Under the legal principle of coverture a husband was responsible for the expenditure and even criminal acts of his wife. Coverture was still in effect in Oklahoma in 1931.

In 1910 the Women's Social and Political Union, the militant suffragettes, declared itself to be at war with the British government. A few hundred middle and upper-class women, awash with money donated by wealthy 'society' women, embarked on a campaign of insurrection, malicious damage and arson. This included setting fire to churches, damaging works of art and planting bombs. On the outbreak of the First World War however the suffragettes suddenly became its most fervent supporters. (Teams of women in 'White Feather Brigades' distributed white feathers to any male not in uniform, even to boys and soldiers on leave.) Then ten months before the end of the war, perhaps as their reward, the government granted voting rights to women over 30.

The inexorable accumulation of power to beget more power had entered its final stage.

The ideal female employment is as an employment agent or health service bureaucrat. In the first she is passive, has power, authority and secures a lock-in on the workers in her charge. In the second she may have less power but there is a compensatory pretence of caring.

LORD CURZON REMAINS UNCONVINCED

EARL CURZON, after explaining that in taking part in the debate he was not speaking as spokesman of the Government or Leader of the House stated that, having listened to nearly every speech, he personally remained unconvinced that it was either fair, or desirable, or wise, in the manner proposed, to add six million voters to the electorate of the country. In the first place, this was a vast, incalculable, and almost catastrophic change, which, whatever might be their views about it, was without precedent in history and without justification in experience. Nothing could alter the undisputed fact that no great State in history had ever made so far-reaching a change; and he could not think he was acting foolishly in ranging himself by the side of France and Italy – he would not mention Germany in this connexion – and the other great countries on the Continent, while the example of Russia, which at one sweep had conceded universal suffrage, male and female, did not fill him with enthusiasm. The second point which affected him was that this change, the most serious in our constitutional development for at least a century, would be irrevocable. Once given, the franchise was a boon, a privilege, a right – whatever they liked to call it – which could never be taken back. It might be misused or even abused; but once given it could never be withdrawn. It might be that they would be doing more than crossing the Rubicon. They would be opening the floodgates to something much more than a tidal river – they would be opening them to a flood which they could not stop, which might presently overspread this country and submerge many landmarks. He had heard in this debate no sufficient answer to the plea that no mandate or authority had been given by the country for the grant of the vote to women.

He did not think anyone had disputed Lord Loreburn's contention that the selection of the age of 30 years as that at which women should be entitled to the franchise was both arbitrary and illogical. That arbitrary, artificial and illogical limit of age in the case of women could not possibly last. This was not only the thin end of the wedge; they would be taking the thin end of the wedge and hammering it half way in. The 6,000,000 women voters within 20 years or 15 or even 10 years would become 10,000,000 or very likely 12,000,000. On all these grounds he continued to regard this proposal with a mistrust and an apprehension which he would be dishonest were he to attempt to conceal.

What Do Women Want?

One of the most difficult questions is 'What do women really want?' The traditional riposte, that what women say they want and what they really want are two different things, is valid. In a more modern analysis in terms of strategies we would say that females obfuscate: they deliberately confuse in order to mask their strategies. This makes their manoeuvres difficult to recognise and discourages the development of counter-strategies. Women are like children who are desperately tired and irritable but will never admit to wanting to go to bed, because they want to stay downstairs and be 'grown up.'

Women want to the loved and adored, but they also want the freedom to behave in ways which makes them reviled, because this is another ploy by which sex can be avoided. Women want the right to do everything and the obligation to do nothing. They desperately want to be desired, but it does not follow that they want sex; mostly they only want to be reassured of a male's willingness to have sex with them.

At least 13% of women fantasise about forced sex, but a man giving one of these women what they really want risks a long stretch in prison. The study, by Glenn Wilson, involved 700 anonymous respondents to a questionnaire about their sexual fantasies. The usual female fantasy involved a husband or steady partner while the most common male fantasy involved multiple females. This confirms the general view that females are monogamous and males are polygamous (the male-female Game of

The Wife of Bath tells a tale of the times of King Arthur and his Round Table. A certain Knight who has forfeited his life was given a reprieve on condition that he could answer the question "What thing is it that women most desire?" and he was allowed a year and a day to find out.

As the story is told by the Wife of Bath it is not surprising to find the satisfactory answer the Knight provided was that women should have sovereignty and mastery over their husbands.

Opposites, which is a consistent theme). Several women shown these statistics remarked that the figure of 13% fantasizing about forced sex was probably low because many women are unable or unwilling to admit their true desires.

Deep down, women want to be able to respect men for controlling them.

THE RULES

1. THE FEMALE ALWAYS MAKES THE RULES.

- a. The rules are subject to change at any time without notice.
- b. No male can possibly know all the rules. All females are born with this knowledge.
- c. If the female suspects that the male knows any of the rules, she may immediately change any or all of the rules.

- b. Under no circumstances must the female let the male know whether she wants him to be angry or upset.

ANY ATTEMPT BY THE MALE TO CHANGE ANY OF THESE RULES COULD RESULT IN SEVERE PHYSICAL HARM.

Women are Inferior

Females are more sensitive and better at discerning taste and smell. They have greater tactile sensitivity from birth. Women are superior at child care, perceiving signals, reading emotional undercurrents and performing fine, detailed work. Here we are talking about rationality and civilisation.

- 1. The natural domain of the male is the thing. They can be excited and intrigued, even obsessed, about some thing. Males of certain races have evolved the ability to sublimate sexual drives into physical ones. The result is the discovery or invention of every modern amenity: electricity, computers, engines, cars, science and modern medicine, washing machines and the contraceptive pill, to name but a few. The ability of the male to process abstract concepts and objects is superior. Since the male is superior at manipulating things, the female imitates the male.
- 2. The natural domain of the female is relationships. Relationships are her primary sexual activity. Females are superior at understanding and manipulating them.

Here the female is like an expert and naturally gifted chess player playing a beginner. The female expert makes the male beginner work, letting him win occasionally to maintain his interest, but whenever she really wants to win she does. By watching his fumbling attempts she learns his strategies even before he has learnt them himself. This female strategy of manipulating the male into doing her work is inferior.

The manipulative skill of females has evolved to compensate for the greater physical strength and aggression of males. The reason females abhor violence so much is because this is a battleground on which they always lose. Since the female is adept at manipulating relationships, the male can imitate the female.

Ultimately the only thing that relationships produce is babies, which already exist in abundance.

Women are totally sexual creatures who will go to practically any lengths to avoid physical sex.

3. Females are hypocritical. Its likely origin is that females are empathic. They are sensitive to and aware of the needs of others, particularly the sexual needs of males, yet their optimal strategy relies on denying them sexual access most of the time.

Females are ambivalent, and thus neurotic. They (at least sometimes) desire sex, and it makes them feel more feminine, but their basic strategy is to raise the costs of sex and this involves avoiding physical sex, because scarcity raises its value. By signalling and other means females seek to load their neurosis onto males.

Females discourage others from pursuing policies they employ themselves (e.g. discouraging males from sexually discriminating but supporting each other). This is a form of *Malign Encouragement*, though its archetype is probably females encouraging competition among males while they conspire.

- 4. Females are selfish. The evolutionary origin is that they are thinking not only for themselves but for their child dependants (including eggs). A female may appear to be doing something with an altruistic motive but the reality, almost without exception, is that she is merely satisfying her own instincts. Males will sacrifice themselves for a greater cause, for example in war. Females are more subtle, take less risks and are less adventurous.
- **5.** Females enforce conformity. Females vary less than males. Exceptionally gifted individuals are almost always male.

Since females have been selecting males with female traits for generations, it is not surprising that many males now express feminine characteristics (e.g. monogamous males). Some exceptional males express female characteristics more strongly than do females themselves. This is the reason that while women are generally better at cooking, the best chefs are men.

Females have a deep desire for safety and moderation, which has its origin in her childbearing role. The practice of derogating anyone who sticks out from the crowd is known in Holland as *De*

Wet van Jantje (Little Johnnies' Law), in Denmark as the Jätteløven and in Sweden as the Jantelagen. If female influence is unchecked the result is a degenerating cycle of blandness, mediocrity and cultural stagnation.

- **6.** Females are immature. The evolutionary origin is that immature females interact more successfully with children and make better mothers. The origin of male maturity is that they compete.
- **7.** Females are illogical. They obfuscate; that is, as a protection mechanism to prevent identification of their strategies, and especially to avoid physical sex, they purposefully make themselves difficult to understand. This involves being irrational and dishonest.

Perception does not have to be accurate to be evolutionarily advantageous. Imagine a mutant rabbit, with a scientific bent of mind, hearing a rustle in the grass. It does an experiment, and hangs around to see whether the rustles are foxes or just puffs of wind. Before the end of the experiment the mutant rabbit has become a fox's dinner. It is evolutionarily advantageous for the rabbit to simply assume the presence of a fox, whether one is there or not. Similarly, women believe what they want to believe.

8. Females are unable to separate feelings from logic. The Corpus Callosum, which joins the two hemispheres of the brain, is wider in women than in men. Female instincts are regarded as safer, so there has been less need for females to inhibit them. Females' favourite occupation is sitting around, measuring, thinking and talking about their feelings. The female instinct is to be passive and to signal. Contrariwise, males must control their instinct to act or they are soon taken out of circulation, either by being killed by other members of the tribe or being imprisoned.

Projection – assuming that others act and perceive similarly – is probably the most important psychological mechanism.

The more latitude the female is allowed, the more her capricious nature will be expressed, the more she will project that nature onto the male and the more insecure of his intentions she will become.

- **9.** Females indulge in irrational fear. They have a thirst for accounts which reinforce that fear. Females project more than males.
- 10. Females conspire. They instinctively act together to raise the costs of sex and promote monogamy.

Many female procedures involve *Compound Benefit*, conferring benefit in multiple ways. The following scenario illustrates a subtle expression of the Conspiracy strategy.

A male makes a random, friendly comment to a female, which she interprets as an approach. Not only does her interpretation benefit her personally, by making her feel desired (enhancing her), but it also confers benefit to females generally. She is likely to have conveyed her interpretation to him in some way. Then he, learning that a pleasantry is likely to be interpreted as an approach in any case, thereafter limits his friendly comments to females he actually desires, weakening his hand. Thus Ambiguity of Intention is removed from males. Females seek to monopolize AoI.

Conspiracy is inherently inferior because competition allows the fittest to prevail.

11. Females know no limit. They do not check their own behaviour but rely on others to do it for them. Females make unreasonable demands to test and extend their power. They do not limit the excessive behaviour of other females but will exploit whatever gains their excesses achieve (another expression of the Conspiracy strategy). The answer to the question 'What will women do?' is 'Whatever they can get away with.' Women are never satisfied.

It is generally admitted that with woman the powers of intuition, of rapid perception, and perhaps of imitation, are more strongly marked than in man; some, at least, of these faculties are characteristic of the lower races, and therefore of a past and lower state of civilisation.

'Amongst the half-human progenitors of man, and amongst savages, there have been struggles between the males during many generations for the possession of females. But mere bodily strength would do little for victory, unless associated with courage, perseverance, and determined energy. With social animals, the young males have to pass through many a contest before they win a female, and the older males have to retain their females by renewed battles... To avoid enemies or to attack them with success, to capture wild animals, and to fashion weapons, requires the aid of higher mental faculties, namely observation, reason, invention, or imagination... Consequently... we would expect that they would tend to be transmitted chiefly to the male offspring... Thus man has ultimately become superior to woman. It is indeed fortunate that the law of equal transmission of characters to both sexes prevails with mammals; otherwise it is probable that man would have become as superior in mental endowment to woman, as the peacock is in ornamental plumage to the peahen...'

An incident... occurred in a troupe of chimpanzees observed by Jane Goodall. One day she saw a subordinate male pick up a pair of empty kerosene cans from near her camp and carry them up to the top of a hill; below a group of dominant males were eating some bananas that she had laid out as bait. The chimpanzee then proceeded to run down the hill towards the dominant males, banging the two cans together to create an awful din. Startled by the clamour, the dominant males rushed off for cover, deserting their bananas. The result of this episode was that the subordinate male not only got the bananas but was elevated to the rank of alpha-male with all its attendant sexual (and breeding) privileges. This illustrates the principle that intellectual prowess may supplant physical strength as a means to achieving dominance in the animal hierarchy, thus helping to account for the startling evolution of human brain power.

Some Female Characteristics and their Evolutionary Origin

Ambivalence Empathic/denial of males' evident sexual needs.

- 12. Females are insecure. During sexual selection females will rapidly switch their allegiance to whoever is prepared to devote the most energy into pandering their fragile egos. To use an old word, they tergiversate. Women are plastic they will adopt whatever mores and values authority figures dictate.
- 13. Females have no sense of humour. Women often define *Our Cosy Circle* (OCC) by deriding people they wish to exclude from it. They can discourage true humour because males use it to distribute information and alleviate neurosis, and it is in the female interest to maintain the male in as high a state of neurosis as possible. By disallowing humour on particular themes taboos can be instituted. Then the perception of a topic can be altered to further an agenda which would be rejected were it to be openly stated.

Dispersive Procedures serve to dissipate normal male reactions such as anger and surprise. When a female says 'No' to some trivial request in jest this is merely the precursor to a refusal being made in earnest.

- **14.** Women are unforgiving. Grievances are too useful to them as weapons to be discarded and forgotten.
- **15.** Females always reduce everything to the personal. Further, females are superficial, because this is consistent with ambivalence.
- 16. Females' strategy of creating problems and then blaming males is inferior. The most important expression of this is over-population; that is, women having babies. Human populations have increased roughly 50-fold in just five centuries, and over-population is the ultimate cause of most modern-day problems. The female who says that she would not like a baby is a liar, because she has become extinct, just as surely as one cannot have a eunuch for a father. Men, most of the time, would simply be happy with sex.

Intelligence may be used to solve problems and create wealth or merely to divest others of wealth by clever manipulation.

Women are Liars

It may be said that women blatantly lie as often as men. But women can distort, manipulate, pervert and twist the truth until it is nothing but a faint glimmer at the end of a very long and dark tunnel. Facets of the truth can be so exaggerated that the most trivial omission of fact is sufficient to obscure the real truth entirely – which is to lie.

Males routinely accept female dishonesty and understand it, even though they often fail to be frank with themselves about it. When a male makes a proposal to a female and a patently false excuse is given, such as 'I'm washing my hair tonight' or 'I'm busy all next week,' the male knows perfectly well that if the object of his attentions were really interested then her hair would be washed at another time, or a gap in her 'busy schedule' would be found. Sometimes the pretence is made that such excuses are given to save the face of the male, but this is another veneer: in fact the female is using subterfuge and evasion to impose her will and disregard his. A male may press the issue, and then a more plausible series of excuses might be given, but it will be a rare exception indeed that a male wins the battle for control against a female's superior verbal skills and her employment of sophistry and evasion.

Another form of female dishonesty is in their perception. This takes several forms but many women, and especially feminists, believe that practically all their ills can be attributed to males. Claims are made that every world problem is the product of males' insatiable desire to dominate and pollute the environment – to conquer 'Mother Nature.' But as already noted, perception does not have to be accurate and true to be advantageous.

False perception is a means by which males can be loaded with false guilt. Although science and its technological applications can create problems which are difficult in their novelty, science alone has the capacity to solve problems at their source. It does this by its search for real, objective truth. It cannot deny facts.

The Traditional Roles

The traditional roles were that the female gave the male the illusion of control while in fact largely retaining it; the male was breadwinner. Only since the 1940s have females been able to be materially independent from males. For two million years previously a woman would have sought a man to provide her with food and shelter – this is the origin of the dowry system. Her manoeuvres were veiled however; the male would be subtly drawn by the female into believing that he was doing the chasing, not the other way around. If her manipulative postures were overt the male might abandon and she would have lost a material supporter and a productive union.

Once a relationship was established, obvious manipulation or dishonesty by the female would be met with physical force or, at the extreme, ejection from the cave or village dwelling.

The reason that traditionally women were not supposed to like sex was that in the long run this resulted in them getting more. Her husband might express his rage sexually rather than violently, for example. This is just a simple application of evolution theory: the more sex takes place the more children there will be and so the gene for the characteristic proliferates.

Female dishonesty is advantageous when teaching language skills to children. Suppose that a woman is teaching a child to read. If she were completely honest, and pointed out every faltering error, the child would rapidly become discouraged and give up entirely. She must encourage the child, only picking up only the most serious and consistent errors for the child to progress.

'Truth, reality and objectivity are all in trouble from our point of view; we see a male-created truth, a male point of view, a male-defined objectivity' (Ruth Bleier).

'The postulate of value-free research, of neutrality and indifference towards the research objects, has to be replaced by conscious partiality' (Renate Klein).

'Feminism withdraws from the patriarchal construction of reality' (Blanche Dubois).

Giving women a voice and allowing them to express their opinions on contemporary social problems is rather like asking the Devil for advice on how to cure sin.

Further examples of female dishonesty include the redefinition of words, or something which is plainly bad may be claimed, using specious arguments, to be good (e.g. miscegenation). Feminists can even deny that objective truth exists at all (see box). Another important stratagem is 'The Old Reverse.'

'The Old Reverse'

Suppose an island exists somewhere in a remote sea. Its land is almost barren; there are no significant mineral deposits, in fact there is virtually no reason for a cargo ship or airplane to go there except to visit the few hardy souls who eke out a precarious existence away from the bustle of mass civilisation. Then 'The Old Reverse' is employed when it is claimed that the island's economic poverty is due to the absence of trade visits, and if only these were increased the island would prosper. The truth, in this example, is that there is no trade traffic because there is nothing to trade. In short, 'The Old Reverse' takes place when cause and effect are exchanged; the effect is blamed as the cause.

This example is highly relevant to the claim of feminists, because this is really just an example of The Old Reverse. Feminists allege that the paucity of female inventors, notable scientists, outstanding artists and musicians, and females' mediocre showing in practically every other sphere is due to their being cruelly subjugated by men. Here is a confusion of cause and effect. Firstly women have allowed themselves to be subjugated and secondly they have been because they are mediocre and if they are not then mediocrity will dominate, which is precisely what is happening in contemporary society.

Finally, females are dishonest about their inferiority.

Out of the corruption of women proceeds the corruption of races; out of the corruption of races, the loss of memory; out of the loss of memory, the loss of understanding, and out of this all evil.

Female Stereotypes

Science, categorization and achieving precision with numbers are male activities; females prefer vagueness and ambiguity. The following classification is speculative, and cannot be claimed to be rigorous, but since females vary less than males they should be easier to classify.

Able Woman possesses male abilities. She is the most dangerous female type of all due to her tendency to be oversensitive, unsuited to certain tasks or just plain wrong. Typical habitats include police stations, local councils, the media and universities, where she learns ever more clever ways of putting down men. Able Woman has also been known to inhabit Downing Street.

The anthropologist Margaret Mead is a good example of Able Woman. She wrote a number of popular and widely quoted books in which she maintained that native peoples led promiscuous but happy lives. Subsequently however all her central conclusions have been found to be wrong.

Bad Girls usually travel in pairs, flitting from place to place, misbehaving at every available opportunity and playing the game for all it is worth. They seek to induce neurosis in any male who is close by or makes an approach; the approach is likely to have been encouraged for this purpose. Bad Girls can avoid normal relations with males because it would limit their ability to play this role. They can often be seen in city centres of an evening but girls as young as eight have been observed playing this role.

Base and Spoiled Female is the mould from which all females are cast. A BSF is a female who is unrestrictedly allowed to act upon her emotions (BSM's go to prison). BSF will go through a male's private belongings and papers to gather information about him if the opportunity arises. She will answer the door or telephone only when she feels like it: 'I don't make appointments, I just go along as I feel' and 'Feelings are never wrong' are typical BSF comments. She is uncompromisingly selfish and gives the

appearance of having no perception of male sensitivities and needs. All females will exhibit BSF characteristics if given licence.

The classic *Bimbo* is stupid, absolutely gorgeous and follows a male around like a dog. She is attracted to Jerk (males who have an exaggerated opinion of themselves), and especially Jerks with money. There are a number of variants of Bimbo – a small number are intelligent, a larger number are unattractive. Most females secretly want to be Bimbos but the current fashion is for them to try and emulate Able Woman.

Defective Female is a relatively rare female type who provides a valuable counter-example to the more usual female types. She seems to have three particular characteristics: she is no more capable than males at manipulating relationships; unlike normal females, she is interested in things; attempts by her to lie go wrong. She gets on well with males and can arouse jealousy in other females because of her success at maintaining non-sexual relationships with them. DF is 'one of the lads.'

The Lady is one of the most important female classifications because possibly 95% of females conform to this role most of the time. Ladies would formerly drop a handkerchief to attract a passing Gentleman. The modern Lady begins a relationship by signalling a male and will dominate him thereafter if she can get away with it. No sex takes place before the relationship is settled to her satisfaction. The Lady doesn't often go out; she sits at home and waits for males to come to her.

Two kinds of *Liability Girl* exist: one is proposed as a biological type, the other as a role. The type may have a boyfriend who is HIV positive and have sex without a condom. A female playing this role must not only be financially supported, kept warm and fed, but also continuously amused and entertained.

The *Personality Girl* has a strong, bright and attractive personality. Possibly more so than any other type, the will and confidence of Personality Girl exceeds her ability.

The status of Base and Spoiled Female is not proportional to the status of the male she can attract, as with females normally, but the status of the male she can reject. Any involvement by a male with BSF will be to his detriment; for it to be otherwise will require inordinate skill and dexterity. The *Scatterbrain* (or Scatty, or Disordered) *Female* is a biological type of special interest. SF's in the past were completely dependent on males but modern amenities and male technology enable SF to be relatively independent. SF's strategy is to exploit the strong protective and caretaking instincts of the male. Some SF characteristics are leaving clocks set wrongly, compulsively moving things around and being unable to throw things away. Like another female type, Unstable Female, she may be found in a house in which every room is being decorated simultaneously.

Thug Woman displays an exaggerated form of the aggressive male ego. The only justification for her behaviour is 'I don't like you.' Actual physical violence is rare but there is a sense that if she were to become violent, unlike most males, she would not know when to stop. Thug Women sometimes congregate at militant feminist and lesbian meetings.

Unstable Female is generally Bad News.

Procedures and Games: The New Theories

This study originated in Holland (a sample Super Feminine State) but its findings are generally applicable. The Dutch were especially interesting because their behaviour was often unrestrained, without the traditional British reserve, making analysis easier.

Many breakthroughs occur when knowledge from different disciplines is combined and Procedural Analysis has been developed from a combination of sex differences and evolutionary biology. A giant in evolution theory was Prof. John Maynard Smith, with his concept of the evolutionarily stable strategy (ESS).

A trait is evolutionarily viable if it is both advantageous (has a reason to exist) and heritable (has a means to exist). In Smith's model everything can be analysed in terms of costs and benefits, according to whether it is good or bad for the furtherance of the gene. Any organism seeks to minimize its cost and maximize its benefit: humans do this all the time. The ultimate benefit, and the only score that really matters in evolutionary terms, is the number of progeny (offspring) which result.

Here a *procedure* is a sequence of moves in a human game. Moves are made using *signals*, *markers*, *tokens* and *handles*.

1. The Costs and Benefits of Sex

In this analysis sex is any activity which is not business i.e., any non-monetary transaction is sexual activity – it involves a relationship. An important cornerstone is that females increase the costs of sex while males seek to reduce them. Ten costs and benefits of sex are defined. It is claimed that this breakdown can be applied to all human interactions.

Since the female is in many ways at a disadvantage, particularly in terms of physical strength, complex and subtle behaviours have evolved to preserve her well-being. She seeks to reduce her costs or, in other words, minimize the degree to which she is expected to reciprocate. For the female this involves raising the perceived value of sex while avoiding engaging in physical sex.

Ultimately, the only thing the female can provide which the male cannot is sex. Hence her basic strategy is to raise its value. If the female instinct is not to avoid physical sex altogether, it is at least to make the task of the male as difficult as possible, by any and every means available to her. (An exception to this rule is when the female already has what she wants, which is a long-term monogamous relationship. Then, if she has power, she will raise the costs of sex and facilitate the same for other females.)

The Table lists the ten costs and benefits of sex; it is proposed that every possible circumstance is contained within them. Moreover every one of these costs can be incurred, in full, even if physical sex does not take place.

To illustrate this scheme, imagine that a male is out one night and is signalled by a female. He approaches her and is then beaten up by her boyfriend. The fight qualifies as an unwanted relationship involving unwanted disorders (bruises and possibly a black eye) as well as *Diminishment of Self* (e.g. feeling bad about oneself). Energy and time would be lost as well as information (that he is not such a good fighter). The time spent in recovery might also result in the disturbance of existing sexual and business activities.

In another scenario, suppose that a tipsy employee has made a

pass at his boss's wife at a Christmas party. If the wife told her husband shortly afterwards it might be laughed off amid the joviality of the season, but if instead the information is withheld until the employee is being considered for promotion some months later, and the woman then divulges an embellished version of the incident, the employee may not be promoted but dismissed. This situation illustrates how the cost of sex can be increased by the control of information. Immature females tend to divulge information immediately while older ones learn to reserve it for maximum effect and advantage.

There should be no situation in which the acquisition of a disorder is considered a benefit, however it is possible to desire it. In love (which is treated as *Paragonism*) a partner may wish to share everything, even including a disease.

2. Signals, Markers, Tokens and Handles

The costs of sex for females are huge compared to its cost for males: he can simply walk away afterwards. Hence the female has evolved methods to provide her with early control of sex. Signals are used to test the male at the onset of a relationship to ensure his suitability as a mate, or equivalently, his susceptibility to manipulation by the female. She wants to know whether the male will care and provide for both her and their child after it is born, a considerable time after intercourse has taken place.

Very often the nature of a dysfunction provides us with an understanding of the normal process; when things go wrong it reveals how it works when things go right. Three situations in which the signal-response sequence goes wrong are given.

First, a male responds to a conscious female signal and approaches, then the female badly feigns surprise that he has done so. Second, the male might approach and then allude to the signal in the approach statement, and the female rather too strenuously denies it ('You looked as if something was troubling you'; 'No I wasn't'), or she similarly denies issuing an obviously deliberate signal. Third, in subsequent exchanges the female might try to ascertain how much of the signal the male consciously perceived, and the male recognises the interrogation as such.

By such means males can learn of the female propensity to signal, although many males are apparently unaware that when they

approach a female they almost invariably do so because a signal of some kind has been emitted. At whatever level, the male already knows that the approach he is making is not an unwelcome one.

Signals have been further categorized as Honest, Erroneous, False and Dysfunctional. The basic False Signal is leaving a light on when no-one is at home.

The Example of the Accident Signal

A typical female sexual signal is the Accident Signal and this is quoted as another illustration of evolution theory. Consider a woman serving tea to a group of workmen. The men, perhaps 20 or 30 of them, stand in a queue and file past the woman pouring tea into the workmen's mugs. One of the men she likes, and as she tilts the teapot to pour his tea she involuntarily spills it onto his hand: she has reflexively emitted the Accident Signal. The man is scalded, the woman fusses and frets apologetically and he reassures her that she should not worry; his caretaking instinct is inspired. As a result of this encounter they talk further, strike up a relationship, have sex and produce children. The gene which confers the propensity to signal in the female and, for the male, his propensity to respond to this particular signal in this particular way is carried to the next generation, and thus the signal-response couplet repeats. This signalling pattern is one reason that females (or even males expressing the characteristic) should not pilot an airplane; if they were to signal at a critical moment many lives could be lost.

Pieces in the Game

It is proposed that all human transactions can be analysed in terms of signals, markers, tokens and handles (see Table). Males and females have different preferences for these components: in fact they are completely the opposite of each other.

Females prefer signals and tokens, because they are ambiguous and thus manipulative, while males prefer markers and handles because they are not. There is a female tendency to weaken markers by distributing them further (e.g. signalling to widen a conversation, sharing), while the male strategy is to increase the significance of markers because they are generally material and often involve the wealth that he creates.

DEFINITIONS AND EXAMPLES

SIGNALS, MARKERS, TOKENS AND HANDLES

Signal. Ambiguous; a signal is a gesture, especially one of a sexual nature. Examples: Accident Signals, the Open Legs Signal, the Wide Eye Signal, normally functioning to attract a mate: 'The female signals, the male responds.' Signalling is the female strategy; it is passive, safe and ambiguous. The female manipulates the male into making an approach and can always deny her intent. Signals induce neurosis in males. If signals were not ambiguous they would not have multiple interpretations and so would not induce neurosis and confusion. (Neurosis is here defined after Pavlov as the condition which arises when one stimulus evokes two or more responses.)

Marker. Unambiguous; a marker is an unambiguous indication of involvement. Examples: Talking to someone, buying someone a drink. Electricity, telephones, cars and other items of utility are markers discovered, invented or created by males. A female marks a male by choosing or mending his clothes. Primordial marking is leaving scent. Other forms of territorial marking are decorating a flat to a preferred colour scheme or leaving something at a table intending to return.

Token. Ambiguous; a token is when one thing means another. Examples: 'Do you have a light?' or 'Come back and have some coffee.' Hints are commonplace examples of the token. A token has different values for the giver and the receiver. The cost of a cup of coffee in a café is a token because the cost of the drink includes the rent of the premises, wages etc., and this is usually understood by both parties.

Handle. Unambiguous; a handle is a request which generates a fixed and predetermined response. Examples: Calling someone's name, having an arrangement to meet. A handle state is a state in which handles are issued, such as knowing someone's name, being able to touch or hold someone, or being married.

To women, the world is just a full-length mirror.

Markers can be *appetent* or *inappetent* – an appetent marker is one for which something is desired or expected in return. Holding a conversation with no ulterior motive is inappetent marking while typical female appetent marking is holding a conversation with someone in order to demonstrate to others that a relationship exists. Females can reject inappetent markers from males because of fears (projecting their own tendency to play Tit For Tat) that something will be expected in return.

A signal or marker is called *indiscriminate* if it is not directed at a particular person. One form of indiscriminate signalling is dressing provocatively.

Markers may also be *transformed*: a female believing that she is doing a male a favour by accepting a drink from him is an example of this. Then there is the mutation of a handle to a marker, e.g. not giving a response to a proposal but interpreting it merely as a statement of interest. Ignoring a greeting is mutating a handle to a signal.

The putative origin of these manipulations of markers and handles is females avoiding obligations to provide physical sex.

3. The Dynamical Laws

The essential dynamic of male-female interaction is summarised by the Dynamical Laws:

- a. The only power that females have is given to them by males;
- b. The only thing that females do with that power is use it against males.

The proof of these statements is the inability to find a counterexample. The closest there has been to a successful counterexample so far, of a woman committing suicide, will illustrate.

How is her power to kill herself obtained from males? A person's ability to use will to over-ride their naturally strong self-preservation instinct involves logic and reason, which are male

Neurotic Transfer: The neurotic male further empowers the female, and thus a reinforcing cycle is established.

With many closely-allied species, following nearly the same habits of life, the males have come to differ from each other chiefly through the action of sexual selection, whilst the females have come to differ chiefly from partaking more or less of the characters thus acquired by the males.

traits. According to Darwin, what capacity females possess to defy their natural instincts is derived from males.

If she jumps off a cliff, all that is involved is will; there is nothing more to add. If she uses a tool, e.g. a gun, this is a thing, which belongs in the male domain. The natural domain of the female is relationships, the natural domain of the male is the thing. Every thing, almost without exception, has been discovered, invented or developed by males.

Suppose a) The female is young, reproductive and attractive; then her power is derived from males; she is perceived by them as desirable: male desire establishes her status; or b) She is old and ugly; then her status is low; in evolutionary terms, she is practically worthless (some primitive tribes ate their old women during times of hardship before they ate their dogs).

In case a), by killing herself she is depriving males of her function. In case b) she has little or no utility to males in any case. If the female who is killing herself is pregnant, this also has been facilitated by a male, by sex. Then she further deprives the male of his progeny.

4. The DSoD Theory

It is proposed that males and females see amounts of difference differently, according to four separate mechanisms, each with evolutionary origins. DSoD (pronounced 'dee-sod') is short for the Dishonest Submergence of Difference, or the practice of females to maintain that large differences are small. Compare, for example, females' insistence that the races and sexes are equal with their meticulous examination of goods while shopping.

In their late years of life males become more feminine and females become more masculine as hormonal influence fades.

The academic imperialism of some social scientists prevented much serious work being done on the lines Darwin's discoveries had suggested: that minds and mental attitudes evolved like bodies, and that behaviour could be studied like other organic properties, by means of comparative genealogies and evolutionary analysis.

Paul Johnson, A History of the Modern World, p. 732

The theory is summarised as follows:

- a. Males make large differences larger and small differences smaller;
- b. Females make large differences smaller and small differences larger.

These processes are similar to expansion and compression as applied to audio signals. Further, States may exist in a state of Super Masculinity or Super Femininity, and—

- a. The Super Masculine State dominates;
- b. The Super Feminine State becomes extinct.

A good practical application of the DSoD theory is war, because it is such an important human activity. Millions may die and history may change course entirely. Any State in a state of war becomes Super Masculine because if it does not, it loses the battle. War is, of course, a masculine activity but nonetheless a war may be fought for feminine objectives (females make small differences larger). The choice of enemy is of paramount importance.

Here F. J. P. Veale's notion of the *primary* and *secondary war* is interesting for comparison: secondary wars take place between combatants who are at a similar level of civilisation.

A woman badly treated by her husband has been known to hang or drown herself in revenge, thereby not only putting the man in jeopardy of evil spirits, but also requiring him to pay her family a substantial compensation.

The Payoff Array

The Protagonist is the main player, who starts the game. In the first array below the payoffs are shown for the Protagonist:—

Real-life games are often asymmetric: cooperation and defection take different forms for each player, as may the payoffs. More accurate is the following array, which shows the payoffs for each player:—

The highest payoff (Temptation) is received by a player who defects while the other is cooperating. The lowest payoff goes to the sucker who cooperates while the other defects. (In the celebrated Prisoner's Dilemma, a symmetric game, T > R > P > S.)

Females play the Tit For Tat strategy, a strategy which is good at eliciting cooperation. Formally, TFT is 'Cooperate on the first move, thereafter do as the opponent last did.' TFT is imitative, it copies the other player and any attempt to improve upon it.

In *Disguised Defection* the female disguises her defection and collects the Temptation payoff repeatedly.

In *Marginal Defection* the female acquires power surreptitiously, continually testing the male, seeking to establish a new base from which her power can be further incremented. The female optimally proceeds just below the threshold at which the male is provoked. If she miscalculates in her power-seeking manoeuvres she may provoke a violent reaction and other serious consequences.

The Male-Female Game. Defection

Behaviour is modelled as a game, but it is possible to describe the essentials without mathematics. For a fuller discussion of games see the books by Axelrod or Poundstone; the former is easier to find but Poundstone's is more wide-ranging.

- 1. Suppose that two players, a Protagonist and an Opponent, transact. The transaction may be social, in which case the benefits (payoffs) may be difficult to measure, or they may be monetary, in which case numbers are already available: the winner is the player with the highest payoff at game-end. In the evolutionary game the only important payoff is the number of progeny. For male-female games the female can usually be cast as Protagonist (the main player, who starts the game) because most games are instigated by females, although the male is often unaware of it.
- 2. Both players cooperate, then each gets a Reward payoff. An example of this is a distributor selling to a retailer: each profits from the transaction, motivating them to continue the game.
- 3. One player cheats: he defects. In the case of a distributor selling to a retailer, the retailer doesn't pay his monthly invoice. If the other player is attempting to cooperate, the defector gets the highest payoff of all, the Temptation payoff. For the retailer this is being able to sell the goods and pocket everything. However a defector will normally collect the Temptation payoff only once: only a fool will continue to cooperate when the other side is cheating. The important point is that cooperative behaviour (sometimes known as reciprocal altruism) only evolves when there are to be repeated transactions. Then the cumulative Reward payoffs are worth more than a single, large Temptation payoff.

If there is ever any trouble, look at the women and the source of it will not be far away.

Serial monogamy is promoted by females because it is a highly advantageous female policy. Most relationships are terminated by females. The female becomes more adept at manipulation as her skills are applied each time in a different context.

FEMALE POLICIES INVOLVING PERCEPTION-DISTORTION

- Increase the population, reducing the probability of a further encounter and disrupting male territorial instincts.
- Employ wide variations in dress and style, disrupting male targeting mechanisms and his ability to recognise the protagonist.
- 3. Erode the discrimination of the opponent, reducing his ability to identify the protagonist's strategies or her defection.
- 4. Impose taboos and emotionalise language. Once a topic cannot be openly and rationally discussed the perception of it can be altered to satisfy hidden goals.
- 5. Stigmatise the opponent (transduction).
- 6. Exploit humans' capacity for

- selective perception, such as turning off attention when an embarrassing event occurs, or being unable to fully comprehend an event because it is inconsistent with established stereotypes.
- 7. Foster irrational and antiscientific perception (belief in a strology, UFO's, the supernatural etc.).
- 8. Reduce an opponent's prospects in subsequent encounters by attributing less significance to the material interactions (markers and handles) which have already taken place.
- Promote a false expectation of a payoff in the future (e.g. a female maintaining a circle of hopeful suitors while she selects a single best match).

Man has diverged into distinct races, or as they may be more fitly called, sub-species. Some of these, such as the Negro and the European, are so distinct that, if specimens had been brought to a naturalist without any further information, they would undoubtedly have been considered as good and true species.

Darwin, The Descent of Man, p. 929

In Disguised Defection the female imitates the male, adopting roles and exploiting technologies which males have defined and developed once they become sufficiently facile, in order to disguise her defection from her natural functions.

Forms of Defection

In the male-female game, interactions between the players are inevitable and subtle behaviour is employed by the female to maximize her payoff. Normally if a player cheats they only collect the Temptation payoff once. However if the female were to erode the discrimination of her Opponent and bring him to a state of such confusion that he is no longer able to recognise defection when it occurs, she can then collect the Temptation payoff repeatedly. This is *Disguised Defection* and by this she is able to obtain the greatest achievable payoff from the game.

In *Marginal Defection* the female defects in small increments, but progressively, taking advantage of male's tendency to give females 'the benefit of the doubt.'

Discrimination

Discrimination is an essential human function. To discriminate is 'to see the difference.' Clearly someone who cannot see the difference between a £5 and a £10 note, or a small opponent and a large one, is at a disadvantage. If one kind (race, species, genotype) is exploiting another it is to their advantage to erode their opponent's discrimination – to discourage discrimination on the basis of kind. This is the *Malign Encouragement* strategy: encouraging an opponent to pursue an adverse policy. Collectively employed it is 'What's bad for them is good for us.'

Malign Encouragement is a female strategy but it would be dishonest to fail to mention two groups who excel at it: Soviets and Jews, especially in the latter's influence in the mass media. Many of the "Holocaust photographs" in our libraries today are forgeries, the product of a Cold War propaganda campaign ordered by Stalin (see the book by Walendy). During World War Two, Johnson relates, Stalin added Axis and Allied losses in the same column.

Important Procedures. Implications

ADVANCED DISCLOSURE = DEBASEMENT. An illustration of the microevolutionary theme which emerged during the development of the Procedural Analysis system is provided by the advancement of *Disclosure* to *Debasement*. It was almost as if evolution was taking place visibly, like watching a plant grow at accelerated speed. Disclosure takes place when a female divulges secrets (e.g. about former relationships) immediately after sex. This can serve to reinforce bonding. Disclosure is advanced to become Debasement, testing a male's loyalty before physical sex takes place. Then it seems that as sex becomes increasingly imaginary, Debasement becomes progressively so too. It is noteworthy that in each case of Debasement it is not only the confessor who is being debased. This is proposed as a more consistent model for the False Memory Syndrome and, in this system, it is a female behaviour.

TRANSDUCTION. An important discovery was the mechanism of inducing a false feeling. Classic examples of transduction are quitting a place because a certain person has arrived or an unpalatable fact has been stated. Females can even give the appearance of having a duty to transduce, but transduction is most powerfully applied when inducing false guilt. These are procedures which can be classed as emotional manipulation. In *Creative Transduction* a problem may be invented for the purpose.

THE MINDFUCK, OR PSYCHIC ASSAULT. In reality females obtain pleasure from inflicting pain on males, although the pain is usually psychic in nature. A common example is the satisfaction females obtain from signalling and the neurosis it induces in males.

The raw expression of this is Afghan and Red Indian women who were presented with male captives for torture until death. The women enjoyed their task and were better at it than the men. That women derive pleasure from signalling explains why the less likely the male is to respond, the more likely the female is to signal.

It is in many ways as if the female does not want the male to act, she only desires reassurance of his willingness to do so. Certainly imaginary sex is much safer for the female than physical sex (especially with a forbidden partner; a further proposal is that females are capable of *reidentifying*, or replacing the identity of an actual sexual partner with another, imaginary one).

The purpose of the Psychic Assault, or Mindfuck, is to confound the male, rendering him susceptible to manipulation and control. A distinction is further made between the *First Level Mindfuck* (FLM) and the *Second Level Mindfuck* (SLM). The FLM has a role in inspiring sublimation in males but the SLM, involving males of other races, has no redeeming features whatsoever. In the SLM the female delivers the supreme insult to the males of her race; it is the sexual-political equivalent of the nuclear bomb. Everything the female is for, biologically, is given away. Women are not naive in

THE MINDFUCK, OR PSYCHIC ASSAULT, FORMALLY DEFINED

- 1. The Psychic Assault is a political manoeuvre. The female manipulates the male into a position where she could have sex but refrains from doing so.
- 2. She maintains and perpetuates the male in a state of arousal or false expectation.
- 3. She scores points to satisfy and bolster her ego.
- 4. She evokes images of granting sexual favours to another (the more perverse her selection, for this purpose, the better) but grants them to the male or males in her audience either rarely or never.
- 5. She quits from a male suddenly or prematurely, because she prefers to Assault rather than engage in a proper relationship.
- 6. She grants and withdraws sexual favours to a male with whom she is involved in a relationship without logic or reason.

this regard; concerning sexual selection females are not naive at all.

When subjected to the Psychic Assault the male can become trapped in a cycle from which he cannot escape (e.g. compulsive attendance at lap-dancing clubs). The modern phenomenon of spree killers may be the acute male reaction to such insults.

Ten reasons have been identified why females prefer males of alien races. None are laudable. The only one which has a valid origin, of incorporating novel genes to prevent excessive inbreeding, is now an anachronism. The instinct belongs to an age when a 'stranger' came from a nearby village or town and not, as now, from another continent. The result is genetic degeneration and ultimately, extinction of the race. The race that cannot control its females becomes extinct (cf. the DSoD Theory).

NEGRO FOLLOWING. An intriguing behaviour, because its origin remains a mystery, is *Negro Following*. One or a group of Occidental females will follow a short distance behind a Negro or other immigrant male, their attention intensely fixed upon him. During World War Two British women and girls flocked against the fences of military camps to watch Negro Gl's (see the books by Costello and Smith). This phenomenon suggests that the Ten Reasons are incomplete and its explanation may help answer another riddle, why some females are more willing to subjugate themselves to immigrant males than their own. This last however could involve Vicarious Generosity.

EBIAR and **EBIAC**. EBIAR is *Exaggerated Behaviour in Alien Role*. It can be observed in over-eager policewomen, swaggering female security guards and super-soppy males pushing prams. People who have recently stopped smoking can become dogmatic in their opposition and recent converts to religion or politics are often exceptionally fervent.

Similarly, EBIAC is *Exaggerated Behaviour in Alien Culture*. Examples of this are Muslim women going on shoplifting sprees in London and Western women dressing provocatively in Muslim countries.

INDIRECT INVOCATION. This occurs when the authority of a third party is invoked without referring to the second. Examples are complaining about the non-repayment of a loan without confronting

the debtor directly or calling the police without asking someone to leave. It is a female strategy to avoid confrontation, exploit male protective instincts and raise the cost of involvement with them.

DIVULGENCE AND REFERRAL (D&R). Females routinely information and refer, often to older females.

PROFITABLE DISRUPTION. Creating a problem for advantage. This strategy is very popular among contemporary politicians. Its putative archetype is a female disturbing an ongoing romance in order to test a male's suitability as a long-term provider.

Ultimately females OVER-POPULATION. their use power reproduction against males by over-populating (cf. the Dynamical Laws). Environmental problems would be insignificant, few species would be in danger of extinction, and there would be a much higher quality of life if world population was a fraction of its present level. Males are territorial and the less space they can command the more their instincts are constrained. It is in the female interest to increase the population and population level, or population density, is proposed as an objective measure of female influence.

That non-Occidental males innately express female characteristics was termed the *Double Reinforcement of Female Characteristics* (DRoFC). In the modern world of the mass media the group that is most capable of processing real, objective truth is very much in a minority.

Applying the foregoing analysis it is apparent that exploiting male protective instincts, and relying on false or highly exaggerated claims of persecution, are merely policies serving to advance in the game. Exploiting emotions is just another strategy. Once an advantageous position is achieved, groups expressing female characteristics are capable of persecuting their opponents far more than males ever would: recall that females know no limit. Presumptions to the contrary are simply a projection of their own tendencies.

Females conspire and males compete. The defining theme of totalitarianism is that it seeks to eradicate competition. An environment in which competition is impossible is alien to males; think of sport, and running a race with only one competitor. Although government is a masculine construct, totalitarianism is a female strategy. It is not Big Brother we should fear but Big Sister.

Control of Information

Journalists like to think of themselves as 'guardians of democracy.' Much information, even if known to be perfectly true, is suppressed, either because they want to 'protect the impressionable' or they 'don't want to encourage the extreme right.' But whether something is extreme depends on where you're standing.

An immense majority of the people are so feminine in nature and point of view, that their thoughts and actions are governed more by feeling and sentiment than by reasoned consideration.

- I shall unreservedly exploit the achievements of males in furtherance of my goals. I shall enlist the vulnerable and those who cannot speak for themselves for my own purposes.
- 2. I shall control information, distort truth and manipulate thought. Freedom of speech will not exist.
- 3. I shall call for tolerance while allowing only those opinions and activities which are to my advantage. I shall promise one thing and do another.
- 4. I shall decree that males and females and people of different races are the same, when it is manifestly untrue. I shall oblige males to perform roles for which I am naturally better-suited.
- 5. I shall maintain males in a state of neurosis and confusion, and any male who disagrees with me, or induces any unpleasant feeling, shall be deprived of all amenities I have the power to withhold.
- 6. I shall indulge my instincts to manipulate, mindfuck, play tricks and be dishonest without fear of retribution.
- 7. I shall treat animals better than men.
- 8. I shall encourage massive immigration so that others shall be the underclass and not me. I will favour immigrants and half-castes to spite and insult males of my own race.
- I shall have the right to do everything and the obligation to do nothing. I shall have babies whenever and by whom I please.
- Any male following his instincts to the same extent will be imprisoned.

'EMOTIONAL FASCISM': 'My emotions are always correct and are sacrosanct. Your feelings don't matter. You're only a man.'

Control of information by the mass media is like giving a child the option of having their room decorated any combination of green, blue and yellow. Endless discussions could take place about the choice of shades but it can be guaranteed under these terms that the child will never have a red bedroom. Because of omission, and making certain subjects taboo, the situation is engineered where the real, underlying problems of society cannot be addressed at all.

Television has a power which is unprecedented in human history – try to think of an evolutionary archetype! Watching a TV drama is most similar to watching those scenes in reality, only a few yards away. Unrealistic images are constantly transmitted promoting ideals which, however fervently some people may cherish them, are unattainable, impractical and dishonest. The 'reality' being portrayed by television is in fact highly abnormal.

False stereotypes (artificial media role models, AMRM's) are often promoted. A single Negro child in an otherwise all-white school is placed front-of-camera; the successful businesswoman is hailed as the harbinger of a New Dawn.

The women of some Red Indian tribes had a special language of their own. They could understand the men's language but the men could not understand the women's. This is what women in the media are doing: they are transmitting subtle messages to other women which men simply do not perceive.

If the primary sexual activity of females is relationships, this makes soap operas the female equivalent of pornography. Women discuss soap opera episodes as if they were real events.

For the surprising facts about the enormous Jewish influence in the media look up *The Mind Benders* and *Who Rules America?* Also note that the Jews lost their 'worker caste' around a thousand years ago (Shahak, pp. 52-53). Today, while Jews make up a small

proportion of the population, they dominate both American and British government policy. Here we are talking not about females particularly but about female strategies (such as Malign Encouragement and Creative Transduction). Insecurity results in every criticism being perceived as a threat; the critic will be treated as an enemy. Every influential position will be filled by 'one of us.'

Female influence is pervasive. As females promote an environment in which they are free to follow their instincts, it becomes progressively harder for males to inhibit theirs. Other males, seeing that in the absence of restraint female strategies are successful, start employing female strategies themselves.

A distinctive indicator of female influence, also deriving from insecurity, is lack of secrecy. One expression of this is cafés and pubs like goldfish bowls, with everyone being able to see in and out.

In the world of Big Sister, promotion is reserved for those who can be manipulated for her own purposes (e.g. actors) and who deliver a message which is in accord with her goals. Every opportunity is taken to further female influence and power. This is the reason for the constant evocation on sex in the mass media, even though many females do not actually like physical sex (see Wilson p. 93).

Practically every word females utter serves to raise the costs of sex. This includes ostentatious advertising of sanitary towels, paranoia about child abuse and the promotion of immigrants. Almost anything involving sex is to the advantage of the female. Making sex more attractive and raising its value directly raises her status. Raising the cost of sex is the pure female strategy which underlies all others.

Another discovery was that the female instinct is to promote young life (especially babies and children) and devalue old life, while the male instinct is the opposite: to devalue young life and value the old. Euthanasia was legalised by Hitler in 1939, only then it was withdrawn due to public opposition. Now euthanasia of the aged is commonplace in Holland and often carried out even when someone is too ill to give consent. Then there is the matter of the unnecessary destruction of millions of unborn children, the consequence of women neglecting their responsibility for birth control. Many women carry a burden of guilt because of this.

'Child Abuse'

According to William Langer, 'in the eighteenth century it was not an uncommon spectacle to see the corpses of infants lying in the streets or on the dunghills of London and other large cities.' Abandonment at the door of a church would have been preferred, but the chance of discovery was too great. Eventually parliament decided to intervene and set up foundling hospitals with various systems for collecting unwanted infants without risk to the donor. On the Continent, infants were passed through revolving doors set in the walls of foundling hospitals.

But government was not capable of sustaining the cost of rearing children to adulthood, and foundling hospitals quickly became de facto slaughterhouses whose prime function was to authenticate the state's claim to a monopoly over the right to kill. Between 1756 and 1760 there were 15,000 admissions to London's first foundling hospital; of those admitted, only 4,400 survived to adolescence. Additional thousands of foundlings continued to be destroyed by wet nurses employed by parish workhouses. In order to economize, parish officers assigned the infants to women who were nicknamed 'killing nurses' or 'she butchers' because 'no child escaped their care alive.' On the Continent admissions to foundling hospitals increased steadily even during the early years of the nineteenth century. In France admissions rose from 40,000 a year in 1784 to 138,000 in 1822. By 1830 there were 270 revolving boxes in use throughout France, with 336,297 infants legally abandoned during the decade 1824-33. 'Mothers who left their babies in the box knew that they were consigning them to death almost as surely as if they dropped them in the river.' Between 80 and 90 per cent of the children in these institutions died during their first year of life.

Behaviour progressively becomes abnormal, because normal behaviour involves obligations, which females find advantageous to avoid.

The fact that women live several years longer than men illustrates the injustice of media emphasis on women's health. Female longevity also means that wealth is progressively transferred into the hands of women, as they routinely out-live their husbands and inherit it. Then that wealth will be used in pursuit of female aims.

Consistently 95% of prison populations are male and at least half are there as a consequence of government malfeasance, for example the ready availability of heroin due to mass immigration.

The means of limiting population in prehistory was female infanticide and this is still practised in some countries to this day. This is the reason we find little girls, particularly, so endearing: their mannerisms and our reaction to them have evolved to compensate for their vulnerability to being killed. Using population numbers as an objective measure of female influence, as seems reasonable, it can be concluded that a matriarchy has been in existence for many millennia.

The nightmares of our forefathers have been realised. Our society is sick and if Big Sister gets her way it will become sicker still. Already it is a society which discriminates against the very individuals who are most valuable to it (e.g. those who are honest and brave enough to insist on truth when dishonesty is enshrined in law). The current situation cannot continue indefinitely; in the jargon of game theory, the male-female game is cyclic. Because of the huge influence of the mass media the pendulum has swung to an unprecedented extreme but it will swing back, indeed the process seems to have already begun. The return to masculine mores in the future is as inevitable as the differences between the sexes.

Women's stupidity is so overwhelming that anyone who comes into contact with it will become, in a way, infected by it.
